Conference Location

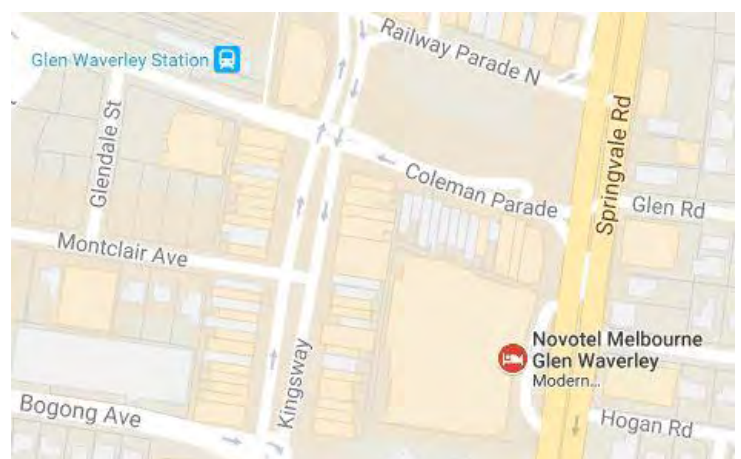
‘Novotel Melbourne, Glen Waverley’ | 285 Springvale Rd, Glen Waverley

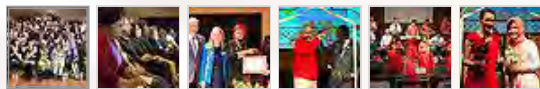
