

FFWPU Nigeria holds Divine Principle Workshops in Okuku Community in Yala

FFWPU Nigeria held a two-days and seven-days workshop in Okuku Community in Yala LOCAL GOVERNMENT, Cross River State, Nigeria. The two workshops were facilitated by the Sub-Regional Director West Africa - Rev. George Ogurie and the national leader of Nigeria - Rev. Imo Nkanta. The workshop gathered 40 participants from eight communities in Cross River State and Benue State where HTM Blessings had been done in the past. They were pastors and community leaders who had received the Blessing and needed further education on the principle and heavenly tradition. They were being prepared to be spokespersons for Family Federation and True Parents in their communities. They were clearly told their mission is to proclaim True Parents and make their communities know and attend Heavenly Parent and True Parents.

The workshop started with two special lectures given by Rev. George Ogurie, sub-regional Director for FFWPU Sub-Region West, on the "Myths and Misconceptions" about the Unification movement and the Trends in Family Crisis in Nigeria.
