The Challenge

Currently the facility is a depleted state which requires financial assistance revive the glories of the facility as we prepare to hold a major workshop for the 2nd generation unification and youth from all over Africa come December.

• Everything in Busabaala D.P training centre is **old**, or **missing**.

• The facility currently has one small pit latrine shareable between ladies and gents , and one a bad day we have to make a queue :)

• The gentlemen lack a shower room and have no option but to use the lake for a quick shower.

• The ladies bathroom is small, and needs enlargement to accommodate as many ladies as possible.

• As a Training centre, the facility needs to be equipped with clean water supply system. We are so close to a fresh water lake(Lake Victoria) and we only need to install a water system so that workshop participants and the general busabaala village community.

• The main building at the centre needs a new roof, windows, doors, rewiring electricity, painting and ceiling board.

• We also need to fence off the facility from intruders. Most of the intruders have been brought to justice, but more keep coming.
