Pastor Mike will share the basic points of the loan and why we are considering it. We will welcome any and all feedback afterwards.

The number one church culture barrier that he sees in the church right now is "Blame." What are the effects of blame in our lives and our community and how can we deal with it? Work continues on the CARP Center renovations. Alisa and Kristian are working hard everyday.




This week, David Mahardy began work to re-repair our concrete wall by the parking lot. Thank you David for your consistent and hard work.



This week, we had the preschool carpet replaced. This was a much-needed improvement, as can be seen from the photos.






