Our beloved sister Katherine Wojcik, *ne* Katherine Jenkins, ascended the morning of February 9, 2023, a little before 6:30 am, at home with her loved ones.

She is fondly known as **Kitty**—the wife of Thomas Wojcik, mother of Tath Lopez, Misun, Gil, Sunny, Tommy, and Natalia Hammond. She is grandmother to Jude and Ira Wojcik, Gil's sons; and Wilder and Dexter Lopez, Tath's sons.

Kitty and Tom were part of the 2,075 couple Blessing at Madison Square Garden on July 1, 1982. Kitty is remembered by our community with loving pride as a dear friend and true sister. She is a daughter of heaven who fiercely devoted herself to her family and missions with a full heart, and who donated 2/3 of her liver to her husband for a transplant when he was ill. She is known as a

great fundraising champion on the national MFTs, a member of the first IOWCs, the American National Messiah to Pakistan with her husband; and the family spent four years in Russia as missionaries, witnessing and teaching the people there, at the same time raising their children in a foreign country. When her husband Tom passed in 2001, she bravely stepped up as a single parent, and gained great success within seven years as an expert nonprofit professional.

After her husband Tom passed, Kitty worked hard to advance her career in professional fundraising and became one of a handful of grant specialists in the United States that is a designated subject matter expert for the Grants Professionals Certification Institute (GPC) and the National Grant Managers Association (CGMS). She has served on federal peer review panels for the U. S. Department of Health and Human Services, the U.S. Department of Labor, the Corporation for National and Community Service, and for numerous local governmental agencies and private foundations. She has also been an active Board Member on the Grant Professionals Association Board of Directors, the Grant Professionals Foundation Board of Directors, and the University of Bridgeport Board of Trustees University of Bridgeport.

Kitty passed due to cancer, after a long battle fought with dignity. We will all miss her great warm heart, her generous giving spirit, her astute intelligence, and her sense of humor.
