The One Heart High School Summer Retreat continues to be a very popular week in the San Bernadino Mountains for Unificationist-born youth and their friends. The camp took place from June 26 – July 2, 2016, and this year and last have seen record numbers of participants and college age staff.

The camp is located near the heart rock, which is a very well known hiking destination for tourists. One Heart Camp has been in existence for 27 years, started by Unificationist families to give young people a place to discover God and True Parents and make lifelong friends.
