
Thank you for your coming to America again

Because so many were able to receive the truth from you, we now have such an easy time here in America. How I wish I could suffer more, and make it easy for you! Because of you, I know God, and can love Him and have the incredible honor to do His will.

Thank you for coming to America again, and for teaching us, and showing us your love, and Father's Love. I really wanted to love you both more while you were here... I hope you know in this letter is the fruit of your much greater love. It has been very easy so far-so much so that I have been surprised, but very happy.

As the state representatives rode in cars across the United States, we felt such a strong pressure pushing on the car against which we had to struggle spiritually. Five of us who rode together (in two cars) began gradually to see and hear things spiritually, even though before we had had very few spiritual experiences. We all saw spirit-men, and heard voices. As we approached Topeka, we prayed at the State Capital. I have been in Topeka, Kansas, for ten days. Each day I have seen a good result. Today I finally got to find

the house! The location is very close to the University, it is very large, very nice, and very inexpensive. When I saw the house I knew Father wanted it. I will move into it on April! (In case you are interested, it has four bedrooms upstairs, and it rents for \$ 135 a month.)

I am giving lecture to about ten people right new... but I need to study Principle more, quickly! Also, victory over Communism ideology. I am going to begin an organization on campus within two weeks that will open the way for me to teach the Principle, and get students learning the lectures.

Most of my contacts are important, some knows some state legislators here, and he is a journalist for the newspaper on campus. He has had jobs at the state level and is well-known in Topeka.

The people here are very open to our Principle so far. I am being careful and working to be wiser than others.
