The most common item mentioned in participants' reflections was the video of True Mother's benediction: her beautiful face and her sorrowful prayer because of the wrong direction in the life of faith that so many have taken. One brother wrote that he felt a deeper embrace of love from Heavenly Parent and True Parents than he had ever felt before, and one sister said she felt the same feeling while reading the Cheong Seong Gyeong the day before the ceremony.

Another sister wrote that the 40-day prayer condition prior to the ceremony was the most deep and uplifting experience for her. She felt her inner mind begin to awaken. Another sister wrote that the ceremony was very holy and that she was honored to be a part of it.
