THE HEART OF GOD The Solution to Peace

About two months ago, I gave a speech at a local "Youth Speaks Out" competition entitled "The Solution to Peace." The speech, of course, was based on the Divine Principle solution. As was to be expected, reactions from an audience of about 75 young people were varied, but I received the loudest applause and tied with another of the eight speakers for first place in the competition.

In working on this speech, and through various other contacts I have made, many new insights concerning the place of our movement in the society of the future have come to me which I feel are not meant just for me.

Peace on earth! What a wonderful world it would be to live in such a state where peace and joy reign in the hearts of all men! I think it will be some years before we will be able to fully realize the momentous transition that we are helping to instigate in the history of humanity. How many of history's great ones have longed to hold in their hands what we now hold? How many have longed to see what we now see? And all this is possible because the Prince of Peace has come with the message of Truth that will transform the earth into the realization of the Divine Ideal of Creation.

Yes, we have the Truth. We know it and we ache with a longing not many have known that the world could see what we see. We tell them that the Divine Principle is the Truth, and so it is; but let us draw a few fine lines here and realize for a moment that Truth does not merely consist of the Word. As does everything else, Truth has three stages. The Word is the Truth only as an idea, or thought, or plan. It is in the idealistic or Logos state, the formation stage. Next comes the growth stage which is the stage of action, or the process of bringing the idea into a manifested form. We cannot say that we really <u>have</u> the Truth until it exists as a manifested reality, which is the third stage.

To sum it up simply, then, Truth has three stages: 1) idea; 2) action, and 3) reality. The message of the Divine Principle is the Truth in its idealistic form, the Divine Principle Movement is the action toward manifesting that ideal into a visible form. We have yet to look forward to seeing the fulfillment of the Divine Ideal in its completion, which will be when Truth actually exists.

Many people throughout history have conceived of a universal ideal or plan, but all have failed to realize this plan because it has not been parallel with the Ideal Plan of Creation. Still others have glimpsed the Universal Plan, but have not perceived deeply enough the Universal Action which works tirelessly to bring the inherent Plan of Creation into visibility. Consequently, they also have failed.

How do we know that no other religion or group has the truth? The answer is obvious -if they had it, we would have seen the fruits by now. We would, at the least, see the Divine Ideal well on its way toward realization. There is only one Movement that is making any real

progress toward realization. There is only one Movement that is making any real progress toward bringing the ideal world into realization, and that is our Movement. Even in the smallness of our numbers, look at what changes our Movement is making, even if, as yet, only on an individual scale. Think what changes will be seen in the world as our numbers increase! The earth will be shaken off its very foundations!

The power of our Movement lies in its being parallel with the Universal Principle of Evolution, the Divine Principle. Once we align ourselves, <u>give</u> ourselves entirely to this Principle, we cannot fail; for we are sped along in the rapidity and ease of its perpetual motion. It is only when we are <u>not</u> parallel with it that we falter and fail, because we are working against the tide of creation.

Yes, for those who are conscientious and visionary enough to look, they will see within our midst the embryo of the Kingdom of Heaven on earth. Speaking collectively, we are a child in the womb of a mother; and as we, the cellular bodies of an embryo, multiply our numbers, our shape will gradually perfect itself. The Kingdom of Heaven will then be born, it will be seen, it will be established, to grow and expand into eternity.

I feel that it is time to begin to look more practically toward our Movement's future place in society, and begin working on a more expanded level. To do this effectively, we must expand our consciousnesses with our growth; otherwise our lack of vision will cause us to be left behind.

Until actually confronted with the problem of showing some practical evidence of how our Movement can benefit society, I had always had the attitude that all we have to do is preach the gospel and, as people change, the society would automatically change; too. That is correct in a sense, but I overlooked the fact that it would change automatically because, as each person's oneness with the Father's Heart increased, his feelings of responsibility for the world would also increase. He would automatically be inspired to go out and do something tangible in the society to change it. He would not confine himself to working on a spiritual level, but would work on a physical level as well. When I saw how narrow my attitude had been, I realized that many of us in America have that same attitude.

What places Christianity above other religions? Because its ideal is a universal one; Christ is for the world, not just for the individual. Our job is not only to align ourselves with the Divine Principle, but to bring all society into alignment with it. Truth includes the whole cosmos. To be parallel with the Divine Ideal, our minds must be as big as the whole cosmos. To do that, we must have the Divine Heart of God. If we do not feel a burning responsibility for the cosmos, we are far from the Heart of God, because God's Heart contains the whole universe.

The message of Truth must be one that can give everyone this Universal Heart. We must learn to see the world as the Father sees it. We must love it as He does. We must regard the whole world as our most beloved child. Being in a fallen state, our child is sick; we must love and nurse it back to health in the same way that most loving parents would. We must become Universal Parents whose every thought and action is for the universe. We must develop attitudes of complete love and self-sacrifice for all people and all nations; the earth, the trees, the animals, everything! We must live, not for ourselves, but for them -because we are them; we are the universe.

The more of the Universal Heart we acquire, the more outgoing our actions of love and selfsacrifice will be. We cannot help but reach out and out, until our hands have touched every building, our voices have stirred every breeze, and our tears have fallen on every inch of ground.

The message of the Divine Principle gives people the power to change themselves into the Ideal Persons with the Heart of God. This, in turn, gives us the power to change our society into the Ideal Society. So far, we have just been working on the personal and evangelistic levels. We have been preaching mainly with words. However, not many people are so keensighted to recognize the truth when it is presented in message form. We must <u>show</u> the world that we have the truth; and we can do that only by sowing the deeds of truth in our society. We have to be willing to be missionaries of action, demonstrating in our society our complete love and sacrifice for the world.

In other words, we need a new type of missionary, and I think this type of missionary is the more effective and dedicated. Some of you may have heard of Family members in Korea who went out to poverty-stricken and illiterate areas of the countryside. These poor farmers have never had the chance for education because they lack the money to go to school. Needless to say, our members didn't have any money either; so, in order to build the school, they had to work and fast for many days. They built the school with their own hands, bought the necessary materials to run it, and now teach there free of charge, still going often without food in order to do it.

These members have learned the Divine Heart of the Father. They demonstrate the selfless love of a parent for his children. Let us honestly ask ourselves if our love for humanity is up to this standard. We are setting the pattern for the future. It must be an absolute one; because, when enough people acquire the Divine Heart of the Father, based on our pattern, the world could literally change overnight.


I think it is also important to mention here that the school our members in Korea built and teach in is non-sectarian. We should never give people the impression that we are doing things just for our Movement. We are <u>not</u> doing things just for the Movement; we are doing it for all people because we love them so much. We love them with the Father's Heart that our Leader's message has given us. The Movement is essential as a means to the end, the action, the second stage of Truth; it is not the end itself. The Truth manifested is the end.

I am not advocating that we should, at this early stage, undertake the same projects as our Korean brothers and sisters. But I feel it is important that we make sure we are ready in heart. We must continually test our standard and make sure it is what it should be. We must always re-determine with ever-increasing understanding, in order to become the Army of Perfection which goes out into the world to dry its tears, not just with words of Truth but with deeds of love. Let us never, even for a second, allow our goal to leave our sight -- the establishment of the Divine Ideal on earth with the Father's Heart!

DUALITY AND NON-DUALITY IN THE DIVINE PRINCIPLES by Gordon Weir

PART III

Parts I and II in this series have traced progressive essences or realities in the pattern of Eastern abstraction. We have proceeded from the realm of the physical essence through energy essence through thought essence to spirit essence. We can represent our path of examination as follows:



(This diagram and those that follow are not intended to convey that anything is not a part of the Absolute. The several factors are outside the circle of the Absolute only for purpose of convenience.)

From the realm or level of spiritual reality, we view nothing but Infinite Invisible Spirit. We see nothing but spirit and appearances of spirit. Spirit is the essence of all of it. Thought, energy and physical phenomena are simply apparent reflections of spirit which man, through his desire, gives names because he does not realize that it is spirit. All belong to the circle.

This view from spirit is much the same as the one we had when we considered energy to be ultimate reality. Like energy, spirit is attributeless; it is without good and evil, subject and object, male and female, cause and effect. Spirit <u>is</u> Being.


Again we face non-duality, this time at a supreme level. At this point of realization, the difficulty that approaches us is that if spirit is non-dualistic and we still perceive that reality, and at the same time perceive of our individuality as spirit, we must recognize that we are not

yet one with that reality. As long as we make any distinction whatsoever between appearances of spirit, we are not yet of its nature, because spirit itself does not name us.

Also, from this vantage point, we again are led to conclude that the phenomenal universe is not possessed of reality. The view rather must embrace the philosophy that when at last we fully realize reality... that we are Infinite Invisible Spirit... we emerge or devolve or evolve into the non-dual existence, wherein there is no relativity: no subject-object, cause or effect... and, therefore, no phenomenal universe.

But let us not dwell on the extinguishing of our spiritual individuality, but rather proceed to the Heart. Here we depart from the perception of the East, and proceed to the relation of duality and non-duality to the Divine Principles.

As we have stated, Infinite Invisible Spirit is Being. To perceive within the non-dual Being, the Heart of it must be found, its Center. We might diagrammatically express it like this:




At the Center, neither non-duality nor duality is capable of expressing It. They become partial explanations of its circumference and rea. Further, that which stands revealed at the Center is Divine Love, which has being in all directions and at all levels.

Divine Love is not characterized adequately by non-duality or duality because love completely encompasses the two.


Love is the ultimate uniting force. From the position of duality or multiplicity, Love unites them into one. From the position of non-duality, Love requires two or more in order to have

something to unite. The numbers of two or more become expressive of the merit or dignity of Love; the number one expresses the single harmony of that which is unified. Both nonduality and duality remain valuable descriptive concepts, but Divine Love is not one or the other; it is too big for them.

The expression of Divine Love cannot be seen by approaching from only one direction. We might show Eastern and Western approaches like this:



From the vertical level of spirit there is no reality in the history of the physical world. From the horizontal story alone there is little meaning in the vertical expressions. However, at the Center, there is an inclusive view:



From the Center, a merging of these two approaches (and others) is seen. Heretofore, no one could understand why, if ultimate reality was non-dual, no man had ever fully been released from the view of duality into the non-dual essence, although such eventuality has been expected from the East. Or, if ultimate reality was dualistic love, then why was it not wholly reflected or realized or understood in the perception and reflection of its manifestations, although such eventuality has been expected from the West.

Not until this time in history, through the revealed truth of the Divine Principles, have the answers been given. Truly, the Divine Principles are a blessing.

Barcelona, Spain

Dear Family; You are probably all eager to hear more news about Spain, so I will write a short report on the first three months in Barcelona. Parents' Day has been a great turning point here. Since then, things are developing at a much faster pace than before.

During the first two months, I lived with and worked for a German family in the outskirts of Barcelona and took Spanish classes at the central university in the late afternoon. When I realized that I could not do anything for our movement that way, I started hunting for a room downtown. Since March, I am staying with a Spanish family.

Some of the customs here represent quite some problem for me, especially their dinnertime of 9 p.m. Immediately after the end of a lecture or meeting of any kind, everyone rushes for home. Now I have joined a social club where people meet from 7-9 p.m. As the only foreigner, I am getting a lot of attention. At that place, as well as at a Methodist church, I first want to make a number of friends before I can talk to them privately.

In this town there are about 12 protestant churches, but some of them have only 4 or 5 members. The spiritual atmosphere in some of them is very high. Recently I took part in a full day's hike into the mountains with the young church congregation. It really was some sort of indemnity for me, as I am not very fond of walking. Last week we all visited one of the U.S. destroyers in the harbor, invited by two young sailors who had visited that particular church. Of course, I took this chance to witness to them in English. I was so happy to have found someone I could talk to about the Principles for a couple of hours. Somehow I had the impression they were led, as they entered the lecture hall at the same moment as I, one hour before the prayer service was scheduled.

I am also lecturing to an American lady in her hotel room. She was sitting next to me during an excursion sponsored by the university. She mentioned an interesting book she had read: Swedenborg! What else did I need to start talking!

Parents' Day was the beginning of new developments. Since that date, I even have some real Spaniards interested, even though not a single girl so far. Most of them replied to an ad I had posted at the students' eating place. Now I am in the process of arranging when and where to meet them.

The morning of Parents' Day I spent singing, praying and reading, doing the ceremony all by myself. I felt very lonely. Before visiting Helen, the American, I went by the post office and took the first letter out of my brand new P.O. box. I was very thrilled to receive a reply to my ad from a student of philosophy. On my way back, I slipped into the beautiful ancient Catholic cathedral to thank Father. Then I phoned the student who wanted to meet me right away the same evening. You see, I did not have to celebrate all along after all. He told me he had walked out of church during mass two weeks before because he could not stand it any longer. Since then I have lectured to him almost every day.

Please do not forget to include the mission field in Spain in your prayers. Thank you. Love, in the Name of our True Parents.
