The youth community in Barcelona organized an activity in collaboration with Roser Bosh, a biologist, environmental educator, and artist. She is the coordinator of the project called “Art descalç per la terra” in Catalan language, which in English translates to “barefoot art on the ground”, an itinerary art exhibition about nature and spirituality.

The activity consisted of a short talk given by Roser and a tour around the art gallery. The participants had to find one artwork that they could connect with and write what they felt in a stone which was previously given to them. To conclude they all shared in a circle their reflections and the words they had written. One by one they all put the stone in the floor and created a new piece of art.

This activity helped them to take conscience of our connection with nature, that everything and everyone is interconnected.
