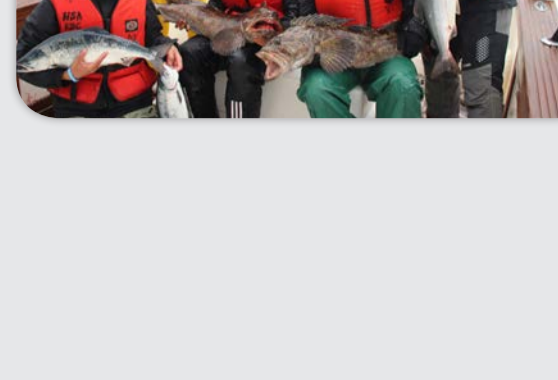
A Successful Year for the National Ocean Challenge Program

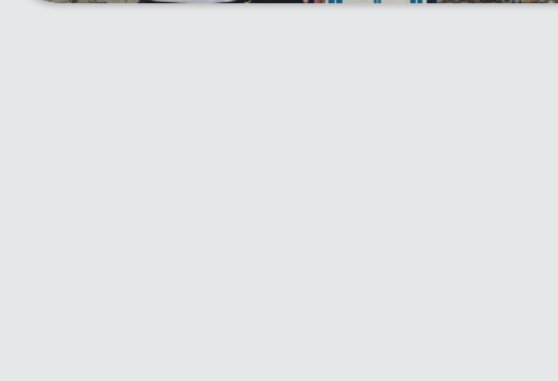
Surf Camp

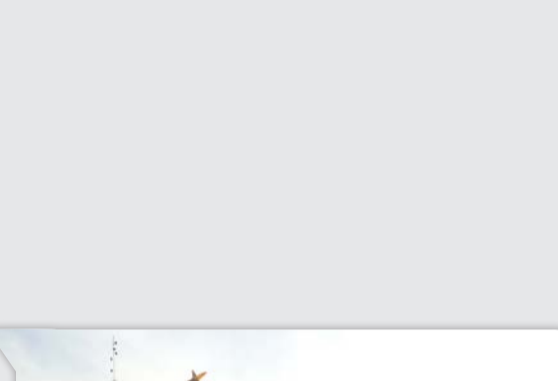

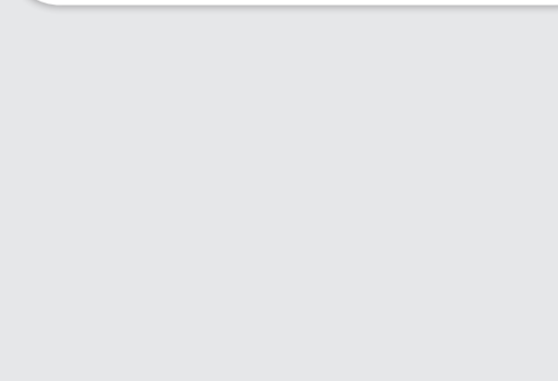
Hobby World Marine Kaiyou Heiwa • Aquamundo

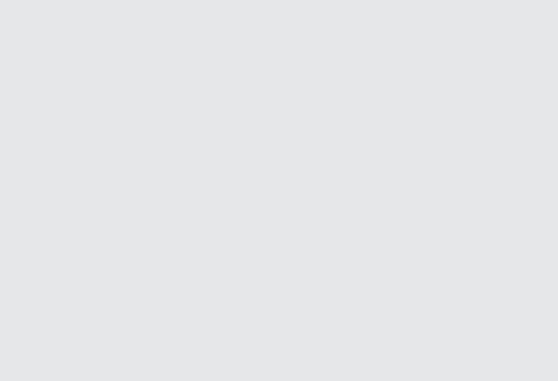

22nd Annual "Corvina Negra" (Black Sea Bass) Fishing Condition, Uruguay

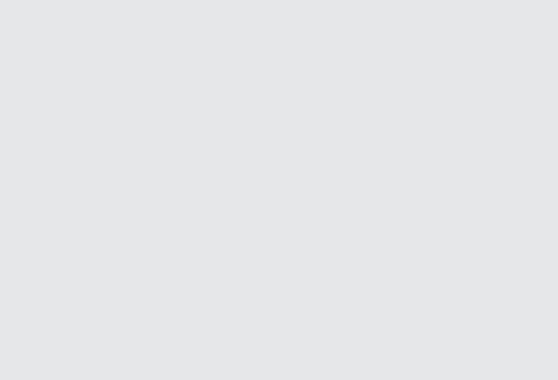

Established in 1996 by True Parents, the internal purpose is to create the internal condition to unify the Americas (North, Central, and South). 33 rods are planted along the beach representing the 33 countries of all the Americas as the young people attend the rods and practice inheriting True Parents' tradition and offering JeongSeong.

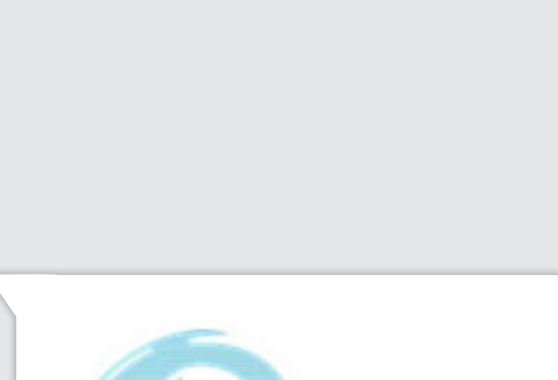
Going up to Gloucester, Massachusetts, True Parents' residence in Gloucester, we were able to meet with three people who are steeped with the experiences of Ocean Challenge and Ocean Church in Gloucester. We heard the stories and testimonies of Galen Brooks, Manuel Quesada and Raymond O'Neil who shared a wealth of insights, experiences and heart they received being a part of Ocean Challenge and what True Father had taught them.

Gloucester perceived perhaps one of the worst cases of persecution for Unificationists in the USA, but despite all the negativity several families remained even after the Ocean Challenge days and took root in the community, wanting to be an important part of the lives of the people there. The complete 180 degree turn around these members experienced from the Gloucester citizens is truly the work of the Divine Principle and True Parents' teachings at work as we listened to their impact and involvement in the community and how each of their children, the 2nd generation, even made an impact and difference for other youth in the city simply by being a living testament of our True Parents.
