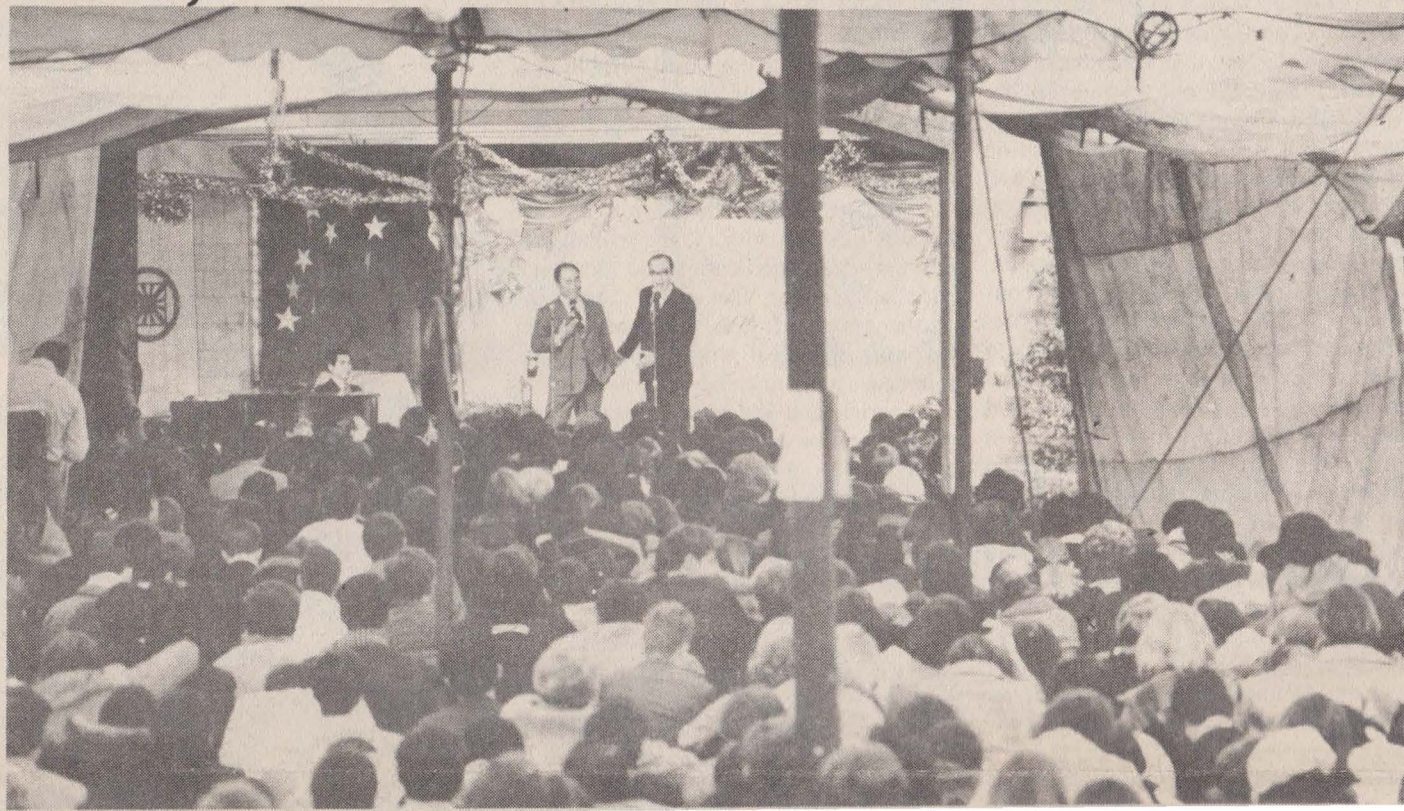

Father Returns from Asia to Celebrate Two-day God's Day with 1,200 Members at Belvedere

Our Parents returned from a whirlwind trip to Asia to celebrate God's Day on December 31-January 1 with 1,200 (and perhaps more) members at Belvedere, making this longest and largest God's Day celebration also the most memorable. Father's words from his midnight speech opening God's Day: "This year is different," will forever remain with those who heard it as well as the conviction that 1976 is the most important year in the history of our nation and that victory in Yankee Stadium will be the keystone of the restoration. Father spoke three times in the morning of the 31st, at midnight on the first, and later that morning.

God's Day was a dazzling physical as well as spiritual event. The 1,200 members—pioneers from across the country, Barrytown trainees, New York and Headquarters members, local MFT's and neighboring states—stayed for the entire two days at Belvedere—sheltered from the twenty-degree weather by the training center and giant yellow and white striped tent creating a wing outside of the large doors of the training center. For the many who could not fit into even this extended

tent creating a wing outside of the large doors of the training center. For the many who could not fit into even this extended space, closed circuit TV was installed to bring the activities on the stage of the training center to audiences in the training center basement and other smaller rooms. The program—coordinated by Mrs. Hillie Edwards and planned by the combined efforts of the Headquarters, Belvedere, Barrytown and New York Churches, smoothly flowed during the two days to provide food, lectures, entertainment and opportunities to participate in contests during the intervals between Father's speeches.

The celebration opened at 9 a.m. on the first, with Father's speech (see excerpts). This speech, his longest of the celebration, set the stage for the rest of the celebration and for the coming year by providing insight into the significance of the year which we were about to enter. At the completion of the talk Col. Pak gave a report on the Parents' trip to Asia, from which they returned directly to Belvedere after travelling through two nights.

After lunch members participated in the activity of their choice. Spread all over the Belvedere property were six groups conducting preliminary lecturing contests: after each participant lectured a section of the Divine Principle, the group selected the best one to participate in the final contest the following day. At the Holy Rock several dozen people conducted a street-speaking contest, with each speaker addressing the group from atop the rock. Inside the training center, everyone else listened to two lectures. The first, by James Cowin, Victory over Communism instructor at Barrytown, was on Communism in the contemporary world. Mr. Ken Sudo finished the afternoon by giving a powerful lecture on prayer.

Our Parents and some of the children attended the evening program preceding Father's midnight speech. The theme of the program, moderated by Michael Run-

yon, was the accomplishments of 1975. Leading off the program was a movie—seen for the first time by most American members—on the Blessing of 1,800 couples. Although the narration was in Korean, the momentous spirit of the occasion was readily captured by its portrayal of large groups of members arriving in Korea, being matched, joining in the engagement and Holy Wine ceremonies, and the wedding itself.

Reverend Reiner Vincenz, captain of the Global Team, offered reflections of the team's experience in Japan and Korea emphasizing incidents revealing the Oriental heart to the members from America and Europe.

"After we had worked for a long time in the United States, we felt that there was something missing. We know what it was twenty minutes after landing in Japan, where we were met by over one thousand Japanese members. You cannot imagine such a scale, so much love, so much closeness!" said Rev. Vincenz. He went on to explain the team's landing in Pusan—their waiting at the shore until the curfew lifted and their greeting by Father and many members of the Korean Church. "I felt that truly this was our home." After visiting the humble house in Pusan where Father wrote the Divine Principle, Rev. Vincenz said: "Walking into that house, I thought, 'if Father can work to restore the world from this point, then there is nothing that we cannot do.'"

Reverend Vincenz touched everyone's heart by telling of the sacrifices of the Korean members for the Global team: of the time that, after seeing a hole in Rev. Vincenz' sock, a member used his lunch money to buy him a new pair of socks; of the time that the Korean cooks sacrificed to buy meat for hamburgers saying: "We are

sorry that we do not know the correct taste but please accept this meat as part of our heart."

The entertainment concluded with a film of the June 7th Rally, also seen by most members for the first time. The movie conveyed more than any photograph—the immensity of the rally—the film dramatically brought to the audience's eyes the endless sea of people surrounding the platform for 180 degrees. Members cried when a Vietnamese member burst into sobs at the podium, telling of the loss of her country and held their breath to see several young men slash their stomachs to write their pledge of solidarity against Communism with blood.

Several minutes before midnight Father and Mother went to the stage and prayed silently until exactly midnight. Then Father prayed aloud and shortly thereafter proclaimed God's Day, 1976 (see excerpts of his speech).

January 1, 1976, continued with 7:00 a.m. pledge service. The Blessed couples joined Father and the family in the main house; the rest had a ceremony in the training center. Later Father came to the training center to speak. After his speech, he received a gift from the American Family: a check with a most unusual card: a mobile of stars surrounded by a spray of colored lights inside a plexiglass dome. The mobile revolved to the tune of "God Bless America."

Finals for the lecturing contest were instructive for many members as they listened to the six experienced lecturers deeply into their favorite sections of the Principle. Also during the afternoon the pioneers had a conference with Father (details in the next issue).

The January 1 evening celebra-

tion—God Bless America 1976—was an appropriate conclusion to the impressive two days. Sunburst opened with some of their best-loved songs, "Pass It On," "Peaceful," "I Wish," "Mountain," "Forever Young," and "Place in the Sun." John Spradling, Steve Honey, Sherri Westerlage, and Yoko Kobayashi alternated piano and vocal solos. The New Hope Singers came forth with some of their most exuberant music: "Joy to the World," "This is my Country," and "And the Joy of the Lord Shall be Revealed" from Handel's *Messiah*.

New Future Photographics gave a wonderful God's Day gift of slide show of the major events of 1975—over 800 beautiful colored slides took the audience from Japan and Korea for the Day of Hope, the Blessing and the Yoido Rally, with the International Leadership Seminar students from Japan in their summer stay in the U.S. to the fellowship with our Parents on Sundays at Belvedere, to the Science Conference and finally to the December 18 speech on Capitol Hill.

Then everyone was treated to hearing the children sing, followed by Mother, Father, and both of them together leading the now-traditional group song "Um Maya."

Winners of the national fundraising contest were announced; Dale Garrett learned that he had won first place in the lecturing contest. Wesley Samuel, winner of the street-speaking contest, received not only a prize but also the opportunity to present his prize-winning speech to everyone, at Father's request.

Late in the evening of January 1 a happy crowd of members, aware that they had participated in a historic event, closed the 1976 God's Day celebration with three resounding Monsei's.

December 31 Speech

"Let us Go Over the Hill of Hope"

Today is the final day of 1975 and therefore our last meeting in 1975. In 1975 the Unification Church has done a great deal. This is the year that the Unification Church was brought to the national level in Japan and Korea. Now the central point has shifted to Occidental culture here in America.

In the heart of God there is no division between East and West; the barrier between East and West is the creation of man. . . . Who is going to unite the world? This has been the task of religion but it has not achieved it. John 3:16-19 says: "God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten son." Not "so loved Japan, or the United States," but "so loved the world." The Unification Church is not alone. It is not important if the Unification Church prevail; it is important that the will of God prevail. . . . I know that each of you loves me and I love you. But it is not my personal love; rather, I am conveying the love of God to you. The world is the container, not the Unification Church. In order to plant such love we need champions to go out and share love with the rest. You must become the embodiment of the love of God to shine to the world, not to the Unification Church. The purpose of the Unification Church is to create men who can know and share the love of God. We must become masters of love of God and humanity. Love of God is the focal point of our movement.

Negative can bring us together. God, True Parents and you, if united, can become an invincible force. . . . God cannot punish our enemies until I reach them; they are ignorant, because we have not completely communicated what we are. . . . Therefore I feel responsible to let them

the motivation for Madison Square Garden and Yankee Stadium. After I have made three public appearances, people should know about me.

We will do things that no one can duplicate. In Korea thirty years ago everyone came against us. Now they think differently—they look at us as the hope of Korea. . . . Here we have just begun the war. Enjoy it, for it won't last too long! I am vulnerable to the justice of God but invincible to the injustices of the enemy. . . .

. . . Since you speak English, if your dedication is equal to mine, you will have even greater success. In a short three years, I have made the world tremble. For you, one year should be sufficient. We must make ourselves a happening, a good happening. The world needs a good happening.

You are in a historic mission. You are pioneers of a new history. We will all die, but your ideals, dedication and sacrificial spirit will remain forever. . . . Your investment is valuable in an eternal way. From this work the ideal world will be born. Your cause and our cause is the awakening of America and the world. We are not building a house; we are laying a cornerstone. If our stone is well laid, the house will be a temple. Future history will be decided by our tasks. We are hand-picked by God to lay this cornerstone. How we are honored! We must give our entire heart to the mission.

Our opposition (Communists and some Christians) are grounded in jealousy and fear. We have the spring water of life; no one can hamper its flow. We are on God's side; that is our conviction. God is on our side. Even under persecution this

and the spirit world are on our side. Future generations are 100 percent with us. That is the majority! . . . If you work harder than I, at every turn a miracle will happen. . . . If your commitment is total, you will be rewarded a million times.

The first chapter is over. Next "Let us go over the hill of hope." For thirty years the Unification Church has been in an adverse battle. Now we can proclaim the truth; that day is at hand. Do you feel that excitement? It is impossible to describe the happiness. God is the same way. . . .



It was a lonely battle to create the individual victory. Everyone wanted to crush me at that level. Now we are a tribe; the rest of the world is trying to clobber us. But our job is not to be crushed.

On June 7 we climbed over the mountain of hope in Korea; we reached a national level spiritually and physically. 1975, 1976, and 1977 are parallel to the three years' ministry of Jesus. The 200 years of American history indemnify the two-thousand year history of Christianity. Yankee Stadium is the showdown battle to decide the heavenly destiny. 1976 marks not only America's 200th birthday but the consummation of Christian history. Yankee Stadium is like calvary, but it is not the place where we will be nailed to the cross! Rather, we will claim victory to lay the cornerstone for God's victory in America. Just as Yankee Stadium is the New Age Mount of Calvary, America is like the Roman Empire and Korea like Palestine. Our destiny is to bring the U.S., the Roman Empire, to accept God's will.

We will be the ones to make it possible. If we fail, the restoration may be prolonged for three more generations. It is no coincidence that this is America's bicentennial year. We are launching a spectacular new movement for the great return of God to America. That is the significance of the Yankee Stadium crusade. We must let America cooperate with us. Jesus died with a sorrowful heart. His sorrow must be rectified. Victory in Yankee Stadium will vindicate the heart of Jesus as well as the saints and martyrs who shed blood for God's cause. Yankee Stadium will be the fulfillment for Reverend Moon and the Unification Church.

Visit to Japan, Korea

A Whirlwind Tour

After Father's December 31 morning message, Col. Pak spoke about Father's trip to Asia, which lasted up until the very minute of the speech. Receiving primary emphasis in his report was Father's intensity during the seven-day trip. Leaving on Christmas Day, our Parents went to Japan, where Father held many conferences with the Japanese leaders, making plans and reporting on the progress of the work in America. One of these sessions lasted until 4 a.m., with Father up early the next morning. The same pattern occurred in Korea. 400 Church members met him at his arrival at the Seoul church; 1,000 came to Sunday's 5 a.m. service. Col. Pak recalled waiting for a 7:30 a.m. appointment with Father on a day which he had planned to go to the titanium factory in Incheon. When Father arrived in a few minutes, he explained, said, Col. Pak, that, arising at 5 a.m., he already visited the factory and had just returned.

Col. Pak also reported progress in each country. One significant development in Japan is the training of the second-generation IOWC, New Hope Singers, and Korean Folk Ballet. As the Day of Hope festivals continue in Japan under direction of Mr. Hideo Oyamada,

Europe has sent 150 members in exchange for the IOWC members now returning to Europe. The second-generation New Hope Singers, being trained by Brian Saunders, has 17 Japanese and 10 American and European members. The Korean Folk Ballet, now largely Japanese, hopes to expand its repertoire to include an international sampling of dances.

Another noteworthy achievement, reported Col. Pak, is the growth of the Japanese daily newspaper, the *World Daily News*. In just two years, it has grown to a circulation of 200,000 and is competing with the major Tokyo papers. The next step, said Col. Pak, is to set up similar papers in the United States and England.

Col. Pak said that the Korean membership has made great strides in building 130 village churches, which have the goal of quickly increasing to 120 members each. The churches, he says, are becoming known as the best and most distinctive buildings of each village.

Col. Pak concluded his talk by explaining: "Father travelled to share the blessings of 1975 with Japan and Korea. But the primary level of work is now in America. 1976 is the year of America."

Those who seek to die for the Messiah's cause will live. Do you want to live or die for the cause of God? If you have that kind of commitment you will not die, you will be prosperous. There is one principle, and it is uncompromising. I live that way of life.

Today we are in that most important emergency. The democratic world is crumbling. Christianity is declining. The threat of Communism is all over. God must have His champions on the earth. . . . We must be the sacrifices to build one heavenly sovereignty. We must create one model nation as a showcase.

God's cause. Yankee Stadium will be the fulfillment for Reverend Moon and the Unification Church.

We must bring hope to mankind—light and hope to the world and each nation. Success or failure at Yankee Stadium will have universal impact. At Yankee Stadium we bet our life. . . . Yankee Stadium is a day of joy and a day of dreadful judgment. We cannot think of a day of failure. We can have Washington Monument in the same year—500,000 people, the largest gathering in the history of the United States. Historians, businessmen, politicians and the religious world will be shocked!

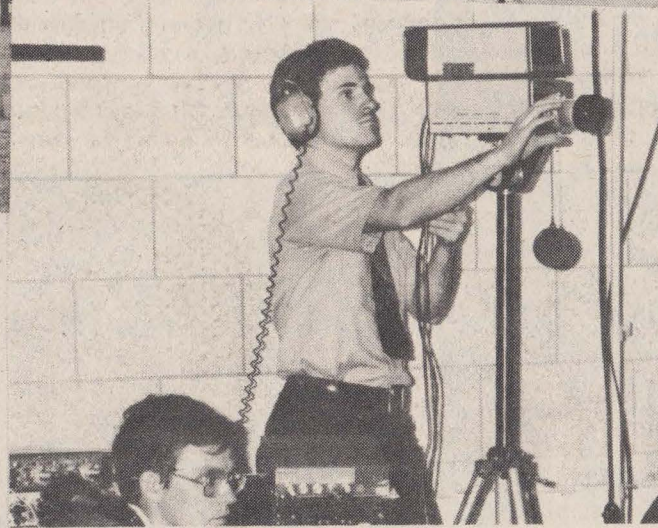
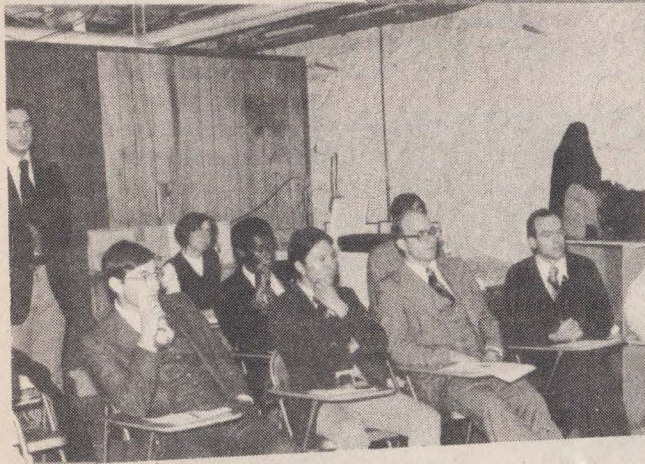

We now have the power to mobilize the spirit world for our purpose. With the spirit world mobilized for your goal, you can have invincible power. Spirit world will bring so many people that there will be a traffic jam! We will need traffic police, and that will be our role. Even if an earthquake comes or heavens fall down, you must hold the flag, marching toward Yankee Stadium because you don't want to fail with so many people following you. . . . After the division of east and west, for the first time God is declaring the most important emergency. He wants all the people of the world to rush towards one goal—Yankee Stadium. First Prize Street Speech

First Prize Street Speech

Following is the prize-winning street speech by Wesley Samuel, delivered at the January first celebration at Father's request. Wesley has been a member for ten years and was blessed in 1969. He is currently with the New York Church, working with the International Family Association.

Ladies and Gentlemen, thank you very much for coming here on your lunch hour to hear me speak to you. I am going to speak to you on a new revelation received from God from Reverend Sun Myung Moon. Hey! Where are you going? You don't like Reverend Moon? Why? You've read about him in the newspaper? Well, hear it from me. I've been with him for ten years.

There is one important question that I would like to ask each of you: Do you believe in God? Let me ask one more very important question. Are we living in an ideal world? If there is God, then God wants to see His ideal manifested here on this earth. Am I right? That means that we must understand and know God's ideal here on this earth. In the beginning when God created man, God said to man to be fruitful, multiply, and have dominion over the whole universe. God said to Adam and Eve to grow up—grow up to inherit this blessing. Adam and Eve failed their responsibility. Ever since that time, God has been working to recreate man and to bring about his ideal here on this earth. Originally, Adam and Eve, the first couple created by God, were to bring about a family of man upon this earth. Adam and Eve were to be the true representatives of God here on this earth—Adam and Eve, beginning as the first couple, led by God in divine marriage. Then they would have their chil-

dren, and create a society of people manifesting God's love, and then a nation—a nation where God can dwell with His children. That nation can be the true nation of God—the representative of God. And from that nation comes the entire world.

But since God created man, God has never seen his ideal manifested here on this earth. For six thousand years, God has been working to establish that ideal. Now is the time for man to come forth. Here where we can come together to bring God's Kingdom of heaven on this earth!

This *New York Times* is mine." In Korea our members work in our factory. It is possible because we are united with God. God is with us. Everyone thinks that I must be a brilliant businessman. Not at all. I only know God's way. I do not control anybody's mind—only God has that power.
