Father Moon: Why God Needs Humankind April 16, 1996

"God's act of creation was inevitable. And we cannot imagine creation without a purpose. There was only one reason God needed the creation: to realize the ideal of true love. God developed life from the simplest and lowest levels up to the human level in pairs, subject and object and positive and negative, to form reciprocal relationships under the ideal of love.

This principle of creation is at work to perfect the absolute love of God through the perfection of the love of man and women in the human world. This is the reason why, in the beginning, God created one man and one women, Adam and Eve.

God's purpose of creation called for Adam and Eve to obey the commandments of God, who is the subject of true love, and perfect themselves as true man and true woman. Furthermore, they were to become a true couple united in the true love of God. Then, by having sons and daughters through that true love, they would have become true parents and lived in happiness.

Had Adam and Eve perfected themselves in true love, they would have fulfilled God's desire to wear a substantial body. And when they perfected themselves as a true couple, the ideal of God's absolute love would have been fulfilled."

Current Events:

Stand for Family and Save the Nation is the motto of the American Clergy Leadership Conference (ACLC) which is sponsored by many denominations. The purpose of ACLC is:

 To break down denominational barriers and then to embrace all religions, all peoples. "That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in Me; and I in thee.." John 17:21

- to dissolve racial barriers by practicing the principle of loving one's enemies.
- to provide moral direction for America and its leaders.
- To promote the blessing of marriage and the end of divorce as well as strengthening family ties and cultivating a healthy environment for youth in the family and the community.
- To actively participate in the renewal of the community by working together with people of faith and such organizations to address the needs of the people.
- To acknowledge and invite the Holy Spirit to work and then inspire and direct the people of the nation.
- To work for an environment of living for the sake of others.

Throughout America thousands of clergy including American Indian clergy/traditional spiritual leaders have rededicated their marriage commitments and have received the blessing of the Creator through the anointing of Jesus and the Holy Spirit as part of the 144,000 Holy Blessing Convocation. In addition, these clergy then give their prayer and anointing to their respective church congregations and gatherings. Each couple vowed the following:

1. As a mature man and women, we pledge that we will become true husband and wife, consummating the ideal of God's creation with absolute fidelity.

2. We pledge that we will inherit and maintain the tradition of family unity and pass this tradition on to future generations of our family.

3. We pledge that we will raise our

children to live up to God's will, and educate them to be sexually abstinent until marriage.

4. We pledge that we will support all families to uplift these ideals, beyond race, religion and nation, by participating in the Blessing of Marriage, helping create the Kingdom of God on Earth and in Heaven.

During these past two months of outreach, thousands of American Indians have participated in the rededication of their marriages which will certainly strengthen their families, communities and nations.
