WFWP Bergamo/Italy's book presentation: Freedom Dance among the Olive Trees

WFWP Bergamo/Italy worked in cooperation with UPF and FFWPU to create this event – a book presentation: 'La libertà danza tra gli ulivi' (Freedom Dance among the Olive Trees) by Alessandro Bozzi, at Hotel Donizetti, Lallio in Bergamo.

On 27 Jan 2018, 17:30, many people arrived at the Donizetti Hotel to hear the book presentation by lawyer and author Alessandro Bozzi.

Franco Ravaglioli, UPF Secretary General, presented the book.

A friendly dialogue between the author and Franco created a family atmosphere in the room.

His friend Andrea Carta, a psychologist and psychotherapist, conducted the interview with the author, who shared his motivation that led him to literacy writing, by giving information about the protagonists and some characters of the story.

The main character is a lawyer at the first trial opening, who has to defend his assistane Laura.

The story leads to reflect on topics of great relevance such as violence against women and the much-discussed punitive and almost never re-educational prison system.

Following the interview was a stimulating discussion with the audience.

Alessandro Bozzi also wanted to give attention to the role of the lawyer in this book, who is many times misinterpreted, pointing out that even those who perform their role with competence and professional ethics often have difficulties.

After the Q&A session, Alessandro himself performed a very lively dance called "Pizzica", together with dancer Monica Ballabio, a typical Salento dance that conveys joy and a sense of freedom.
