The presentations were interspersed with lively group discussion and sharing. In the evening, the Fleisher couple, Gary and Alice, shared their experiences of matching their three children. Their son Yongil also shared about his matching experience.

The participants were unanimous in their appreciation for the knowledge and insights gained, sharing that "all materials were well developed compared to even a few years ago" and that "all my questions were answered." Many felt new confidence in their ability to successfully support their sons and daughters in establishing healthy and happy marriages and families.
