## Our Master Continues His World Tour

(After seeing many dignitaries including ex-president Eisenhower)

Our Master started His world tour on January 28, 1965 from Seoul, Korea. He blessed many Sacred Ground sites in Japan, and spent His birthday with our Japanese families in Tokyo. On February 12 He left for the United States; for San Francisco, California. On April 2, He observed the meaningful "Parent's Day" with foreign families in Washington, D.C. He visited each chapel and center and the three missionary headquarters; San Francisco, California; Washington, D.C. and Portland, Oregon. Alto ether, 55 Sacred Ground sites were blessed as God's Holy Sites in the United States. This heavenly ceremony is the first event since the fall of man in the Restoration Providence Course. Thus, our Heavenly family have noticed His Work and His Lordship over the world and the universe. He made strong ground for us to follow and fight against Satan and win the victory over Satan.

After He returned to Washington, D.C., He spent three months fulfilling many significant things for this nation, for our future work and for the world. He also observed "The Day of All Things" with the American families in Washington, D.C. He instructed His followers to set up "more than 12 foreign missionary headquarters other than the United States within this year of 1965". Along this line, we must work hard not to miss the heavenly blessed chance to restore the foreign lands to laster; to "His Coming Kingdom" or "The Kingdom of Our Master". For 3 months He, Himself, participated in many programs in re-training the American workers in preparation to send several missionaries to Europe, Japan, the Hiddle Host, Retin Macerica, Australia, and other nations.

After setting up a strong foot-hold for our family, and before His departure for His continuing world tour. He shared His precious time for one hour with ex-president Eisenhower at Ir. Eisenhower's Gettysburg home. This interview was held on June 25, which was the anniversary of the Korean War.

Our Master discussed with Mr. Eisenhover crucial subjects such as:

- 1. "How to conquer the world prevailing communism?"

  It is possible only by the ideological superiority, not by force or weapon, Master emphasized.
- 2. "The problems of young peoples moral corruption."
  This can be solved by this Hovement of loving our Heavenly Father (God).
- The mission of the United States as a leader of the nations can be fulfilled successfuly by unifying all religions to One, and make a united front line to fight against Communism. If this nation fails, there will be severe internal conflicts and religious wars shall emerge leading Communism to victory over the whole world.

Our liaster especially emphasized in the interview with exPresident Eisenhower that "Our United Faith Movement" hed by
Him has all the answers and He asked Mr. Eisenhower to cotoperate with Our Movement which is marching on a world-wide
scale. He showed much evidence and scrap books to Mr.
Eisenhower on the Holy Marriage of the 124 young couples and
of other significant activities over a period of 12 years in
Seoul, Korea. Mr. Eisenhower, who is very much impressed with
Our Master, promised to cooperate with our Master's work and
this movement. Thus, the King of kings and a worldy king,
(ex-president of theUnited States) had a significant interview
which lasted one hour at Gettysburg on June 25. Now Our
Master is continuing His world tour.

How grateful I am to at last have the opportunity to send greetings and my love to my Heavenly Family in Korea. I long for the day that I can walk among you and greet you in person.

Receiving this baton gives me an opportunity to reflect upon God's miracle in placing me in the right place at the right time 3 years ago this month so that I could meet His messenger, now my beloved sister in this faith, Mrs. Eileen Welch. Through the love from God that she brought, I have after years of seeking, found His love and the faith and hope to live each day for Him. I found from experience that to live for the material things of life or even for our families that we love, leaves only emptiness and a longing for the love that can come only from our Heavenly Father. With this Divine Love comes responsibility. This is the responsibility to give this love to manking.

To most of mankind, life is only a day to day existence.

Our young people are losing hope for their future at a very young age. They are pushed into society unprepared by parents desiring their children to be socially accepted by the worlds standards, but completely disregarding God's standards. They may struggle and seek love and happiness for a time, but give up in despair when their efforts only bring temporary happiness. They do not realize that real love only comes from God, and that they are seeking from the world something the world cannot give. With disillusionment comes resentment - many times resentment towards God. A young woman once said to me "Where was God when I needed Him? Why did He let me down?" I could not help asking her if God had let her down or if she had let Him down. She is a young woman that spiritually knows that Our Lord is on

earth and that God is restoring mankind. But she felt she would have to give up the things of the world to follow Him. So I ask you, did God fail her or did she fail Him? Her rejection has brought alcholism and desperation into her life. This is what her love of the things of the world brought to her when she could have had Divine Love from our Heavenly Father.

Jesus of Nazareth said, "Seek ye first the Kingdom of God and all these things shall be added". In seeking the Kingdom of God FIRST, the desire for the things of the world pass away in the joy of experiencing His love.
