Earlier this year the ministry and education team conducted an educational survey amongst our pastors, youth pastors, and other ministry leaders. What we found was a desire for access to ongoing education on subjects such as: Ministry Leadership, Divine Principle, Preaching, and The Life and Legacy of Rev. Sun Myung Moon.

As you may know, the Ministry Support team is partnering with the Unification Theological Seminary (UTS) to offer ongoing professional training for our ministry leaders. Two courses (Growing Your Church and Exploring Divine Principle Level One) were offered earlier this year. We had a great time sharing and learning. This semester we're going to kick it up a notch by offering six more, 5-week courses in Unification ministry.

- 1. Spiritual Formation
- 2. Pastoral Leadership
- 3. Apologetics
- 4. Preaching
- 5. Life and Legacy of Rev. Sun Myung Moon
- 6. Exploring the Divine Principle

Spiritual formation is the process of shaping and growing oneself in relation to God and others. The fruits of spiritual formation appear as inner peace, and a greater capacity to love and care for others, which are essential skills for ministry leaders. This course will work towards forming one's own spiritual path and the disciplines and practices that move one along that path. We will point out how authentic progress naturally involves supporting others on the same path.

Spiritual formation involves physical practice as well as a growing and nurturing of the heart. The physical practices of spiritual formation include spiritual disciplines such as prayer and meditation, fasting, study, journaling, seclusion, listening and so forth. This is coupled with nurturing and growing the heart's capacity to love by giving to and serving others, especially those we find difficult to love. The details for this certificate program and the courses offered are as follows:

- Downloadable course materials and syllabus will be available as needed.



Tyler Owen Hendricks, Ph.D.



Dr. Tyler Hendricks has served as president of the Unification Theological Seminary (UTS), the Unification Church in America, and the True Family Values Ministry. He has pastored in New Jersey, Manhattan and Boston.

Dr. Hendricks earned his M.A. and Ph.D. in Religion at Vanderbilt University (1979, 1983), a diploma in Religious Education at UTS (1978) and a certificate in Clinical Pastoral Education at Albany Medical

Center (2011). He is the founding editor of the interfaith journal *Dialogue and Alliance* and helped direct the first Assembly of the World's Religions (1985) and first Religious Youth Service (1986).

He has authored several curricula, including "Building a Genesis 1:28 Family" and "Creating a Faithful Christian Marriage." He is the author of *Family, Church, Community, Kingdom* and *Assembly of the World's Religions, 1985,* along with numerous articles. He teaches in ministry, church history, historical theology and spiritual formation.

SESSION THREE: Honoring the world

SESSION FOUR: Honoring my family

Leading a family is like leading a church, and you've got to do both. For them to reinforce each other, which has to change—your family, or your church?
