During the **Foundation Day** celebrations in Korea in February, about 100 couples from the United States attended the **Holy Marriage Blessing**. A large number of our members attended the 40-day summer workshop at Cheong Pyeong and continued the tradition of a strong connection to the homeland of our faith.

During the summer, thousands of U.S. Unificationists, young and old, made the historic **God's Hope for America Pilgrimage**

to 55 U.S. Holy Grounds in 48 states over 43 days, retracing the footsteps of True Father's first visit to the United States in 1965. We commemorated the second anniversary of **True Father's Seonghwa** in a deeply moving memorial ceremony held at the Manhattan Center in New York.

Encouraged by True Mother, we opened an exciting new CARP witnessing center in Las Vegas and held a great **Christmas celebration** in that "Shining City" with guests from Korea and Japan, followed by a successful outreach campaign. The appeal for the Las Vegas **International Peace Education Center** continues and we look forward to the opening of this historic facility in 2015.

CHRISTMAS IN LAS VEGAS

In mid-December, 1,500 Unificationists gathered in Las Vegas to celebrate an early Christmas with True Mother. During this time, True Mother shared deeply about the life of Jesus and the heart of God. On several occasions she was in tears as she related how our Heavenly Parent had suffered waiting for the coming of His only begotten son, and how He longed to see his only begotten daughter join Jesus to become the True Parents. How fortunate we are, that the fulfillment of God's providence of restoration has been realized in our lifetime.

True Mother challenged traditional concepts at the annual **American Clergy Leadership Conference**, when she urged the audience of 330 pastors to consider why, after two thousand years, we still do not know the real date of Jesus' birth. She explained that Mary and the twelve disciples should have been proud of Jesus as the savior and messiah in his lifetime, but hesitated in the face of opposition and persecution to even celebrate his birth. True Mother then encouraged attendees to be confident and clear in their witnessing efforts.

True Mother also inaugurated the **Cranes Club** for young professionals while In Las Vegas. "I missed you so much," she said, "and I hope that we can come to know each other better from now on. All of you represent the fruit of God's love." Her vision for this new initiative is for it to become a way to network and serve the wider community. She envisions renewed interest and involvement in the practical work of building God's kingdom by practicing the motto "living for the sake of others." Each participant was able to introduce themselves to True Mother, and everyone was touched by her heart.

After these inspiring programs over twelve hundred people joined the **Christmas Celebration with True Mother**. She encouraged everyone to be confident in sharing the good news about True Parents. A traditional turkey dinner was followed by entertainment from around the world.

Motivated by True Mother's words and investment, an international team of about 60 young Unificationists took part in a **14-day Witnessing Program** and in a short amount of time, they brought 200 guests to the Las Vegas CARP center! The events, outreach efforts and time spent with True Mother were wonderful gifts this holiday season.









ALOHA! WORKSHOP

True Mother has invested a great deal in youth programs this year. In July and August, a group of teenage Unificationists had a transformative experience at a special workshop in Hawaii. The **Aloha Reunion Workshop** was a unique chance to attend True Mother, study together and build bonds that would last a lifetime. True Mother asked the young teenagers to reflect on how the field in which they will study can help them build God's ideal of the Kingdom of Heaven within their own countries.

"My message today for you is to become water that spreads out the true love of our Heavenly Parent and the True Parents of Heaven, Earth and Humankind. Water is a living substance that is essential to all people, creation and animals, without exception, right? Yet, even pure water becomes stagnant if it stops moving, so please keep your spirit and inspiration fresh."

A few months later, all the U.S. Aloha participants enjoyed a reunion during the Las Vegas Christmas festivities.

"I'm so grateful to Heavenly Parent and True Parents for my wonderful experience in Hawaii and Las Vegas. It was life changing because of the reunion of the North American participants and the honor of singing for True Mother and hearing her speak. While performing on stage and being in True Mother's presence, I could feel love radiating from her and I was so overwhelmed by that love and gratitude that I cried."

HOLY SCRIPTURES

Connecting with our Heavenly Parent and True Parents on a daily basis is essential. This is why the Holy Scriptures are so significant. On the first anniversary of Foundation Day, True Mother announced the publication of the first two volumes of **True Parents Scripture Anthology**—the *Cheon Seong Gyeong* and *Pyeong Hwa Gyeong*. These two books include many of True Parents' most powerful sermons and speeches, including the historical messages at Yankee Stadium, Washington Monument and more. A new section of True Parents' profound relationship with God.

True Mother explained, "The first thing I did after True Father's ascension was to organize Father's teachings. We have accumulated around 600 volumes from the past 50 or so years. Not so many people can read them all, right? It is difficult to hold on to all those volumes and read them. It would be difficult to digest the many contents.

That is why I have classified the teachings, given titles to them and organized them by level, so that you will be able to easily understand the teachings that True Father gave. These words help raise us as people who can bring about a new world through the blessing of rebirth and resurrection. I selected a team of theologians to organize three volumes of text, two of which have already been completed. The last volume is the Cham Bumo Gyeong (True Parents' Life Course). These teachings illuminate the path of life for all humanity."

We are blessed to have such a vast collection of True Parents teachings to guide us in our lives. These three volumes, as well as True Father's autobiography, *As a Peace-Loving Global Citizen*, and the original "Eight Great Textbooks" are available at HSAbooks.com.





In the final years of his earthly life, True Father shared a vision of Las Vegas as a shining city of peace. Through education and the pursuit of the philosophy of true human development, True Parents hope to change the tarnished reputation of Las Vegas as "Sin City" to become a city of education, family values and spiritual enlightenment. Las Vegas has seen significant development in the last several years, with True Parents continuing to invest in its future.

As part of this mission, True Parents laid the foundation for a world-class educational institution where people from all nations could study and be inspired by the *Divine Principle* and learn about the worldview of the Unification movement and its associated organizations. The center will also be a convenient base for visitors to explore both the region's natural and man-made wonders such as the Grand Canyon, Zion National Park and Sedona, as well as Hoover Dam and the city of Las Vegas itself.





In 2011, True Father sanctified the foundations of the future **International Peace Education Center** (IPEC). The site was originally a 135,000 square-foot warehouse situated on six acres of land near McCarran International Airport. True Parents guided the architects to create a facility in the style of the *Cheon Jeong Gung* museum in Korea. When complete, the IPEC will be the flagship educational facility of the Unification movement in the United States, as well as a training center for the world movement. Still under construction, the site has already become a place of pilgrimage for groups of American, Korean and Japanese Unificationists.

Thanks to all the families around America who have contributed the \$3 million that has been raised to date. Let's keep working to surpass our pledge of \$5 million by the opening of the center. All contributors will be honored on a Donors Wall. Your generosity is what has made this project, a dream of our True Parents, into a reality! We are extremely grateful.



NATIONAL MINISTRIES Holy ground pilgrimage

The summer of 2014 gave American Unificationists the chance to walk in True Father's footsteps. The **God's Hope for America Pilgrimage** kept members around the country extremely active and engaged from June 22 to August 3, and news of the pilgrimage inspired our churches around the world. We honored True Father's remarkable tour of 48 states in 1965, when he first came to declare God's Hope for America, by visiting and rededicating each of the 55 original holy grounds through prayer and song, renewing the hearts of our American family.

A significant spiritual, financial and logistical challenge, even with the aid of every modern technology, the 43-day pilgrimage was a reenactment of True Father's first steps in America. "On so many occasions, we felt True Father's presence and could almost hear his laughter and encouragement," said FFWPU USA president Michael Balcomb, who led the tour from start to finish.

At each stop on the tour, participants were overwhelmed by the outpouring of spirit and support from local communities. From war veterans to truckers and bikers, from folk at every rest stop on the way to the countless people who honked their horn or gave the bus two thumbs up as they passed by, the tour's message surely touched the core of America.

I felt that every place we stopped at was connected to God's providence. When talking with other participants, I felt that True Father was speaking to me through them. THE NATIONAL MEMORIAL





After tracing True Father's footsteps on the Holy Ground Pilgrimage, we came together once more to honor True Father's incredible life and legacy. The **National American Memorial Service for True Father** on September 20, 2014, at the Manhattan Center, was one of the most moving events of the year. True Mother's message was delivered by WFWP International president, **Dr. Yeon Ah Moon**. Through the service, we honored True Parents' 40 years of love and investment in America and how they taught our country to live for the sake of the world.

Congressman Dan Burton spoke about True Parents' contribution to America and the world, and especially about their work for interfaith and ecumenical harmony and the cause of religious freedom.

"I know that the life of Reverend Moon was by no means an easy one. He encountered opposition and persecution throughout his life and sadly, this also included his being imprisoned here in the United States. I want to go on record and say, on behalf of America's leaders, we are sorry that this happened. America must not fail today. We must do better and provide moral leadership by lifting up the God-affirming principles that allow respect for men and women of every race, creed and culture."

A global observance of True Father's second *Seonghwa* Anniversary, themed "Forgive, Love, Unite" was held in August in the stadium in Cheong Pyeong, Korea. Our American family was honored to send a large group to perform some of True Parents' favorite American songs, including "God Bless America" and "The Battle Hymn of the Republic" at the international festivities.





EVANGELISM & OUTREACH



Sharing the powerful message of True Parents is perhaps the most challenging, but also the most rewarding experience we face in our life of faith. Our National Ministry team is solidly committed to supporting outreach and witnessing efforts. From major campaigns, to local grass roots initiaves, to the Christmas/ New Year's outreach workshop in Las Vegas, we seek to create and utilize any available resource to spread the news of our True Parents through true love, personal responsibility and by connecting to True Parents' realm of heart.

We have taken advantage of modern technology to expand our outreach efforts. In just over a year, the DPlife website has grown from a small site hosting a single video to one of the foremost outreach tools for FFWPU in America and many other nations. The website is a witness to the priceless gifts our True Parents have given us in a creative, inspiring and professional way. The site features articles, videos, directories and more and traffic to the site is quickly moving past its current average of 7,500 visits per month. 2014 closed out with 14,000 Facebook followers and a growing Twitter community.

Following the Christmas weekend, True Parents invited Unificationists from Korea to participate in a 14-day witnessing program in Las Vegas. Ten Americans and a team of local Japanese missionaries joined in support of the effort made by the 36 Korean participants. The National Ministry team met True Mother's call and prepared some 21,000 bookmarks, postcards, caps and t-shirts centered around the theme of "Forgive, Love, Unite."

BLESSING & Family Ministry

For the first time in history, humanity has the grace and opportunity to receive the Marriage Blessing from True Parents. Our **workshops, seminars, curricula and online support programs** continue to provide uplifting education and preparation for blessed family life. BFM provides resources and support to couples and families, who are the cornerstone of everything we do. In 2014 we held three **Parent Matching Convocations**, introducing hundreds of parents to each other and assisting them in the Matching process for their families. A total of 171 Matching Advisors now serve and support local communities.

The Blessing and Family Ministry also facilitated Holy Marriage Blessing ceremonies throughout the country coinciding with **Foundation Day 2014**.

There were numerous events and initiatives this past year centered on the importance of marriage and family. The **Blessed Marriage Project** is an independently funded, grassroots initiative by Blessed couples for Blessed couples. In its first year, it has already hosted two successful "Energize!" couples retreats.

The **Getting Back on Track** retreat provides a healing and renewing experience for those who have encountered more serious difficulty in their relationships.

The **24+ Connect** retreat brought a total of 88 single young men and women together ranging in age from 24 to 32.

Online Webinars in courses such as Marriage Enrichment, Family Matching, Sunday School, Blessing Preparation Support and Matching Advisor Advanced Training will continue to be available in 2015.

A NEW GENERATION

A new generation of Unificationists has found ways to make its mark on the world. **Generation Peace Academy** (GPA), provides opportunities to explore beliefs and develop a faith-based life centered on God and True Parents. In January 2014, GPA served in Peru, Panama, Trinidad, Barbados and the Dominican Republic. In May, GPA visited nine communities across the country, to assist local ministries in outreach and service.

During a visit to Las Vegas in March, True Mother shared her vision for a new student outreach initiative that combines the strengths of the local Las Vegas Family Church, GPA and CARP. The overall focus is on campus ministry, teaching the Divine Principle and the study of True Parents' words; early results are already very promising!

We were pleased to host the Korea-based **Universal Peace Academy** in the United States several times during the year. During their stay, GPA and UPA shared about their programs, joined in friendly sports tournaments and collaborated in service work.

Service work is at the heart of many of these programs. One group, Religious Youth Service (RYS), sponsored the **Honduras RYS Peace Park**. where 24 participants from the U.S. and Honduras joined forces in a project called "It's Not About the Pieces, But How They Work Together." The project included an art-based service project using mosaic as a catalyst for experiential learning of cooperation and peace.





GPA held its annual **Family Assembly** and its first **Alumni Reunion** in April. About 400 friends and family members from all over the country gathered for this joyful occasion at the beautiful YMCA of the Rockies in Estes Park, Colorado.

In June, at the end of their year, participants spent three days touring New York and Washington, D.C. learning about the history of the Unification movement in the United States. They were thrilled to hear testimonies from older Unificationists who had walked side by side with True Parents back in the formative years of our movement in America.

The 110 young men and women who graduated GPA this year, said they had found greater clarity in what they stood for, were better prepared for the challenges of life, and fully ready to serve others.



UTS

The **Unification Theological Seminary** continues to uphold the tradition of bringing people from all cultural and religious backgrounds under one roof, exemplified in its 2014 graduating class that featured graduates from around the world. It included 12 Master of Religious Education (MRE) graduates, three Master of Arts in Religious Studies (MA) graduates, three Master of Divinity (MDiv.) candidates and one Doctor of Ministry (DMin.) candidate.

Adding to its history as an international and interdenominational graduate seminary, UTS is now offering an undergraduate degree in World Religions and Philosophy, and the Barrytown, NY, campus is once again filled with youthful energy and a spirit of inquiry.

An extensive educational survey earlier this year resulted in UTS courses being offered directly to our Unificationist pastors through a new series of online classes. The first two 5-week courses, "Growing My Church" and "Exploring the Divine Principle," attracted interest from across the United States, the Caribbean and Europe. In 2015 the program will expand to a oneyear certificate of continuing education. Learning is a lifelong endeavor, and we are proud to support educational programs for students of any age.





KODAN

KODAN, a ministry to the Japanese membership of FFWPU in America, encourages Tribal Messiahship efforts and raises funds to support training and education for local pastors and to sponsor evangelism.

KODAN has spent the year reaching out to people in communities across America, street and campus witnessing and setting up book tables at colleges.

In March, 100 people attended the national workshop at East Garden. They presented a report of recent activities, viewed footage of True Father expressing his vision for the International Education Center and Peace Palace in Las Vegas and were encouraged to attend the God's Hope for America Pilgrimage.





CARP

The **Collegiate Association for the Research of Principles** (CARP) is about building authentic relationships with a community that supports personal growth. CARP strives to help its members solidify their beliefs and broaden their perspectives. Through sincere dialogue and community impact events, local CARP chapters establish lasting friendships and teach practical life, leadership and communication skills.

Over a long weekend in March, students from Ohio State University and West Virginia University converged on Columbus, Ohio, during their spring break to attend a Regional CARP Officers' Training. This was the first of several spring break regional training sessions CARP organized for March and April. In the summer of 2014, CARP also hosted three summer interns to work at their National Office in New York City.

CARP USA hosted its national convention— Momentum 2014—from July 30 to August 5 at the University of Maryland. Over 120 participants gathered from all 12 districts and even as far as Canada, England, Israel, Russia, Korea, Australia and Fiji. The 21 international participants greatly contributed to the spirit, diversity and energy of the convention.

In September, Las Vegas CARP launched a new outreach effort at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas. The CARP members all full-time students, have each made a personal commitment to reach out to at least three people per day.





The **American Clergy Leadership Conference** (ACLC), established in May 2000, has been working for 14 years with Christian clergy to bring America back to its Christian roots and principles. ACLC pastors across the United States participated in the February **Foundation Day** celebrations and, inspired by their experience, took a stand for marriage and family.

At the ACLC monthly **Prayer Breakfast** in Brooklyn in September, some 80 faith leaders, including clergy of Islamic and Sikh religious traditions, learned about True Father's vision for America and his appreciation for the important role faith leaders have played throughout the nation's history. All were encouraged to attend the National Memorial Service for True Father. In November, under the leadership of Bishop Lewis Evans, ACLC pastors gathered at Soul Harvest Ministries in Highland Park, MI, for a conference on the **restoration of the African American Family**. Then in December, over 300 clergy attended the 19th **Annual True Family Values Banquet** in Chicago. Several received awards, and a stimulating pastor's forum discussed faith-based solutions to rebuilding families.

ACLC kicked off its **National Convocation** titled "Ambassadors for God's Kingdom Building" on December 17 in Las Vegas, coinciding with the Christmas celebrations with True Parents. The convocation was honored by a personal address from True Mother.



WPF-USA

Universal Peace Federation-USA (UPF-USA) saw new developments this year. Ricardo De Sena was appointed Secretary General of UPF-USA in June, and he presented his vision for expanding UPF's work in America to a group of 24 UPF leaders at a strategic gathering in Chicago.

In autumn, new Illinois state UPF director, Mr. John Prevost, organized an exciting American Leadership Conference. The keynote speaker was Reverend Clyde Brooks, who was Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.'s driver and confidante when the great civil rights leader visited Chicago in the 1960s. Reverend Brooks is now the CEO of the Illinois Commission on Diversity and Human Relations, a non-profit that works for equality and diversity.





WFWP

Carrying the banner of peace with a mother's heart, **Women's Federation for World Peace** (WFWP) USA continues to inspire women to use their unique gifts to establish a culture of heart and achieve genuine peace under God.

The annual National Assembly drew over 200 participants to Washington D.C., among them 40 young women professionals, to discuss **Learn to Lead – Leading With Heart**. D.C. Mayor Vincent Gray declared that day "WFWP Day." Two days prior, scores of children from four local schools beautified an historic avenue in WFWP's signature **Learn to Lead Through Service** program.



WFWP USA President Angelika Selle spoke on four occasions on the "Now Is the Time" internet radio station to audiences in the U.S., Europe and South America about **Living by the Logic of Love**, WFWP USA's motto.

WFWP chapters nationwide provided a wide array of programs and services, such as eight "LOVE IQ" abstinence education seminars; eight Bridge of Peace Ceremonies, one co-sponsored by the Athena International Award Luncheon hosted by the Women's Chamber of Commerce of Nevada; health and healing seminars and advocacy forums. WFWP USA donated \$24,605 for its Schools of Africa Project and raised \$21,000 for families affected by the November 2013 typhoon in the Philippines.

STEWARDSHIP

Maintaining buildings and assets is just as important as all of the work that goes on inside the walls. That's why the **Office of Business Investment and Asset Development** (OBIAD) was established in 2013 to manage property assets. The OBIAD team creatively examines ways to improve financial performance while upholding the highest levels of stewardship and integrity. Several buildings significant to the history of the Unification movement are under renovation, such as 4 West 43rd St in New York, Belvedere and the Washington D.C. church on the East Coast. Other properties around the country are planned for repair and renovations.

AROUND THE USA

District 1 saw growth with consistent early morning prayer and study at local Holy Grounds and at church sanctuaries in Norfolk, Richmond and Fairfax, VA, Washington D.C. and Baltimore, MD. These devotional commitments, led by the pastors, brought personal and community revival and laid a foundation for growth in 2015.

All communities made progress in enhancing the educational and fellowship opportunities for our younger Unificationists. This has made the continued growth of our communities much more promising. We look forward to raising up those among the younger generation who are inspired to become great leaders.



District 2 held street rallies in four locations in August and September following the God's Hope for America Pilgrimage. Rallies in White Plains, Brooklyn, Queens and Manhattan included music, public speeches and leafleting/outreach. Each rally was supported by Unificationists of all ages from throughout the New York District. A total of 26 guests who were met at the rallies attended introductory Divine Principle programs. Of those, six continue to study Divine Principle and attend local church services. Two have become Unificationists.



District 3 saw many community-wide efforts this year. Following True Mother's call to beautify our churches worldwide, the whole NJ Community pitched in to turn its patchy meadow into a luscious lawn. The Golden Age Club, Youth Ministry, Sunday School and local Unificationists donated the money for equipment and new rolls of grass, and gave their time for this project.

The God's Hope for America Pilgrimage brought amazing rebirth and everyone started talking about Tribal Messiahship again. District 3's Sunday school children initiated a fundraiser and collected more than a \$1,000 in support of IPEC. It was beautiful to see children standing up to support one of our national projects.



District 4 committed to quarterly, regional Divine Principle education seminars as a way of sharing the profound message of True Parents with the community and inspiring elder Unificationists by reminding them of the power of its teachings in everyday life. Local pastors met regularly to discuss issues of church growth. In March District 4 held its first one-day seminar, "Creating a Culture of Heart." Seminar themes included: Return—Making Church Irresistible; Relationship— Investing in What Matters Most; Responsibility from Attending to Belonging. In July, NH hosted Camp Aurora, an annual summer camp for more than 80 students grades 4-12. The youth on staff did an awesome job.

District 5 in the Deep South, saw several new church plants. South Miami Dade County planted a new church and anointed a new pastor who has been leading active outreach in the area ever since. The boyhood home of Rev. Jeddie King in Kissimmee, FL, became a new church community and it has quickly expanded attendance beyond just family and friends. The Kings continue their roadside blessings and service projects alongside their internet radio ministry. In Orlando Unificationists searched and found a new location in a strip mall to hold service. In South Florida, the largest community in District 5, Unificationists are acquiring a new church with complete facilities.



District 6 was busy in 2014 hosting local events in its communities and striving to meet goals for tribal messiahship, consistently reaching out to the community throughout the year. The highlight was the visit of the God's Hope for America Pilgrimage. The tour stopped in five of the district's Holy Grounds: Paducah (KY), Memphis (TN), Raleigh (NC), Cleveland (OH) and Hammond (IN).



District 7 launched the *Marriage Restoring Movement* in April 2014, a series of conferences on strengthening marriage and family held in Detroit and Chicago. These programs were initiated by one of Detroit's Ambassadors for Peace with a vision of a five-year plan to revive the institution of marriage in Metro Detroit and beyond. He shared his vision with Rev. David Kasbow, State Pastor of FFWPU USA Michigan and they started working together. It didn't take too long for the cooperation to expand to Chicago. In 2015, District 7 expects more people to join these efforts and to continue growing as a genuine marriage restoration movement.



District 8 held many witnessing activities on the University of Omaha campus and gave first time introductory talks to new guests studying Divine Principle at the Omaha Family Church. Spanish Divine Principle workshops were held in Minneapolis. The Kansas City Family Church had a joyful experience hosting the Interfaith Food and Thought event co-sponsored by Cultural Crossroads and the Greater Kansas City Interfaith Council. The God's Hope for America Pilgrimage visit featured a minister's luncheon that was well attended. Near the end of the year, we held an exciting and activity-filled district-wide winter youth workshop in Minneapolis.



District 9 was revived through the God's Hope for America Pilgrimage, with one young Unificationist participating from coast to coast and back again and two of the District's youngest members participating from Texas to the east coast and back to Colorado. Every state in District 9 took part in the national celebration of True Parents' 40 years in America in September and 30 local families traveled to Las Vegas to spend time with our True Mother for Christmas. Outreach efforts have added new faces to the district's community and provided the opportunity for rebirth for those who left many years ago. District 9 has one new Church center and is looking for new facilities for its district headquarters.



District 10 and the Kodiak Family Church has hosted the National Ocean Challenge Program since its inception in 2009. It was created to honor True Parents' love of the ocean by giving young Unificationists an unforgettable experience of boating and fishing on the Alaskan waters. Last summer, local families teamed up with participants who attended evening programs, served in city volunteer projects and hosted a closing banquet. Forty guests came, representing the United States Coast Guard, the U.S. Wildlife Refuge Visitor Center, fishery researchers, Christian leaders, co-workers and friends of young Unificationists.



District 11 saw a group of 12 sisters at the Bay Area Family Church gather to form the BAFC Women's Circle. Their vision was to bridge the differences of nationality and culture and as women representing the larger whole, to create an environment of love and care for everyone. Two retreats were held in 2014 at Point Montara Light House on the beautiful northern California coast with the themes of forgiveness, renewal and connecting as heavenly women, sisters and mothers. On the foundation of these two retreats, they decided to make it an annual event and open it to the community.



District 12 gained momentum in three areas during 2014: Home Church (small groups), Sunday Service Celebration and the "My Path with God" (Divine Principle education) workshops. Participants and host families of Home Church and hobby groups shared how they applied God's word in day-to-day life. Camp Mozumdar is a serene retreat in the San Bernadino mountains was refurbished and renewed.

In 2014 expenditure was reduced to \$11.28 million. Our American church took additional financial responsibility for \$3.26 million of annual ministry expenditures previously supported by our church community in Japan. These included East Garden/Belvedere church, UTS, and church activities in Las Vegas. The American church and related organizations are now self-sufficient and have developed a fund to support our global ministries.
