"I can't believe we learned so much in just two days," said K. Narifusa, who graduated from the University of Washington this past June. "I got out of this workshop everything I came here for... I'm so glad God pushed me to come to this workshop and meet great people while learning His words," she added.



"I did not think I would need another DP [Divine Principle] workshop," said one Unificationist who had already read the Divine Principle several times over. "I must admit that this one has been very fruitful.... I was able to open my heart to the lectures in a way that I had never done before."
