Reverend Bo-hi Pak was born on August 18, 1930 in Dogo-myeon, Asan-gun, <u>Chungcheongnam-do</u>, Republic of Korea. On February 17, 1952, he joined the fledgling Unification Church. He received the Blessing on May 15, 1961 with Ms. Ki-sook Yoon as one of the 36 Couples. He found Little Angels Children's Folk Ballet of Korea on 1962 and the Washington Times Corporation on 1965 [should be 1985]. He also established Korea Culture Foundation on 1969 and served as the first president. He was the special secretary of True Parents from 1971 to 1994. Over the years, he served as CEO of News World, President of UCI, President of World Media Association, Chairman of CAUSA International,

President of Washington Times,

Chairman of World Summit, President of Panda automobile, President of International Federation for Victory over Communism, Chairman of The Citizen's Federation for the Unification of Korea, President of Segye Times, National Messiah to Cameroon and Mongolia, and Bun Bong Wan, etc.
