
Peace Designer Training – Final Presentations – Hungary



After two months of interactive sessions and mentor meetings, seven teams were formed from students of two high schools. Each team could then present their project ideas.

They competed for a 20.000Ft (50 euro) prize to help realize their project. IASYP's President, Bogdan Pammer, and Vice President, Jeong Hye Yeom, were both present to judge the projects, as well as teachers from each school.



Ultimately, two winners were chosen! The first was the "Feed Back" project from Városmajoi High School. They aim to combat food waste from their school by donating leftover food to charities. The second winning project was the "Not mean just green" project. Their aim is to raise awareness of responsible recycling for students by providing recycling bins within the school.

The teams that didn't win were by no means discouraged and aim to carry out their projects as well, we're glad to have encouraged such a positive force of initiative for good in these schools and we'd like to support all these wonderful projects in some way.
