Dear Parents,

This letter is to inform you of our workshop for High School Students. The workshop will be held at the Red Farmhouse in Bear Lake, Utah (565 South Stump Hollow Road, Garden City, UT 84028) . The workshop will begin with registration at 5:00 PM on Sunday June 27th and the workshop will close on Friday, July 2nd at 10:00 AM. The retreat is open to the unificationist High School Students from Utah and Colorado family church. The fee for the workshop is \$275 per participant for early bird, \$300 for regular fee, and \$50 for team leaders. Additionally, for families who are registering more than 1 participant, the first child will have registration fee of \$275 early bird and all additional siblings will receive a \$30 discount. In regard to kitchen staff, to express our appreciation for their time and sacrifice, we waive the fee for one participant of their choice.

Lectures, internal guidance and testimonies will be provided by a number of speakers. Particularly, this year's High School Workshop includes the collaboration between the Utah and Colorado family church, which has been never done before. Additionally, we are looking forward to receiving Rev. Thompson, our SR5 director, as the main lecturer.. We also hope that this workshop will provide the great opportunity for self-reflection and help young unificationists take ownership over their own life of faith and their relationship with God and True Parents.

Enclosed is a link to the registration, liability waiver and medical treatment consent forms and payment. Registration for early bird will close June 10th, and regular registration will close June 13th.

**Things to bring to the workshop:** A heavy jacket AND light jacket (It will get cold at night and warm during the day), flashlight, blanket, toiletries including: deodorant, feminine hygiene products (if applicable), towel, etc., close-toed shoes for sports, change of clothes, sleepwear, underwear, and swimwear. Please remember that we have a dress code at this workshop. We do not allow makeup, tight t-shirts, tight pants, short-shorts, tank tops, t-shirts that show your midriff, t-shirts with inappropriate slogans. Boys pants must not show their boxers. Please leave electronics at home or they will be confiscated. Please note that cell phones will be collected during the workshop. If contact with parents are needed, child will be permitted to do so under supervision.

Swimwear: Sisters- no bikinis or Short-shorts; one piece bathing suits with shorts OR shorts & t-shirt OR bikini with t-shirt and shorts

Brothers: long-truck shorts and t-shirt
