




Guest Speaker Series - March 2018

Ron Pappalardo is a teacher, author, publisher, and medium. He lives in Cary, North Carolina with his wife, Constance Pappalardo, a respected artist. After the November 2016 election, there continues to be tension and division among the people. The USA needs a model of political, religious, and racial unity. Ron Pappalardo maintains that the "glue" that can bring this about is prayer – that the Spirit behind the national motto "In God We Trust" is the only thing that can heal our community. Abraham Lincoln was asked during the Civil War whether or not God was on the Union side, Lincoln replied, "Sir, my concern is not whether God is on our side; my greatest concern is to be on God's side, for God is always right."
