
- Headquarters must consist of a man leader and also a woman leader. If a man is national leader, then the vice-president should be a woman.

# Father's Fishing Conditions During Mother's American Speaking Tour

ATHER fished for king salmon [also known as chinook salmon] from June 21 to June 30 in Kenai, Alaska. Early on June 21, Mother had left Anchorage for Phoenix to continue her American speaking tour. Father had planned to return to Kodiak, but his flight was canceled because of heavy fog. He decided then to go fishing for king salmon on the Kenai River, determined to make a record catch. Father said, "Let's catch a seventy-pound king salmon."

Last year at the same Kenai River, Father had decided to catch a king salmon weighing over fifty pound. Five days later he caught a fifty-five pound fish. I recalled that story when I heard Father had decided to catch a seventy-pound salmon.

Father arrived at Kenai after a threehour drive from Anchorage and immediately asked, "Where is the river?" Even before we finished checking in at the hotel, Father had left for the river. The Kenai River is about a hundred meters wide, and Father cast his line again and again into the river. He caught a Dolly Virden, a small fish, and after that nothing happened. Then Father returned to his hotel room to hear Mother's speech. Mother's speech was really successful. Father said to Mother, "Omonim, Kamsahamnida. Sugohashussoyo" ["Mother, thank you for your hard work and accomplishment"] and really encouraged her. Then at 10:30 p.m. he went back to the river.

The sky was still bright, and at about 11:30 p.m. Father's line arched. I realized that it was a king salmon. The river current was so fast and strong, it was not easy to bring the salmon close. The fish headed down river until the line was almost gone; then, with one brother, Father looked for a good landing place to bring in the fish. A good place was not easy to find and,

unfortunately, after about fifty minutes the hook came loose. The brother apologized to Father, who gently responded, "Don't worry."

The next day Father returned to the river in a very new boat. From morning to night over the course of three days, Father's boat went back and forth on the river, but no fish were caught. It was the end of the first salmon run, so there were not many fish, but here and there other boats were making a catch, so my heart was not so calm. On the third day when I heard Mother ask Father if he had caught a big fish, I was really frustrated that we were not yet successful.

# Father's smile

On the fourth day, June 24, over three hundred small boats had gathered on the river, but by 11:30 p.m. Father's boat was alone on the river. Father dropped the an-





chor and waited. When one of the lines became taut, Father immediately took hold of that line. We pulled in the anchor, and Father fought with the fish for about twenty minutes. Finally we could make out the king salmon's shape, but it would appear and disappear again under the surface. Father said, "It's really a big one," and all the crew became excited and tense. Father began to carefully reel in the fish,

and finally pulled it in alongside the boat. Father set up his reel, and the fish floated on the surface, but as the net was lowered to lift it up, the fish jumped. Everyone could hear the sound of the fish dropping in the water and thought it was lost, but the line was still taut. Father again carefully pulled in the reel, and this time successfully netted the fish. It took two people to lift the fish into the boat. This was a

really big king. It was still evening time not so bright, but not so dark—and we could see Father's beaming smile.

The fish was fifty-three inches long, much bigger than the last big king Father had caught. We returned to the dock and the fish weighed in at just seventy pounds. Father's word was accomplished.

The next day Father reported the story to Mother, who was also very happy. It

seemed to me that Father would really have liked to call Mother to come to Kenai River.

# Enthusiasm and diligence

Until June 30, Father stayed in Kenai, returning to the hotel only to hear Mother's speeches. Otherwise, from early morning until midnight, he focused on catching king salmon. He caught one or two every day. About 10:30 p.m. on the last day, we heard the sound of Father's

line on the Kenai River. Father fought, calm and composed, for twenty minutes and caught another king. This one weighed sixty-two pounds. Father was very satisfied, and said to go back home.

A manager from one of the main sport shops told me that Father's seventypound fish was the second biggest caught on the Kenai this year.

When I look back over the past ten days I see how Father really focused on catching a big king salmon. He forgot

about eating and resting, and the result was that he caught three big fish—seventy pounds, sixty-two pounds and forty-four pounds—as well as two weighing around thirty pounds. This is Father's brilliant accomplishment, brought about by his enthusiasm and diligence. We cannot help but admire this kind of diligence.

Father returned to Kodiak from Kenai on June 30, 1993. **■**

# Mother Testifies about Father's Workshops

NOVEMBER 11, 1993 OSLO, NORWAY

At the end of the August Kodiak workshops [see the November issue of Today's World] Father continued with a new series of workshops for Japanese women. When Mother finished her speaking tour of Japan [see the November issue of Today's World] and went to Korea to speak at the universities there, Father moved these workshops to Cheju Island where he continued teaching until the end of the first year of the Completed Testament Age.

Another wave of fifty thousand Japanese sisters began coming incrementally to Cheju Island on January 3, 1994, for workshops.

N Korea right now. Father is educating eighteen hundred woman leaders from Japan. Each team goes through three nights and four days of training. After each team leaves, another team comes. By the end of this year, Father will complete educating up to fifty thousand Japanese women leaders. Father himself is giving personal, special training—Divine Principle and teachings for life of faith in general. Think about it. Father, at the age of seventy-three, sleeping less than two hours a day, speaking fifteen to sixteen hours every single day. On top of that, Father and the participants are staying up at night to listen to my speech. Right now in Korea it is 6:10 a.m. In order for them to listen to my speech, they have to stay up, because they started listening from 4:00 a.m. until now, 6:10 a.m. Father will probably have something simple for breakfast and then go out and talk for another fifteen or sixteen hours. Think about it. These teams of Japanese leaders come and go-three nights and four days. Then a new team comes, but Father stays there every single day, without rest he keeps going on. We are really praying for Father's health. Of course, Father's spirit is higher and stronger than anyone else in the world, but Father's physical body has limitations. We must send our support and prayer. Next year Father may come.

# Special Workshops for Japanese Women Leaders

World Mission Department Seoul, Korea

Since October 6, 1993, there have been on-going special workshops for women leaders at the international training center on Cheju Island in Korea.

With each workshop lasting four days, nine hundred fifty-two women attended the first, and fifteen hundred eighty-five attended the second. Up to the twenty-third workshop, forty-three thousand, seven hundred and ninety-three women have attended these programs. It is projected that over fifty thousand will have participated by the twenty-fifth workshop concluding on December 22, 1993.

The workshop with the most participants was the twenty-second one, with thirty-three hundred ninety-four women present. Especially at that workshop, Father stayed right at the training center, not resting even one day, giving words of life around the clock.

Now the Japanese sisters, witnessing Father's great love and sacrifice, are deeply repenting and making a new start by pledging together to multiply Father's true love.

# Your Responsibility is Enormous

HOSE who are attending this kind of major celebration with True Parents for the first time, raise your hands, please. Are all of you blessed? Those who are not blessed, raise your hands. Only blessed members are supposed

to be here. To participate in this kind of major celebration requires prayer and preparation. You should have three days of separation between husband and wife, and at least one week of prayer or cold shower condition or another condition. Children's Day is one of the seven major holidays we celebrate every year and in order to prepare for this kind of celebration, we must set conditions for ourselves and the things we are offering. When you go out shopping to buy fruit and other things for the offering table, you should go with a prayerful heart. Sometimes spirit world will guide you, showing you which store to buy from. Actually, if I explain all the conditions and rules to comply with in order to be able to participate in this kind of major holiday, you would be overcome because the rules are so strict. There are so many different steps and conditions you have to set. Therefore, I will skip that.

However, while preparing yourself and preparing the offering table for this kind of major celebration, you must not fight or feel angry or upset. Instead be joyful and happy, volunteering to do all the tasks. You shouldn't just wake up in the morning and say, "Oh, this is Children's Day. Let's go and participate." That's not the attitude. You should prepare yourselves spiritually, internally, and with prayerful heart come in and humbly participate.

This celebration of Children's Day in this country and on this continent is a very historic occasion. Therefore, with your coming generations, you should commemorate this event, year after year. This is a sacred and special event for your country and your continent. However, just this handful of people are not supposed to

participate in this kind of major celebration. Actually, if we celebrate this holiday here in this country, the entire country of Switzerland should all work together to prepare for and participate in this celebration. Furthermore, all of humanity should participate and celebrate together with God and True Parents.

# True Parents' grace

Because of this help from the spirit world and because Jesus Christ spiritually appeared and helped people, established Christianity laid a strong enough foundation for the coming of True Parents.

As I tour these Western countries, which were built based on Christianity, I see the reality that this established Christian foundation has been taken over by Satan and is becoming a foundation for evil to spread rampantly. For example, the very cause of the fall is now being widely exercised among the Christian people here. I feel sad particularly because many of these Western countries have established Christianity as their national religion—in some countries maybe ninety percent of the population are of the Christian faith. Even with this Christian foundation, these Western countries are the setting of all kinds of incredible social crimes and immoral practices, which are spreading all over the world. How sorrowful God's heart is now when He looks down upon this chaotic, dirty world. From God's point of view, He doesn't even want to look at us twice. Though God feels that He doesn't want to deal with humanity anymore, because of True Parents' grace and forgiveness we now have one more chance. That's the grace from True Parents. Therefore, as blessed couples in these Western countries, your responsibility is enormous. Please remember

The key point I want you to remember is that True Parents themselves gave this proclamation of True Parents and the Completed Testament Age, in which we are living right now. Whatever country I visit or True Parents visit, I set the victorious foundation for that particular country. Therefore, to maximize that victorious foundation laid by True Parents, you must reach out to as many people as possible and give this proclamation to them, just like True Parents did. You must not hesitate whatsoever but be courageous and bold to go out and teach them, and eventually lead them to True Parents and God. This is a very precious time we are living in and we must be busy even twenty-five hours a day with a desperate feeling. Otherwise we can't do our responsibility. If we just relax, this opportunity will be lost.

In this very moment, this very second, while True Parents are here with you, tens of thousands of people are dying without knowing True Parents. Sooner or later, without any exception, we will all have to join the spirit world. Millions of people who have lived together with us in this world without knowing True Parents will be there when we join the spirit world. When we face them, what do you think they will say to us? Do you think they will welcome us with big smiles? They will accuse and judge us that we didn't let them know about True Parents and God while they were living with us on the planet Earth. If we don't fulfill our responsibility to reach out to as many people

as we can, when we join the spirit world our place will not be secure, our position will not be guaranteed. We will be lost in the spirit world. Our focus on this earth should be to go after even one more single soul to restore back to True Parents and God; otherwise they will accuse and criticize us. That's our responsibility.

The Unification Church has been established in most countries in Europe for more than twenty years, but I am sorrowful when I see the reality of each country as I am traveling through them.

Father has been devoting his entire life to defeating Satan and setting the victorious foundation for all of humanity. Even though he has been constantly confronted by worldwide level persecution, he always overcame that and he finally set the victorious foundation by proclaiming True Parents and the Completed Testament Age. Father himself walked the course of indemnity for over forty years for the sake of humanity, and on top of that, Father set this victorious foundation. That's Father's life course. You may not fully understand all that Father has gone through, but Father and others have explained some of Father's life course.

When compared with Father's life, your quality of life is such

that in front of God you can't even raise up your heads. There is no comparison. Even the blessing that Father gave you of tribal messiahship is not really welcomed by you, because you are neglecting it. Therefore, you must evaluate your past life, what you have done, what was wrong, and repent and make a truly new determination in front of God and True Parents. Many of you feel the time difference between last year and this year. It's up to you what kind of condition, what kind of foundation, you establish. Then the spirit world will be ready to give as much blessing and support as

There is a small group of Japanese people who come to the won jeun where Heung Jin Nim is resting at least once or twice a month. This group came to greet Heung Jin Nim and worship there last month. While they were praying, the spirit world told them through one member of the group who is a medium: "You people, why are you here now? We are all mobilized. Heung Jin Nim, Hong Halmonim and everybody have been mobilized to accompany Mother on

her world tour, to go ahead of Mother and prepare to receive Mother. It is a very busy time. Why are you here?"

Since I began my speaking tour in America, in May of this year, continuing on to Japan and Korea and now in Switzerland, I have delivered this same speech over a hundred times. Each time I deliver the proclamation, Father is always with me, following the same text. A spiritual medium told me that it's not just Father who is with me all the time, but even God Himself is so joyful and so happy that He is virtually dancing around whenever I am delivering this proclamation. Please understand the significance of this precious time period. After six thousand years of history, finally True Parents came with this proclamation. Now, through this proclamation, God's suffering heart, which we call han in Korean, is being liberated. Therefore, True Parents are so moved, so inspired, and so happy, that we can't just sit still. We have to go out and give this happy news, this new truth to all of humanity. Thus can you just sit around and do your routine things? You must be inspired even more than True Parents. You must be happy and touched and even intoxicated by this grace and truth from True Parents. If you are moved in order to spread this truth, you should not be able to sit someplace and take it easy. That kind of urgent feeling and determination should be with you all the time. This is the significance of the time period now. I hope that all of you make this kind of determination here this morning. Will you do that?

# Mother's prayer

[A brief summary.] Mother first of all gave her thanks to God and Father that she can celebrate the thirty-fourth Children's Day here in this country and though Father is in Korea they are celebrating together across the ocean.

This is a very historical place in the eyes of God. [In 1985, there was a conference here led by the Professors World Peace Academy and the title was "The Fall of the Soviet Empire." While Father was in Danbury prison Dr. Morton Kaplan, who was at that time taking care of the conference, came to Father begging Father to change the title. As you remember, in 1985 the Soviet Empire was still so strong that they were taking over one country or several countries a year. Father told Dr. Kaplan and Rev. Kwak to go ahead with the meeting, which was held right here in Geneva, and declare to the world the fall of the Soviet Empire. Even a person like Dr. Kaplan was so afraid that he came to Father and pleaded with Father to change the title. Father said, "No, this is the direction from God." Through Rev. Kwak he petitioned to Father a couple more times, but Father never moved. Father is like a mountain. Mother mentioned that special significance here.] This is the very place where God declared to the world the fall of the Soviet Empire and communism through Father. It is historical that we have our Children's Day celebration here in this very

significant place. Therefore, all of Christianity and the European continent, particularly the countries where Christianity is a national religion, must be reborn. This are doing now.

Having finished the speaking tours in America, Japan and Korea, on November 1, 1993, Mother flew from Seoul, Korea, to Frankfurt, Germany, to begin her world tour which continued through December 23 when she returned to Seoul. In those two months Mother covered sixty-two thousand and fifty miles in the air and on land to bring the wonderful good news of "True Parents and the Completed Testament Age" to all the people of the world.

When Father asked the True Family to follow his and Mother's examples, the family responded with a rousing forty-speech American tour with the same proclamation. Now the door is wide open and other countries and tribal messiahs are reporting victorious responses to giving the speech. We begin these reports here and continue them into the coming issues of Today's World. It is such a joy to report these events. Thank you Heavenly Father and True Family. Truly you stand as one.

# Frankfurt, Germany November 2, 1993

A BOUT twelve hundred people gathered for Mother's speech at the Marriott Hotel Ballroom in Frankfurt. The preparations were almost perfect. With the strong determination and united effort of all the members of our German church, we were able to fill the hall with a thousand people for Mother's speech. This is a sign of hope for our nation.

VIPs, guests and brothers and sisters gave very positive statements about the good atmosphere, the program and the organization of the event. The cantor of the Jewish congregation in Hannover offered a prayer before Mother's talk. About a hundred Korean guests were in the au-

dience.

Rev. Chung Hwan Kwak, Peter Kim and Rev. Kwang Kee Sa (newly-appointed president of the European church) expressed that Mother was very happy about the evening. Mother was very happy when she telephoned Father in Korea, and he was happy too. Father was at Cheju Island together with sixteen hundred Japanese sisters, who listened to the whole event via telephone hook-up, even though it was 3:00 a.m. their time.

During the victory celebration, Mother emphasized that we are now living in the Completed Testament Age, and not in the Old or New Testament Age. "This is the age of living with God," she proclaimed. This was the hope of all humankind throughout history. This is possible be-

cause of True Parents' victorious foundation.

# The Hague, Netherlands November 5, 1993

We were amazed at how openly we could witness about our True Parents and how many people showed interest in our ideology. The prime minister of the Netherlands sent a personal letter welcoming Mother to our country. Weather conditions were favorable for Mother's first four European speeches.

On the way to The Hague, Mother stopped at an exhibition about the dike system that was initiated, after the flood of 1953, to prevent another disaster. Mother was so happy that she gave her a kiss on the cheek.

A very warm and beautiful atmosphere was created during the celebration meeting. After Rev. Kwak reported to Father, Mother talked and sang to Father and the two thousand Korean members and various True Grandchildren who were on Cheju Island with Father. They sang in response and talked and laughed with us

# Ottawa, Canada November 8, 1993

On November 8, 1993, Mother addressed an overflow audience at the Parliament Building in Ottawa of over three hundred fifty dignitaries, parliamentarians and guests from all over the country. With the support of Dr. Edward Schreyer, former Governor-General of Canada, who was the Queen's representative and head of state from 1979-1983, in addition to that of a sitting Senate member, our members secured three (!!!) rooms in the central House of Parliament, an unprecedented

first for a non-governmental organization.

Dr. Schreyer's respectfully thoughtful introduction of Mother lent a tone of dignity and awe to the occasion. A lovely presentation of classical music by a young, but accomplished, duo of soloist and harpist also raised the atmosphere toward heaven. Rev. Dr. Petro Bilaniuk, of Professors World Peace Academy note, gave an invocation of peace from St. Basil the Great to open the program.

In the audience were some members of Parliament, Senators's aides, ambassadors

and other dignitaries. The newly-appointed Minister for Women's Affairs joined the meeting and listened attentively to Mother's message. Messages of welcome, congratulations and proclamation were received from virtually every major city in Canada, from a number of provincial premiers, from a former prime minister as well as from the present Governor-General. To our great joy, Hyun Jin Nim and Kook Jin Nim arrived shortly before the program, as well as a number of church and Women's Federation for World Peace leaders from the United States.

Dr. Schreyer, much to this writer's surprise and delight, stayed on afterward to attend the reception and mingle with the audience, fielding questions about his involvement with the movement. Mother held a private reception for over one hundred members at her hotel later, complete with telephone link to Father.

The next day, before leaving for Paris, Mother, after a short tour of the capital city, visited the home of her high school classmate, Mrs. Helen Kim, for a luncheon in Mother's honor. Many members accompanied Mother to the Mirabel International Airport to see her off after a very victorious and moving two days with the True Mother of mankind.

tion from Satan. I felt that the absence of persecution in France was a great victory for True Parents.

Our preparations were very smooth and our staff had been working very harmoniously. However, Satan made a final effort to try to destroy the meeting at the very last moment. The transportation union decided to strike against the Paris metro system from 4:00 to 7:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. to 1:00 a.m. on the very day of Mother' speech. Our meeting was scheduled to start at 7:00 p.m., and although the hall was still seventy percent empty, the meeting had to begin. You can imagine the heart of all the members who had been investing so much up until that moment. However, the guests had determined to come under any circumstances, and before Mother started her speech the hall was totally full.

As soon as Mother appeared, the Catholic layman who had just given the invocation stood and encouraged the whole audience to stand. Everybody rose to their feet and gave Mother a warm ovation as she took the stage. The audience followed the whole speech in their text, reading very carefully and applauding from time to time. Many guests were struck by Mother's purity, some shedding tears during the meeting. After Mother finished, the whole audience immediately stood up and applauded.

One Muslim leader later presented Mother with a plaque, and a Jewish theologian expressed appreciation for the speech. Thus three main religions united together under the name of True Parents. Some guests did not arrive until 9:00 p.m., after Mother had already finished speaking. They were very sorry, and some decided to go to Geneva to hear her there.

The final number of guests was seven hundred. Many gave up coming due to the metro strike and consequent traffic jam. It was a strange coincidence that one of the largest traffic pileups in French history took place at the moment Mother commenced her speech at 7:45 p.m. More than seventy cars were burned and seventeen people were killed. Maybe France

had to pay great indemnity after trying to oppose the meeting, now that the declaration of True Parents and the Completed Testament Age has been made.

# Geneva, Switzerland November 13, 1993

THIS time Switzerland received so many blessings from True Parents. marked opera singer Blazenka Milic before she closed the main program by singing, "Ave Maria."

It was a wonderful experience to see Mother happy and relaxed. After the speech, we spent almost an hour and a half sharing with Father and singing. Then Mother spoke about the importance of this day: "Tonight was the first speech in an East European country on this tour. Up until now, God could not do so much; now you can freely go everywhere and proclaim your faith. You must resemble Father and Mother." After her guidance

# Budapest, Hungary November 18, 1993

People were transformed by Mother's love and words. Afterwards we gathered around Mother to celebrate the victory. Nothing seemed to have gone wrong, and Mother was happy with the success of the event.

Mother introduced to us Jin Hun Nim (Un Jin Nim's husband), who is working in the CIS, and said that blessed couples should resemble True Parents.

The Unification community has a twenty-year history in Poland, Mother remarked, one of the longest in Eastern Europe. It started underground, and now we are free to receive Mother officially. In the Completed Testament Age, we should serve God and True Parents. Mother urged us to spread True Parents' name boldly and courageously everywhere.

At breakfast the next morning, we reported to Mother about the responses from the audience. Many VIPs expressed their gratitude for being invited to the event and asked us to pass on to Mother their words of thanks, admiration for her accomplishments and best wishes for further success. # Kiev, Ukraine November 20, 1993


MOTHER'S party arrived in the Ukraine and stayed at the Intourist Hotel, which is Kiev's best. The hospitality side of the visit went smoothly. However, the same cannot be said for everything else.

Less than forty-eight hours before Mother was due to speak, our representatives were called to the National Drama Theatre, where the event was scheduled to be held. There they found four "gentlemen" waiting for them. One was the head of the local police, another the head of the local visa department, and the other two were KGB officials. They announced that our meeting was illegal, and for two hours they tried to find out who had issued the invitation for Mother. The conclusion was that we needed the approval of the city administration and the signature of the president in order to go ahead. For the whole of the next day and right up until the event, we tried to obtain what was asked for, but in vain. All of the people who might have helped us, including those on our welcoming committee, had somehow left Kiev two or three days before the speech.

Quickly we booked a nice but smaller hall in the Intourist Hotel. We did this through the Chernobyl Foundation and its secretary, a former dissident with no fear of the authorities. He gave the speech introducing Mother in an extremely sincere,

respectful and heartistic way.

Two hours before the speech, we gave up trying to get the original hall and made a crazy, chaotic scramble to prepare the reserve venue. We had to redirect the people who were coming to the original hall, where they encountered police who told them that if they went anywhere else the speech might be held they would be arrested. In addition, the buses we had arranged to transport people to the new venue failed to appear.

The original theater had a capacity of a thousand seats. The second one had seats for four hundred sixty-five, plus standing room for an additional hundred people. The hall management told us they would lock the doors once the coat racks were

While we were setting up, the first two officials appeared, but left after nobody would introduce them to the organizer of the event! A few minutes before the program began five KGB officials appeared; after enduring their aggressive rhetoric for twenty-five minutes, Mr. Shovkoshitny managed to show them to the door, after which all the doors were padlocked by the hall's director.

We dispensed with any entertainment before Mother's speech, and everything went smoothly. Mother was really radiant and spoke easily. The audience responded very warmly, especially towards the end, when there was frequent applause.

There were many school teachers, school directors and representatives of women's groups from around the Ukraine. Afterwards I recognized a few university rectors, but because of the mad scramble it was difficult to know how many VIPs were present.

One woman in the audience commented, "I don't know if he is the Messiah, but she is definitely the daughter of God." Mother received some very warm letters of welcome, which is definitely not a local tradition. After the speech she was presented with a beautiful gift from the head of the Kiev Cultural Fund.

The meeting with Mother afterwards was very wonderful, although it was clear that our members were not well prepared. Mother was seated before any members arrived, and they did not know that they should bow.

There was a lot of singing and give and take between Father and Mother. Mother sang at least three songs to Father and then asked Rev. Kwak to give a report. While Rev. Kwak was speaking, the KGB came again, demanding to see the organizer. They were told that it was myself. The officials complained that this was our second illegal meeting in one day. I asked what was illegal about eating cake and invited them to join us. As Rev. Kwak was finishing his report, the officials were shouting at me. They came back two or three times to Mother's floor during the night, but without any incident. Even the next morning, the hotel security would not allow our missionary brothers up to Mother's suite to say pledge.

Mother's party left the hotel without incident and quietly departed for Moscow. At the airport, we were able to exchange waves with Mother for several minutes until the plane took off. Considering all the difficulties that we encountered, it is hard to evaluate our experience. Maybe we can take to heart the comment of Mother's security guard Bob Smart, who said that when everything was over Mother was the happiest that he had seen her

since they came to Europe.

# Moscow, Russia November 21, 1993

FTER her visit to Kiev, Mother and her ntourage arrived in Moscow on the

morning of Sunday, November 21, 1993.

This was Mother's third visit to the capital of the former Soviet Union. Almost one year ago to the day, as part of her 1992 world speaking tour, Mother had addressed an overflow crowd at the famous Oktyabrskaya cinema. At that time, despite our members' best efforts, we were unable to secure the Kremlin's Palace of Congresses, but we promised Mother that next time she would speak in the Kremlin!

Nevertheless, this proved to be a monumental undertaking—virtually impossible. Because of the tense political situation following the October Revolution, the Kremlin was absolutely off-limits to any group that could be even remotely seen as religious or political. Added to this was the opposition by certain elements to having a "Moon organization" at the Kremlin.

The time before Mother's arrival was an unbelievable spiritual battle, as we tried to go through every channel, using every VIP contact we had, to rent the Kremlin. There were many "heart attack" situations, especially when the other theaters we had rented as back-ups suddenly canceled. Even four days before her arrival, we still had nowhere for Mother to speak!

Thanks to Heavenly Father's power, the impossible became possible, and on November 21 at 4 p.m. Mother walked out on the stage of the Kremlin Palace of Congresses before seven thousand people.

# Minsk, Belarus November 22, 1993

THE next morning, Monday, November 22, 1993, Mother and her entourage flew on to Minsk, Belarus, to speak to the women there. The event took place in the Grand Opera and Ballet Theatre and was attended by eight hundred people. Most

of the guests were women who work in state and public organizations dealing with the problems of the family, women and children, young people and education, such as: Ministry of Education (Family and Marriage Department), Association of Girl-Guides, Women's Christian-Democratic Party, Association of Mothers of Soldiers who Died in the Afghanistan War, and others. Some of them had attended Women's Federation for World Peace (WFWP) conferences that were held in the Crimea (Ukraine) and Moscow (Russia) in 1993.

All the money that we received from selling invitation tickets was donated to the Association of Parents that Have Crippled Children. The president of that association made a short speech of gratitude to Mother and WFWP.

Several universities from Minsk sent welcoming letters to Mother. Their rectors or vice-rectors attended the Conference for Rectors in Crimea in September 1993. Some of them are interested in teaching Divine Principle and "My World & I" in their courses at the universities.

When Mother arrived in Minsk, she was greeted personally at the airport by Mrs. Irina Kuzminichna Shushkevich, wife of the president of Belarus. Mrs. Shushkevich was very supportive during our preparations for Mother's coming. In May 1993, she attended the European conference of WFWP that was held in Germany. She had a nice experience there and was very interested in WFWP activities. Since that time we met with her several times in our CARP center.

Mr. Shushkevich attended the Summit Council for World Peace (SCWP) in Au-

gust 1992, in Seoul, Korea. Therefore both of them had contact with Mother before. The Shushkeviches let Mother use their car and security personnel. Mrs. Shushkevich met Mother at the airport, presented Mother with flowers and then escorted her to the government VIP residence for visiting heads of state. (The government residence was opened to Mother by Prime Minister Kebich. He attended International Leadership Seminars in Washington, D.C., in 1990.) Mrs. Shushkevich attended Mother's speech and after the speech presented her with flowers.

About one hundred brothers and sisters and guests from Minsk and the Baltic gathered for the celebration when the speech was over. It was really a great blessing for all of us to meet with Mother directly. For most of us this was the first time meeting her.

The next morning Mrs. Shushkevich came to the place where Mother stayed and talked with Mother for about an hour. Mother asked Mrs. Shushkevich to attend a Divine Principle workshop. Mother told Mrs. Shushkevich that there were different kinds of fortune and Mr. Shushkevich was really chosen by God and given such a great fortune and responsibility as the president of Belarus. However, he was chosen not because of his personal qualities, though he used to be the rector of Belorussian State University and was fa-

# Lisbon, Portugal November 24, 1993

THIS was Mother's first visit to Portugal. Our goal was to fill the fivehundred capacity hall in Lisbon and bring one hundred VIP guests. In the end, the hall was totally full, with forty people standing, and around eighty VIPs were in attendance.

A woman professor from the University of Vila Real introduced Mother in a beautiful, poetic way. She described Mother as a unique

woman, someone who is making great efforts for world peace and an exemplary mother, wife and woman.

During her speech, Mother was moved to tears. At the victory celebration, after Mother and Father sang, Mother gave tearful guidance to the Portuguese members about the suffering heart of Heavenly Father and True Parents and the need for repentance and redetermination to bring spiritual children. After Mother cut the victory cake and left the hall, Rev. Kwak talked about the meaning of the Completed Testament era and urged us to follow Mother's direction and witness intensively.

On the following day, before leaving Portugal, Mother visited the Tower of Belem, the place from which Portuguese navigators left for voyages of discovery during the fifteenth century. # Madrid, Spain November 25, 1993

VER five hundred people came to listen to Mother's speech, held in the Princess Hotel, in downtown Madrid. In the audience there were around a hundred fifty VIP's, fifty parents and relatives of

Mother was introduced by Isabel Gutierrez Zuloaga, who gave a very direct and heartistic testimony about Mother. The head of the Education Department at Madrid University, Professor Gutierrez had attended the 1992 inauguration of Women's Federation for World Peace in

Mother's speech went perfectly. There were minor technical problems, but they didn't affect the flow of the program. Even though there were five labor demonstrations in downtown Madrid, people came early, and by the time the program was to start the room was quite full. Ten minutes later, the room was packed. People followed Mother's speech attentively, and she spoke in a very dignified way. Guests had only positive comments about Mother and her speech.

The celebration after the speech was quite special. Half of the people attending were not church members. In the audience there was a Catholic priest, the head of the

Federation of Protestant Churches in Spain, another Baptist minister, three Hare Krishnas, a Catholic theologian and many parents and relatives of members of the Unification family. They merged perfectly in the joyful atmosphere, with no difference between members and non-members. We all cheered the same manseis.

At breakfast the next day, Mother commented that the guests at the celebration were listening very carefully. She said that the Hare Krishnas didn't even blink their eyes, and that I should witness to them.

People were truly impressed by the event. The director of religious programming on national television told us that he didn't expect us to manage such a large and successful gathering. He told us we should have made it more public, using national television.

A Jesuit priest who attended the program wrote a story for one of the major newspapers. In it were only positive comments and quotes from Mother's speech. This same priest had been quite critical of our church when we first met him a couple of years ago, but somehow Mother's presence and speech melted him.

To receive Mother meant the fulfillment of a life dream and the starting point for a new development of our church. All members felt united in the desire to accomplish much more for our True Parents in the coming years.

# Prague, Czech Republic November 27, 1993

SINCE Prague was the final city of the European section of Mother's 1993 world tour we were privileged to host many European leaders and members, who were invited to participate in the inauguration and celebration meeting the following day. This international participation gave a great international feeling to the event and this was especially important to our native brothers and sisters.

Mother's coming was the first time True Parents had visited our nation. She arrived in the Prague airport at 11:20 a.m. to a blue sky and cold air. Her calm, beautiful smile brought the balm of peace and confidence to our rather overwhelmed feelings.

The day before Mother's arrival many planes were rescheduled because of fog. When she landed, the weather was fine, but two hours later all of Prague was covered with a heavy icy rain and all planes were rescheduled to land in other airports. This happened to some of our guests coming from out of the country.

Preparation for this event started in August, when we began a national fortyday pioneering condition in hope of Mother's yet unscheduled visit. All members were mobilized to pioneer new cities, work on the Mobile Fundraising Team, witnessing teams and New Hope teams. This concluded in an all-membership meeting. After we finished this period the dates of Mother's visit were set and we did two additional forty-day periodsone for all the preparation and another one for mobilization in order to fill the hall. All preparations turned out to be exactly one hundred twenty days. We were sure that our greatest potential for guests were the family members and friends of our brothers and sisters, so our main effort was focused on them.

The Atrium Hotel, a newly built modern hotel in the center of Prague, was the site of the event. The capacity of its congress hall is fifteen hundred. With the support of many European leaders and members coming to Prague for the final European meeting, we had a great deal of hope about filling the hall. Since a good

number of VIPs, particularly from several ministries, and even top government officials planned to come, we expected a great result

Four days before our great event a major newspaper started a slanderous attack against the Women's Federation for World Peace and the Unification Church. Then the national television picked up the stories and broadcast them twice in the same day. Several radio stations did as well. We understand this was a well-planned attack from an institute with international connections, aiming to destroy our event. The organizers are well-known to us. This began a fierce battle, mobilizing the nation against our providential schedule.

Many of us were scared, since we had never experienced such negative coverage. The members of many ministries were banned from attending by pressure from "above" as they told us. The entertainers, the invocator, the introducer and the person to give thanks canceled. We are grateful for the last minute replacements who saved our program and made it even more beautiful.

The turnout was almost seventeen hundred guests including fifty-four VIPs—among them sixteen ambassadors (including the ones from both North and South Korea who met with Rev. Kwak at the VIP reception). Despite the ban, some ministries were represented and many others apologized. The first lady, Mrs. Havlova, sent a congratulatory greeting, though we didn't read it publicly.

It was surely with God's help that we

# Istanbul, Turkey November 28, 1993

IN Istanbul, we filled all the seats, with over four hundred people. The guests came mainly through women's organizations. One, the Turkish Mothers' Association, sent one hundred fifty people. We had messages from the minister of state for Women, Family and Social Services, and from the mayor of greater Istanbul.

Mrs. Ozal, former first lady, introduced Mother, but she left early, together with several other front-row people she had brought. This encouraged a number of others to leave, causing real distress to Mother, who called Father after the speech, but did not hold any public meeting or celebration. Rev. Kwak said it was the first time she had faced this sort of reality. He recognized that the speech simply was too much for many who came. They could be offended as Muslims, or as secularists they could be put off by the heavily religious nature of the speech. Nevertheless, among those who remained, many were very positive, and there is

much work to be done in follow up.

More than thirty Bulgarian members came, and Rev. Kwak spent time with them after the program, for a celebration.

# Jerusalem, Israel November 30, 1993

We knew we were heading into "heavy weather" before Mother's arrival in Jerusalem. The Chief Rabbinate of Israel had threatened to revoke the kosher license from the Holiday Inn if they held the event there. This was a serious threat, because to lose such a license would be death to the hotel. The Holiday Inn refused to let us use the hall, but Mother did stay there.

Members desperately looked for an alternative site, out of the reach of the Rabbinate. This led to a recently opened hotel, the Ambassador, in East (Arab) Jerusalem. The contract for the room was signed the night before we arrived.

In the meantime, the Orthodox Jews had taken it upon themselves to organize a major protest at the Holiday Inn. Through their newspaper, they called for twelve hundred protesters, and they were given a police permit for their demonstration. A few hundred people showed up to demonstrate at the hotel where the speech wasn't held.

The mass media of Israel announced that the meeting had been canceled. A couple of our speakers and many participants took this as the truth and stayed

away. We called as many of our contacts about the change as possible, but quite a few Jewish guests were reluctant to go to the Arab quarter. For those who came to the Holiday Inn, we provided buses to take them to the Ambassador Hotel.

About a hundred people turned up at the Ambassador. The videotape was screened on a white sheet. The introduction was given by a nice but rather informal poetess, and the audience listened quietly to Mother.

After her experience in Istanbul, Mother was quite prepared for a difficult time, and the celebration afterwards was in good spirits. In both Istanbul and Jerusalem, however, Mother spoke with great seriousness about the lack of local members, and said that the only conclusion was that the members did not have a high enough standard for God to be able to work through them.

An article in the *Jerusalem Post* the next day was quite respectful. It quoted an "anti-cult expert" (!) who said the event was a draw: we got to hold our meeting, while the opposition prevented it from happening in the Holiday Inn.

Twelve Jewish members from abroad came to Israel to help, and they are forming a group to support our activities there in the future.

In these four countries in our region, Mother met the roots of the three monotheistic religions, as well as the base for secularism (Hellenism). She persevered and overcame all obstacles with love. I consider the outcome tremendous.

On October 30, In Jin Nim held a His-





# Not without sacrifice

Kook Jin Nim had spoken on November 20 to a full hotel ballroom on Long Island, where guests were moved and in-

guired about our community. He afterwards told the small Long Island church that, "We are like the first century Christians and we must multiply quickly." Then on December 12 he traveled to Louisville, Kentucky, in preparation to give the Sunday morning speech in the large church of Rev. Elliot. He had been sick and as he flew into Louisville from Cincinnati, Ohio, he became quite ill on the plane. An ambulance met the plane and rushed him to the hospital where he was diagnosed with a gallstone which had moved, causing infection and a high fever. Much to the amazement of Rev. Elliot, Kook Jin Nim called him from the hospital to apologize that the speech had to be cancelled. Soon Ju Nim (Kook Jin Nim's wife) and Hyun Iin Nim flew to Louisville to be with him. By Monday morning Kook Jin Nim was feeling better and eight days later he flew back to New York, being transferred to a Manhattan hospital for another week until the danger point had passed.

Hyun Jin Nim pointed out to the local members, "We have to pray for True Parents—for their safety and health—ten years ago Heung Jin Nim sacrificed his life around this same time. This is the end of the first year of the Completed Testament Age, and Satan really wants to keep us from a victory."

# **Tears for their Parents**

The genuine love of the True Family for their Parents and their deep respect for the path of persecution was communicat-

ed by every True Family member who delivered the speech. Tears flowed and voices cracked as they identified with True Parents' painful course. Un Jin Nim, the third daughter, commented during one delivery, "I can talk about anything else, but not my parents." In Manhattan where she spoke to five hundred in the chapel of the headquarters church, In Jin Nim's many tears touched hearts everywhere. A member commented that the emotional presentation "crested a deep revival-type experience." Another member commented, "Since members have not had much opportunity to see the True Children in action, this gave us a chance to appreciate their capabilities and heart."

# Campuses hear the message

Kwon Jin Nim, eighth child of our True Parents and a freshman at Boston University, gave the speech at Yale University in Connecticut. Yale Law School is the alma mater of both Presidents Bush and Clinton, so it seemed a fitting place for a son of True Parents to deliver the proclamation of his parents with intensity and emotion. After the speeches, his younger brother Young Jin Nim came onto the stage and embraced his brother, expressing a powerful testimony of love within the True Family. The Yale Daily News campus newspaper sent a reporter and photographer to the event; this resulted in a positive article.

On November 7, Jin Sung Nim spoke at the Hyatt Regency in Cambridge, Massachusetts, and on November 21 he spoke at a rally at Boston University. CARP members at Boston University stated, "To invite True Family to speak on our campus has been our dream—a long-held dream, in fact, passed down way back from the first pioneers of Boston CARP."

Boston is the area where many of the True Children are pursuing their education. Therefore, the members decided to be "bold and courageous" and drop a truth bomb on campus in the form of a powerfully striking poster with Father's

face and an article entitled "What If?", challenging the reader to think of Father's accomplishments and ask the question, "What if he is who he says he is?"

Members also placed this poster as ads in campus newspapers. It caused controversy which in the end led college officials to defend our advertising as being straightforward and something we are entitled to.

At this rally, Jin Sung Nim spoke to an audience of four hundred fifty students who were more receptive than expected. Everyone felt heaven's victory when the Boston University campus paper reported on the front page, "Moon speaks on Family Stability," and captured the very essence of the speech.

# Even the high school students shared in the efforts

Sun Jin Nim, a senior at Buckingham, Brown, and Nichols school in Cambridge, Massachusetts, is the ninth child of our True Parents. The large picturesque Anglican Episcopal Church in Brooklyn was the place of her debut as a young but powerful speaker. Her sincerity and depth of heart moved both members and guests. Significant to note is that the Brooklyn members had spent the week prior to the event cleaning the fine old church from top to bottom to the awe of the pastor, elders and custodians.

Young Jin Nim, tenth child of the True Parents and a sophomore at Groton Academy in Massachusetts, decided that he, too, would give the speech. In fact, he flew to Louisville, Kentucky, where his

Sometimes in the midst of busy schedules, classes, and unforeseen events such as illness, changes had to be made. The True Family members and husbands and wives filled in for each other when necessary. When Hyo Jin Nim was prevented from speaking due to a sore throat on Children's Day, November 14, his wife, Nan Sook Nim, delivered the speech in Korean to the Korean-American members in New York.

Then, in the afternoon at 3:00 she delivered the speech again in Japanese to the Japanese Church members and guests. One of the sisters who was helping to serve said, "She gave the speech in Korean to the Korean congregation,

then she came upstairs and had lunch with her four children, after which she went back downstairs and gave the speech in Japanese by sheer practice and memorization, since she does not speak Japan-

ese. Japanese members were much impressed with her ability to pronounce the words and give the speech beautifully and with great dignity."

Nan Sook Nim also gave the speech in

the Mohr Faith Baptist Church in Hayward, California, and in Los Angeles the following day.

Jun Sook Nim, wife of Hyun Jin Nim, gave her first speech in Maryland on November 13 at the New Hope Academy (a Unification Church school). The Landover Hills community of Prince George's County prepared for the speech with five letters of welcome from public officials who applauded and commended the commitment to promoting family values as a means of healing our society. Afterwards Jun Sook Nim gave internal guidance to members, including telling them that purity was most important.

Soon Ju Nim, wife of Kook Jin Nim, who is studying education, spoke in Queens, New York, at the LaGuardia Ramada Inn on November 27. One member said her delivery was "graciousness compressed."

As Mother winds up her worldwide tour and True Children complete the forty speech tour of America, there is a heartfelt gratitude in each of us that they have taken so much responsibility to proclaim the message. As we enter the new year, may we too take up the responsibility and carry this message deeper into the heart of our country.


