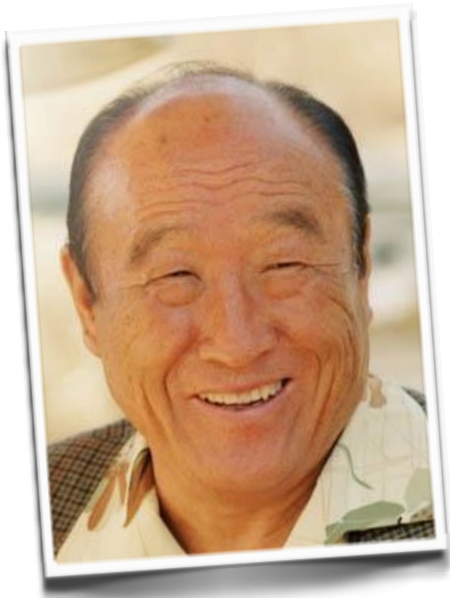

‘I think it is vitally important that our young people get to hear the Divine Principle, and a good way to do that is via a seven-day workshop.
