On Sunday, October 20, 60 students and guests gathered at the University of Toronto hosted by Youth and Students for Peace (YSP), Universal Peace Federation (UPF), Unity Under One Umbrella and Civilization Wisdom Charity Upsurge to hear three guest speakers share about how holy scriptures view love and happiness.

Dr. Abdulcabbar Boran, leader of Zivilisation Weisheit Wohltätigkeit Aufschwung (ZWWA) or Civilization Wisdom Charity Upsurge, with a translation from Eyub Yegen, a PhD candidate at the University of Toronto and president of the student organization Unity Under One Umbrella, spoke about Abrahamic religions and compared various holy scriptures.

President of UPF Canada and the National Leader of Family Federation for World Peace and Unification (FFWPU) Canada Rev. Franco Famularo concluded the seminar with an analysis of comparative religion. A discussion followed which was met with optimism and a mutual agreement that all religions are essentially alike in their basic beliefs and that our similarities are what makes us stronger together.
