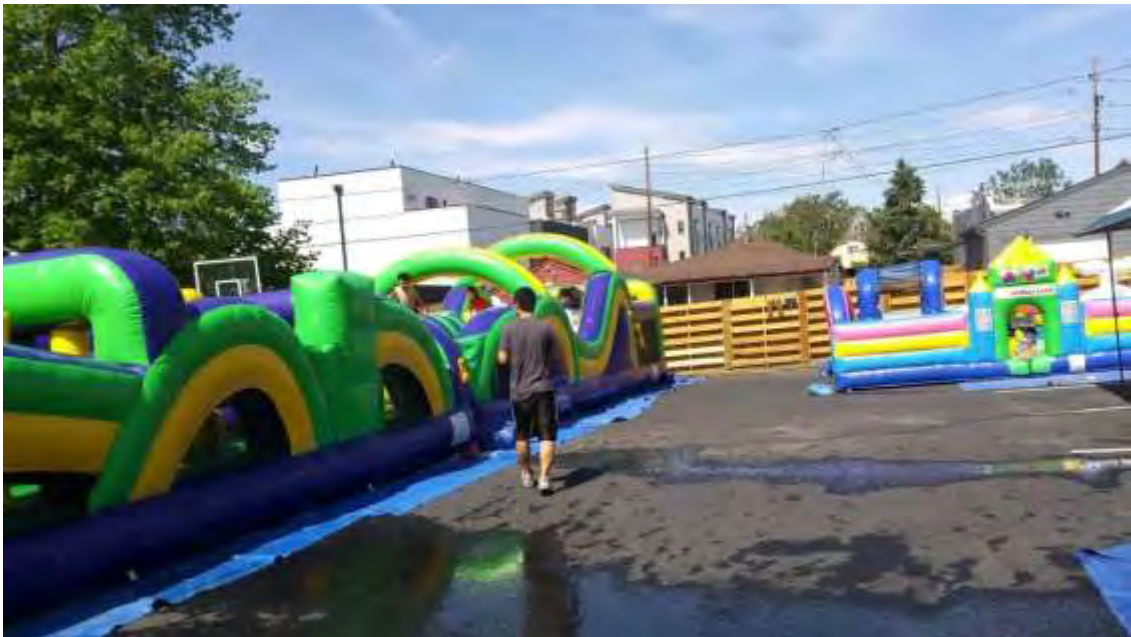


Special Guest

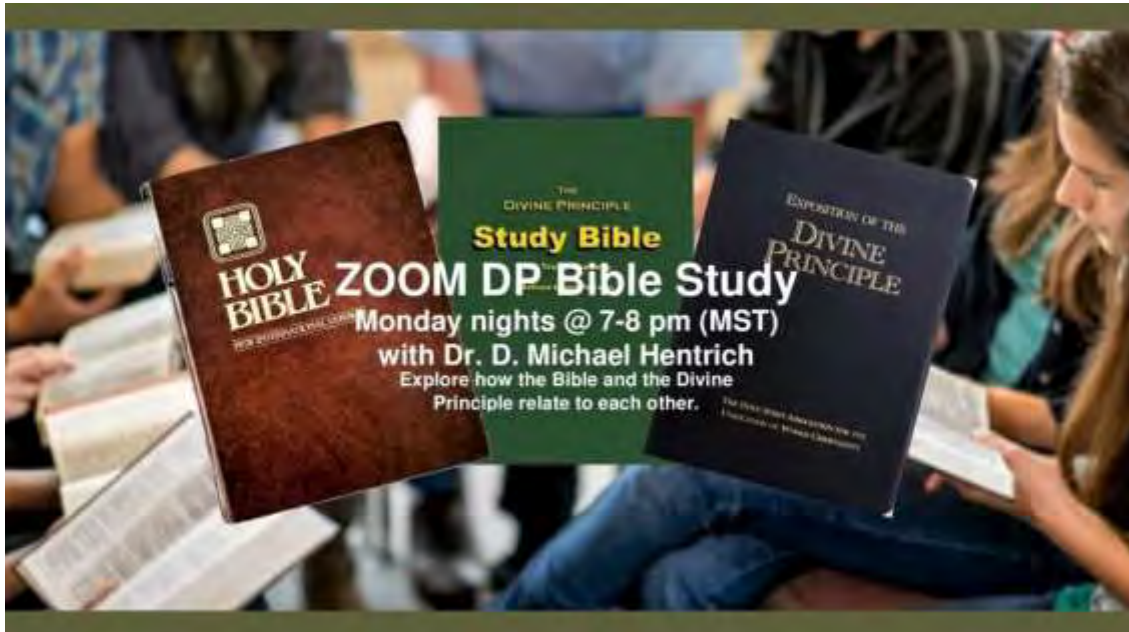
