I am reminded of the Jewish saying – the reason God made mothers is – he couldn't be everywhere at once. To mentor is not a life time commitment to a person. It just requires I phone call a week and a face to face meeting once a month. Most often it's about being there to listen to them. Please consider becoming a mentor. Through it you will surely come closer to God. Even now, 3 new members just joined in Manhattan – who need mentors. And please consider your participation in a small group. A good step would be to attend the Small Group Seminar coming up on Saturday, June 1 at Belvedere.
