For the participants who are selected, the organizers will pay the costs of the educational and cultural program, accommodation and meals.

Participants who complete the program successfully will receive a certificate.

Participants must pay for their own travel to the program site and back, as well as any accommodation costs while en route.

Interested in the development of intercultural interaction.

Ready to spread and multiply the knowledge and skills received during the program.

Ready to participate in all events planned in accordance with the program.
