See you on Sunday!




Council Nominations Online Form

Expectations of Council Members

To qualify, a Council candidate must be at least 18 years old and have been a member of the Belvedere Family Church for at least one year.

The following will be expected of elected Council members:

- a. Serve for two years
- b. On average this is about a 6 hour/ month time commitment
- c. Attend council meetings at least once a month
- d. Attend the Council retreat to be scheduled in late August or September (usually 2 days)
- e. Serve as the Council representative on one of the 7 major Circles: Sunday Service, Outreach, Youth Ministry, Blessing and Family Ministry, Ministries (Small Groups, etc.), Finance, Admin
- f. Be prepared to serve as an officer on the Council.
 Officers are Chair, Vice-Chair(s), Treasurer, Scribe, Communications, and Administrator (Role descriptions are available upon request)
