Buenos Aires, Argentina—"Sharing, Acknowledging and Celebrating" was the theme of UPF-Argentina's year-end meeting.

During the December 20 event, UPF members reviewed the organization's accomplishments of 2015 through a video.

Those individuals who supported and collaborated with UPF for the sake of peace were thanked, and the tenth anniversary of UPF's establishment in Argentina was celebrated.

Ambassador for Peace certificates were awarded to Eduardo Borri and Jackeline Giusti, coordinators of the Pacis Nuntii Movement, and of the Universal Peace Flag initiative.
