THE NEW AGE FRONTIERS

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Re-Incarnation

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Frequently we come across those who believe in the theory sf Re-incarnation. It is most pathetic that this one minor doctrine often blinds them from seeing the whole truth. I want you to prepare more fully on this question and help them with the light of truth by a logical and consistent explanation.

The theory of Re-incarnation can be traced to early stages of mankind. Particularly Hindus and Buddhists have held the doctrine for many, many centuries. It is probable that the Western world has become familiar with it through the channels of Oriental influences especially the Yogis and Theosophists, both of whom have imported much of their literature into Western countries in the last 50 years.

Incarnation means the entering of the soul into the body of flesh but once. Re-incarnation is the belief that the soul has successive bodies of flesh and, therefore, many lives upon the earth.

The doctrine of reincarnation fa concerned with the evolution of the soul and the Karmie Law. The evolution of the soul is presumed to be effected by repeated incarnations in successive physical personalities. Each time it resumes a body of flesh after a rest, the duration of which depends on its evolutionary progress from 11 months to 50P years. The soul is drawn to sursoundings which its own past has made necessary for its further advancement. In the Karmie Law of cause and effect it is claimed that the consequences of every act must be discharged in this or some future life on earth,

Reincarnationists seek answers to questions such as follows: Why is one person so well placed in life given every advantage that money and culture can confer, while another person is born into very difficult circumstances, where it seems k impossible to make any advance in life? Why is one child born a cripple, or born blind, while another child arrives in this world with a healthy body. Why does one child live to a ripe old age, whereas another child dies after only a few days? Men and women are not born free and equal but start this life like horses in a handicap race -- no two bearing an equal burden.

Now, why should this be, if indeed God is loving, just and all-powerful? The reincarnationists would answer and say: You are reaping today, for good or evil, the results of the seeds that you have sown during the course of many previous lives. Many times you have been a man, and many times you have been a woman. Some of those who are at the bottom of our social ladder today have walked the earth as kings, and presidents, and generals, and admirals, and high priests; and some who now sit in the seats of the mighty, surrounded by pomp and circumstance, have toiled as simple peasants in days gone by, pulled at the oar of a galley, or worn the chains of the slave.

We do not agree with the reincarnationists on this point, because material wealth, good environment, physical comfort, the highest education, prestige and power are not true blessings in the ultimate sense of spiritual value. Moses gave up an easy and comfortable life in an Egyptian palace and became a shepherd to be closer to God. Buddha left his palace, and became an ascetic, forsaking his position as a prince in order to seek p spiritual enlightenment. St. Francis of Assisi gave up his wealth and became a friar do follow Jesus. Thomas Aquinas gave up his rank of nobility and became a humble monk to seek spiritual truth. Father Damien chose to go to Moltoki island to live with and teach the leperous. Albert Schweitzer chose to live with the primitive Africans to serve them with Christian love, giving up a good position and a high standard of living. Helen Keller, though blind, deaf and dumb, achieved the highest academic goal and obtained spiritual light and peace in her heart. Many people turn to God and find inner joy and high purpose in life after a serious illness or accident. Why? Because an easy life and comfortable environment are often a hinderance to one's spiritual growth. It is true that man's extremety is God's opportunity.

The reincarnationists contradict themselves in saying, "Those who are at the bottom sfour social ladder today have walked the earth as kings, generals, and high priests. Who then wishes to be high in rank and power and enjoy pleasure and luxury in this life, if they are to go down in the new life? The explanation of the reincarnationist concerning the reason for the amount of injustice in this world is self-contradictory. Let us remember the warning given in the Bible, that "the sins of the fathers shall be visited upon the children unto the third and fourth generations." We reap either good or bad according to what oar fathers have sown. Understanding this we should learn and try to sow only good for our descendants. However, the differences in human lots are often relative things which can bring one either blessing or misery, depending upon one's own choice and efforts. Let us remember the words of Jesus, "Blessed are you that hunger now, for you shall be satisfied. Blessed are you that weep now, for you shall laugh. " If difficulties and adversity often turn one to God then physical well-being is not necessarily an absolute blessing.

The reincarnationists would say that we are here to develop spiritually, that is, to acquire a full understanding of and control over our mentality; and that this is difficult to do in one lifetime. Therefore we must come back many times to this earth to learn more. Why cannot one finish learning in one life time? Their explanation centers on man's laziness and inertia; on his reluctance to change himself radically, to adopt new ideas; on man's conservativism and tendency to self-satisfaction; and above all, on his ignorance of his own unlimited potentialities.

These reasons for reincarnation contradict the following facts: 1). The majority of the people in this world are still lazy and inactive with regard to their spiritual growth and are still reluctant to change themselves. What lessons have they learned in their many previous lives? If they have not learned anything in the previous lives, what is the sense of coming back again? 2) Every child starts to learn from complete. ignorance. There is no evidence that anyone brings with him the acquired knowledge and experiences of his former lives. What is the point of coming back again and again to start all over, 3). According to the law of the spirit world there are inuumerable spheres and regions for our evolution, and we get opportunities for improvement, but not by being once more **bound** to the same kind of form - a physical body. What a poor place our earth would be without the hope of a better world to come or reunion with those whom we love. The theory of reincarnation ignores God's design for the blessed eternal spiritual heaven where the road of evolution lies open before us after physical death. It is for us to tread, if we wish to, in order to learn the things that we have failed to grasp on earth.

According to the claims of reincarnation, many disembodied souls are constantly returning to start another live on earth. If this were true, then we should not be able to communicate with them in spirit. Yet not only have the saints and martyrs come back and given evidence of personality, but many souls who made \neq serious mistakes during their earth life have also come back to tell people of the opportunities provided in the spirit world for advancement. Those who contact Jesus today learned that reincarnation is a false concept.

We have not the faintest recollection of a former existence. The reincarnationists would explain that this away by saying that people are already prone to worry and grieve foolishly over the past events of this life, and if they had the material of many lives to handle in this way they would destroy themselves very **quickly**. Hence, they say, nature has drawn a veil of forgetfulness over our beginnings on this plane, and for excellent reasons she hides away the memory of previous lives.

We are to reap in this life what we have sown in the former lives, Why are we held responsible for what about which we have not the faintest idea?

The reincarnationists again contradict themselves by saying that the whole history of all our past lives is stored away in the deeper levels of our **subgconscious**, and thus it is that our mentality today -- and **consequently our** destiny -- is the logical outcome of all the lives that we have lived up to the **present**.

. The impressions and experiences of **our** early childhood are stored up deep in **our** subconscious, and may affect our mentality to a degree. Also during the time the physical body is asleep, the spiritual self is free to travel in other lands and in other places, which **we** may not remember at all when awake. These two factors can account for the remembrance of places and people outside the **consciousness** of the material mind.

As proof of reincarnation, the adherents of this theory cite the case case of the woman who, whenever she read ancient history, would invariably remeber the events about which she was reading. A "memory" of this type occurs when a cooperating spirits enforce or strengthen the mental images invariably created while reading. Swedenborg, a great psychi and revelator, explains this, saying, "If a spirit were to speak from his own memory with a man, the man would not know otherwise than that the thoughts then in his mind were his own, although they were the spirit's thoughts. This would be like the recollection of something wheih the man had never heard or seen.... This comes from an influx from the memory of spirits into their ideas of thought. "

The doctrine of reincarion denies the influence of **one's** heritage. No one ever inherits anything from his parents or his ancestors.

This view contradicts the history of the chosen people in the Bible. When Abraham made a mistake, his descendants were required to pay indemnity for it and suffered in Egypt as slaves, When Jacob fulfilled God's dispensation, his descendants were chosen to be the blessed instrument of God. This is the pattern of operation of God's providence throughout the history of God's chosen people. What our ansestors sow, we inherit, whether good or bad. This is biblically true, historically plain, and empirically factual. Therefore we have the privilege of fulfilling the good our ancestors have started and making up that which they have failed. We als are also responsible for laying a good foundation for our descendants and leaving them a good heritage. Reincarnation claims to explain the differences in talents which we find between one man and another. Differences in talent, like differences in opportunity are the result of our activities in other lives. Child prodigies are always souls who have acquired their proficiency in previous life.

Let us offer anfother explanation. The talents of children can be traced, back to similarly talented parents or ancestors. Often such talented people are trained invisibly by artists in spirit who desire to see their work continued for the good and the enjoyment of mankind. We call this the succession of missions in the Divine Principles. Naturally those spirit artists would fook out for the bodies and minds that seem most suitable for their artistic purposes. Often someone may never sho^wany artistic talent when all of a sudden, there it is! People wonder, saying: "Is it possible; it has never occurred before! Where can it have come from?""

This phenomenon may be called "inspiration^M -- work done by spirit guidance through carefully handled instruments. In order to fulfill their mission, departed artists, musicians, or $d \phi c$ poets find rapport with people who have ssme traits or interests and descend and cooperate with them in their development and performance.

If reincarnation had been a fact through the ages, should we not find evidence of it in a **goodly portion** of perfected souls smong us? But there is no evidence of such supermen or perfected souls.

The physical body is an overcoat for the spirit body; all through earth life you are building the spirit body; when you pass from the physical plane, you throw off the overcoat. The spirit body is only a form for the soul to manifest through -- the Theosophists would say 'an astral shell.'

When realization of the change from the physical takes place, the soul still holds the old ideak which it had in the physical existence. Spirit bodies can be of very coarse material or they can be of very fine vibration. Those with coarse vibration and strong physical attractions may sometimes be seen, as in haunted houses,

When one who has learned to build the spiritual body through understanding passes from the physical, the spiritual body has light and strength, and when the awakening comes, such professes a soul progresses.

Some people sit and meditate to be spiritual and to become 'masters.' To sit in the silence and meditate is dangerous; one often contact\$ the neutral gray sphere and becomes negative, losing contact with the world. In this state you often see nothing and are aware of nothing, since that is the condition of the next sphere, which is also a place of rest. This gray sphere, the astral plane, is real, but spirits do not progress there, There are many kinds of spirits in the gray, neutral condition; it is a laboratory and spirits there have not yet strength or power.

The first stage in this sphere is a gray, negative state; the second stage is one in which the departed spirit wakens to a realization of a change and must decide about development.

The first and second states are conditions in which old ideas are thrown off. If you are ignorant of the spirit world, you think only of your earthly home and go back to be near earth life.

Instead of being helpful, the doctrine of reincarnation is very dangerous, since earthlyminded individuals with strong attractions to the physical world, may learn of the theory of reincarnation and fix firmly in their minds the determination to reincarnate again and seek for a chance to reincarnate but with the sole result of becoming lodged in the aura of some person sensitive to spirit encroachment, thereby causing great distress to the victims of such obsession.

Very often the aches and pains which doctors classify as psychosomatic occur because of this spirit obsession. If an individual, say, who has been crippled all his earthly life, makes the transition to the spirit world with little or no knowledge of life there, he may very well believe that he is still crippled. It was to these conditions of mind that Mary Baker Eddy was referring when she brought **Sorth** the concept of "mortal mind." Illness and disease do not exist in the spirit world except as an individual believes himself to be ill. Our physical body, however, still suffer from Satan's attacks; from this condition we cannot escape until we "have paid the last penny," that is, made the final payment of indemnity. The crippled individual mentioned above may be attracted to the earth sphere, especially if he believes in reincarnation, and possess some child. Due to the influence of the "crippled" mind of the spirit, the child thinks himself crippled and becomes so, when actually there is no physical cause for such malformation. Only when the spirit is removed from the aura of the child, or in Biblical terminology, "cast out," will the child be "healed."

An individual who believes in reincarnation may become self-satisfied with his life if it is a properous one, for he will believe that he is receiving the rewards from his past lives of effort. One may also become fatalistic, believing that he is caught in the web of circumstances woven in past lives. It is important to realize that what we do NOW determines our life and character in the spirit world, for we are forming our spirit body. It is just as important to know that we are not the products of our actions in past lives but that we are all victims of Satan. Whether rich or poor, we must not focus our attention on our surroundings and situation but on our re-lationship to God. We must strive to be victorious over Satan and become true children of God.

The doctrine of reincarnation destroys the belief in natural spiritual progression; too much stress and importance is placed upon this brief mortal life. The doctrine that we **must return** again and **again** to earth life to become perfected is equivalent to saying that, after one has

passed through kindergarten, grade schools and university, he must return to kindergarten over and over again. What is mortal life but a kindergarted? Too little is credited to the vaster opportunities of the next school in the spiritual realm.

The entire scheme of reincarnation is a limited idea, one that fails to recognize that this is a formative plane and that there are many levels and schools on the Invisible Side which offer far greater opportunities for one's development than does this mortal plane. There is no need of returning in physical form when we can progress from sphere to sphere, or school to school in spirit,

Through the Divine Principles and spiritual communication we find that a spirit who realizes his condition and understands progression is not interested in reincarnation; to try to reincarnate in a physical body on this earth again would be very foolish. But very few spirits seek for the spirit world when they **pass out**. Some spirits who *have* gone beyond the veil of death are in the dark, some are in semi-darkness, some are in twilight, some in the light. The ones who have found the light are those who understand, who have knowledge of life in spirit; these would never think of coming back to earth again in physical bodies.

They come back as spirits, to be invisible teachers, to guide and help humanity. **This might** be called a "reincarnation" of the soul, but without physical birth; it is only a temporary measure. It is not reincarnation in the flesh, but a return in spirit, to help and serve. They can come back to those whom they love and help them in many ways when they know the laws governing such return.

The spirit of Madam Blavatsky, who introduced the doctrine of reincarnation to the Western world, speaking through a medium, said of the theory of reincarnation: "I see now that my teachings caused many to become psychic sensitives and that the theory of reincarnation causes much obsession. I also taught that one should be a vegetarian, but the majority live under too great **a** nervous tension for this and become too sensitive." "I have found that 'reincarnation' is possible only through obsession, and I have also found, to my great sorrow, that many of my followers become obsessed." "It is dangerous to teach the theory of reincarnation because many selfish people, who come to the other side of life. look for what they consider the right place to reincarnate but they do not understand obsession and therefore disturb and obsess children. That is one reason there are so many idiot children in the asylums." "I was a psychic when in earth life and I knew spirits could come back and control mortals. I realize now that if I had taught the truth of spirit return, it would have been much better." "We cannot progress to the higher life of understanding with a falsehood on our minds; an understanding of the truth is necessary." "World travelers, missionaries, authors and lecturers alike bear testimony that in India, where belief in reincarnation is general, cases of obsession and possession are exceedingly prevalent."

An ancient Indian teacher speaking through a medium, said of India with relation to the doctrine of reincarnation; "this perversion of a great truth into a maligned superstition has become a source of the most pestilent spiritual mischief." "There is one effect of the doctrine of reincarnation that is felt with direful power in the spiritual world of India, Myriads who have left the physical life hover over the mortal's of that country seeking for opportunities to become re=embodied, in order that they may realize the promised relief from their imperfect development in the former earth life. They are earth-bound to a degree that infects the mental atmosphere of its people with almost hopeless despair, for however intense may be their desire, they are never able to obtain the fancied reincarnation." "Could India emancipate herself from the tyranny of the idea of reincarnation, she would rise in the scale of spiritual enlightenment far higher than she rose in the age of the Vedas or when Gautama led her hosts toward the heavenly paradise. She must do this or she must remain the prey to vile superstitions, and her moral nature be degraded by the mental influx of myriad hosts who strive in vain to realize the truth of the dogma."

In conclusion it is the Divine Principle that a spirit-man can reach perfection only in conjunction with a physical body, because God had designed man to become perfect while in his physical life. Because of this principle all spirit-men who have gone on before, who are still imperfect, are destined to return to contact earth people, not to reincarnate, in order to advance to the state of perfect. The theory of reincarnation is, therefore, a misunderstanding and a misinterpretation of this phenomenon of spirit descent. Those spirits who try to reincarnate in physical bodies only 'cause spirit obsession or possession, a vile result completely contrary to the law of spirit return.

Dear Miss Kim: Today I heard many people witness. As I listened, I was reminded of my own life which led me up to this wanderful message and new life. As I look back, each feeling, person, and event seem very significant to me now. My parents had no religious background. Testimony: After being a nominal non-church-going Christian for most of my life, I had a conversion experience in Feb. 1960. From that time on I had visions in which I both saw and conversed with Jesus. It was some months before I realized that this was a special gift\$ I thought it went with becoming a Christian,

Within a year, Jim and I joined the local Baptist church, and I went to work on the **staff** as the Pastor's Assistant. We **also** became active in the Yoke-fellow movement, a spiritual growth organization which meets in small groups and attempts to combine psychological analysis with Christian synthesis. We both became Yokefellow leaders and were deeply involved in church and Yokefellow activities to the virtual exclusion of all else.

In March of this year I had what I labelled "a disturbing vision", in which Jesus cried, foretold the end of the world, and was generally not as he had been in previous visions. Although it passed my long-established safeguards far authenticity, I determined that the vision should be ignored. I also stopped trying to make contact.

We had been exposed to the theory of reincarnation and **karma** which began to **sound more** and more plausible; we joined the Rosicrucians; and I began burdening my adult Sunday **School** class with my views of the non-existence of evil.

On Junly 30th, my meditation period produced the first vision since March and my first contact with someone other than Jesus, My assumption was that he was a Master of the Far East, since his features were Oriental and he was dressed in a long, rather straight robe. Among other things, he told me that "help is on the way." Five days later, Galen Pumphrey made his first appearance at our Sunday School class.

Galen and Jim had been next door neighbors in Bonner Springs, Kansas, when they were children, and Galen lost no time in renewing the acquaintance. Since we were always on the lookout for "enlightened" people who were ready to hear about our interesting collection of half-truths(reincarnation, et al), it was rather touch and go to see who was going to gat in the first licks. Galen won, thank God! Jim came home repeating fascinating and tantalizing bits of Galen's conversation and we promptly made arrangements for Miss Kim to speak at a small group meeting on August 9th.

We heard half of the Principles that night, the rest (except for the conclusion) the next day, and came home with a book a piece and a firm determination to keep an open mind. I finished reading the book two days later and promptly went into meditation. My question was "Whom do I follow? What do I believe?" For the first time in five months, Jesus appeared again. After a warm greeting, he led me into a small room and said, "You must now follow he who has been guiding you." Waiting for us was the same man who had told me help was on the way. I asked him who he was, He said, "I am the Sun and Moon. You are my star. You will must meet my bride." A most beautiful Oriental woman welcomed me to the Holy Family and announced, "My husband will guide you in your life problems. He will help you in wisdom. I will help you in the matters of everyday, in the small problems of living with which mothers have always helped their children."

It was several days later that I learned what had happened in 1960, and *a* week or more before the pictures in Miss Kim's room confirmed my identification of "The Master" and "Lady Moon."

Needless to say, there's no question in my mind that the Principles are right, and that there is an immense amount of work to be done. I feel highly privileged to be entrusted with so precious a mission, however small my part may be in it.

I was raised a Methodist in the Midwest. As soon as I was old enough to exercise my free will, I dropped Sunday School and Church as a regular thing, returning on occasion as a spectator but generally following a worldly course with all that implies. In April, 1960, my wife and I dés decided(something somewhat reluctantly on my part) to begin to seek a church connection as sort of something we should do. Strangely, T seemed to be immediately struck with vague anxieties and elusive fears which continued to drag me down to a point about 9 months later that can only be described as a personal Hell. I quiit my job, running from I knew not what, seeking a seemingly just as elusive answer to the problem that was myself.

In November of 1960, I found a new job and began an association with Yokefellow, a spiritual growth group organization in aur local church. Immediately I began an upturn in spiritual understanding and self awareness. My whole religious outlook took on a new meaning and broader vision. I grew emotionally and spiritually during the next two and one half years.

However. as I grew, many spiritual things remained unanswered and new questions came up demanding answers which Yokefellow and the Church seemed not to even begin to touch on except in some mysterious and elusive way. My wife and I became interested in the revelation of Edgar Cayce and the idea of reincarnation which seemed to answer much, we read searchingly about the Dead Sea Scrolls, we decided to pursue Rosicrucianism, we read books on the secret disclosures to be gained from Yogi-type meditation. The more we searched the more questions seemed to come up.

Through Emmet Fox' writings I thought I had discovered a path through Metaphysics which, through study, would give me the breakthrough I longed for, At this point, Galen Pumphrey walked into my wife Mary's Sunday School class one morning. Galen was 5 years younger than I and we lived at one another's back-doors as children in Kansas. I had not seen him far perhaps 15 years. I had heard has he was in Burlingame but had not boothered to look him up because we had been only slightly acquainted as youths. He felt the same toward me and had not bothered to look me up. A couple of days later we met at a local coffeehcuse and began to get acquainted. To my amazement he had followed a course of searching much like mine over recent years and encountered much the same problem as I. He began to allude to some new answers from a Korean lady, Miss Kim. I expressed interest in having her speak to a new group of four people whom Many and I had formed about a month earlier for the purpose of deepening our studies into spiritual growth and Galen arranged for Miss Kim to come speak to us 10 days later.

Miss Kim gave first her testimony which excited me and held me rapt. Then she began to explain the Divine Principles. The first thing she placed on the black board she was using was a symbol that had come to me in a meditation not 3 days earlier. From then on through the first five chapters that evening I sensed something great was happening. When she finished that evening, half way through the lecture, my mind wandered to the fact that she came from Korea which I had seen labled on maps as 'Chosen' and that the capital of Korea was Seoul, pronounced Soul. I hardly dared voice this idea to myself or others. Who wants to be thought a nut?

The following day, Galen, Mary and I went to S. F. to hear the rest of the Principles. We still hardly dared believe our intuition but determined to keep our minds open. That week I began to think about Satan as an actual evil spiritseeking to keep himself hidden but in control of me. I realized that my idea of God had grown and expanded in the last three years but Satan was still in that funny unbelievable costume. In the front yard of the Tokyo church stands a shiny, new 1963 Japanese model car. Next to it squats a funny-looking, old garbage truck. At that time, we had a wonderful car. When she was loaded with items, she looked stately. Year of make? Unknown. Kilometers per hour? Five. Her name is Riaka(Hand-cart). Without a single mishap, this car carried for a full year our laugheer, sweat, and tears. Now she lies quietly in our. front yea yard as a heavenly souvenir for all Japan to see. On the foundation built by her blood, sweat, and tears, her offspring stands, the best national product of Japan. So, look twice when you see this seemingly useless old wreck, and give her hour respect and loving care.

An Interview with Mr Kurohara who Fasted for 40 days. Miss H. I ran up the steep stairway and saw Mr. K lying quietly in his room. I couldn't see his face clearly, for he was surrounded by Papa(Mr. Nishikawa), Mr. M and others of the church who had squeezed themselves into the small room. Papa was praking softly, holding Mr.K.'s hand: "You have done marvelously. Father, I thank you for leading K. this far." Only 6 hours were left before K, could again know the taste of food. K s face portrayed the encouragement he received from Papa's prayer, K. looked at me, and I saw his pupils shining as they reflected the light from the lamp. This didn't matter, however, for the amount brought was shared in common for every-one's expenses. \$ Many outsiders at the wedding ceremony were thrilled by this gnerosity and mutual love,

To start off the ceremony, Mr. Eu greeted the audience of 3.500 and spoke for 30 minutes on the history of the movement and the meaning of the wedding ceremony. Our Leader and his wife clothed in flowing white robes and shining crowns then marched up to the stage, followed by two little girls, who were carrying two howls of perfumed holy water. The 124 couples then marched up to Our Leader and his wife, one by one, the bridegroom was baptized by our Mother and the bride by our Father as a token of individual blessing. After all the couples had been individually blessed and had taken up their positions in lines in front of Our Leader and his wife, twenty-four couples, selected from and representing those who had been blessed in past years, formed two lines of 12 couples each and stood on either side of the 124 couples. Then Our Leader and his wife turned toward the couples, and each member of the couples Our Leader

solemnly asked four questions to each of which the couples answered mightilyin unison: "Yes!" 1. "In taking this marriage vow, does each of you swear to accept personally the responsibility for any action taken by one sf you that is against the Will of God?" 2. In taking this marriage vow, does each of you swear to be most faithful to God and obey His Will with filial piety?" 3. "As husband and wife, do you swear before all the hosts of Heaven to be true forefathers worthy of the respect of all men?" 4. "To the original man, God promised to give dominion over the creation. Do you vow to bear yourselves in dignity as lords to whom all glory is due as victors over Satan?" Our Leader then offered a powerful and moving prayer of blessing. Then the brides and grooms exchanged wedding gifts, The bride received a golden ring and the bridegroom a signature seal. Our Leader then announced that they were married. Mr. Lew then recited a poem he had written for the ceremony, Representatives of the Nenewly-blessed couples presented to him and his wife a wreath of flowers. The vice-minister of Social Welfare and Public Health and the chief of the National Reconstruction Organization then gave exuberant speeches of congratulations. Following this, telegrams from local Korean groups(11), from Korean individuals(18), from the churches in Japan(22), America(8), and West Germany(2) were read as an introduction ϕ to the audience of the churches abroad,

Mr. Eu then greeted the audience, thanking them for their coming and enthusiastic reception. From beginning to *end*, the wedding ceremony proceeded with great solemnity, beauty, and order, yet in an atmosphere of breathless excitement.

After refreshments were served to the entire audience, the 124 couples left the auditorium and entered the cars waiting for them. The pole police had formed a cordon to prevent the populace from pressing in on the wedding party. Preceded and followed by policemen on motorcycles, the wedding party, headed by Our Leader and his family, drove through the main streets of the city in 150 cars. All Seoul had turned out to see the procession, and the city was in a state of great excitement and congratulations. All returned to the civic auditorium for an informal greetings to their families and guests.

Comments heard during the ceremony:

"I wish I could be married in that way." "It looks like a true wedding" "It's right that the parents should give the blessing on behalf of heaven and earth," "Their leader must be an unusual man to marry so many couples. It takes us (parents) years of selecting and rejecting to match our children, and even then their marriages don't turn out happily. In fact, this seems to be the case all over. You can see that these couples really do take their marriages seriously, for they follow whole-heartedly the Divine Principles and make them the basis of their marriage; they're willing to go through joy and suffering and from what I can see, they all live so happily! What an unusual maw their Leader must be, for this is their fourth ceremony like this! This is really awe-inspiring! For a group like this, nothing is impossible, believe you me!"

In the evening, the our church held program for those who had attended the morning ceremony and for any who wished to come. During the first half, the children of the Church danced, sang, and recited, and those who came laughed and applauded enthusiastically. During the second half, the Korean symphony orchestra(classic) performed great musical works for the audience, Then one of our members read *the* telegrams from the churches abroad for the benefit of those who had not been to the morning ceremony.

Finally, Mr. Choi read two of the 70 letters received from the young adults in the reformatory near Seoul. He w/a has been working with them and lecturing to them the Divine Principles. Never before had any of the prisoners responded to a minister, but after Mr. Choi had preached to them, many were so moved that they cried and repented. They wanted to write to our church, but a rule of the reformatory had been that no written communication was allowed with any church. Yet positive response and the emotion of the prisoners to Mr. Choi was such that the prison officials were moved and allowed them to communicate with our church in Seoul. From the more than 70 letters received, Mr. Choi chose two to read. The audience was greatly surprised even shocked to hear sf the prisoners⁴ favorable reaction, and the evening meeting closed in an atmosphere of great excitement, wonder, and expection. Newspapermen and photographers took many pictures and notes, as they h/a had done during the morning ceremony, and the events were made known later through the newspapers, radio, television, and news movies. For the first time, the attention of all of South Korea was focused on The Holy Spirit Association for the Unification of World Christianity,

Someone asked one of the couples where they were d' going to their honeymoon. The couple replied that they were leaving the next day to proclaim the Divine Principles to people in Korea: "This is our honeymoon!"

Passing on the Baton

When one's battlefield is changed, one's strategy is also. Shifting the center of our activities from our headquarters (located in a small place) in Seoul to the civic auditorium, we felt the difference in atmosphere. On July 24 at the auditorium, the cry "Long live the brides and bridegrooms!" was heard loudly shouted three times. Long live the eons and daughters means 16 long live the Father. Even spectators outside the auditorium felt within themselves the enthusiasm and spiritual pressure of the audience and lifting their hands joined in the cry. In this way, the ceremony celebrating the surrender of Satan's control over our nation was concluded, and the fort from which our battle would proceed against Satan's control internationally was firmly established. The outcry between God and Satan has been settled, and a new history is about to begin. Meanwhile, I heard the signing of the chip choir, and the songs which often have rung in my ears in the past today rang in my heart, not because of greater enthusiasm on my part or on the part of the choir but because of the pe difference of stage and the response of an audience which included representatives of our nation as well as our Church. In order that this song be sung throughout our nation, the singers had for a long time cried out painfully because of their grudge toward Satan and intense grief. In order to be noticed by the nation, these sons and daughters went through wave after wave of cold, hunger, ridicule, blood, sweat, and tears.

Brides and bridegrooms! These are easy words for the outsider to say, but for us these are the most difficult words to say. These words have acquired their present meaning bit by bit until they are now even higher than the bamboo tree, which also grows bit by bit, joint by joint! With every bit, a credit bas been given to our side, We have now crossed the national river and are standing before the territory of the world. Our bitter victory and the laughter of today have come because of the closeness of Our Father, our desire for a world family, and our organization based on the heart. There are groups, strong and weak, in the world today which have three elements in common: a leader, an idea, and an organization. In former times, if someone had suggested that fertilizer be made out of air, he would have been rejected, just as Copernicus was. Today, however, we know that we can produce a solid from a gas. Likewise, today is the time we can realize our ideal. To condense, heat is needed. To realize our ideal, Don Quixote-like acts are needed. Once we are told of our enemy even though he appears as unusual as a windmill, we must thrust forward our lance and charge. A French soldier once said that he hadn't learned the trumpet call for retreat, so all he could do was to march on. Likewise, we haven't learned the call for retreat, so we must press on. If you start rolling up a verywide mattress or tightly-woven straw mat and leave it only partly rolled, then it will quickly unrbll. Even though much effort and struggling with your hands, feet, and knees are needed at the beginning, if you continue, then rolling it up becomes easier and easier until eventually you need only kick it with your feet and it rolls of itself. Continue to march! The whole world will be rolled up like a straw mat. Then our desaendants will inscribe on monuments erected to us: "Warriors for God's Liberation," In the eternal kingdom, Heaven will provide for us a feast of eternal comfort. As these final thoughts weave through my mind, the last part of the wedding ceremony is ending, and so I close.

At the headquarters in Seoul, on Act. 1(Nov. 16 our time), Children's Day, a speech contest for Koreans will be held in order to select the most capable people for training in lecturing the Divine Principles in English. The contestants are to speak on the Principles for 10 minutes in English.
