For my American PEACE CLUB friends: this is the logo we use in most of the world....Soccer is Football almost everywhere else. The ball is kicked with one's foot, something which happens very rarely in "American Football."

Let me introduce our work in Jordan, a country surrounded by war and violence.

I have put together the project in Al-Karak, Jordan for the end of March. The curriculum and project design are done, the coaches are invited (up to 30). All that is left is the final push to raise a few more \$\$\$ to cover media production, website development and social media marketing.

Also we will be prepping for the next two workshops, which will take place in a more volatile part of Jordan in the towns of Mafraq and Ramtha right up by the Syrian border. Each will cost about \$5000 and will have a huge impact upon Jordanians and Syrians (up to 1.4 million refugees in Jordan) and the tensions that are making life so hard in the border region

Perhaps you can pass on the PEACE CLUB information to friends and colleagues. The program engages a wide number of people. People like the simplicity of the PEACE CLUB model. They see that introducing PEACE CLUB virtues to the 300 million+ soccer players in the world can be a huge step toward peace.
