Spiritual Conditions

- Lead by personal example to make internal and external condition to welcome TM: prayer and HDH
- Promote a national 40 day prayer condition
- Follow up on whether members do have copies of the new scriptures and are actually reading them for HDH
- Donate personally and encourage all members to donate to make the \$3m goal for IPEC appeal
- Revive the donation culture for Holy Days etc.
- Make better, quicker reports to complete the offering

Upcoming Projects

1. Send college age youth to a 7-day DP workshop at IPEC, to complete before the Official Opening
2. National Blessing Campaign; first Blessing June 27; goal to bless 430 couples nationwide
3. Encourage youth to attend Cheongpyeong and help to provide support staff and lecturers
4. Create the first USA CIG Youth Missionary Team each district to send 1 or 2 candidates

7 Day DP Workshop

- Invite students and young adults to a 7-day DP workshop at IPEC , before the Official Opening
- Goal of 120; each district to send 12 candidates
- Hold workshop mid May, (May 15-22) to finish before IPEC opening.
- Consider best presenters, speakers, and take-aways

National Blessing Movement

- All pastors become familiar with the national Blessed Family plan and available resources
- Plan and then announce goals how and when your district can participate in the National Blessing Movement
- Goal at least 4 Districts that are able to do so hold a local Blessing on June 27; at least 8 by October 14.

National Blessing Movement

- Ordain District Pastors and selected others to minister the Blessing. Maintain a clear record of such ordained people.
- Create online and other education for both pre and post Blessing audiences
- Develop the Blessing as an Outreach, PR and Interfaith Tool

Cheongpyeong Summer Workshops

- National Goal of 100 -120 participants (high school and college)
- Provide at least 6 staff and lecturers
- Promote and encourage district youth participation
- HQ reps to be more actively engaged at the workshop Korea so that we can capture the inspiration and bring it to the campus
- Evaluate and Upgrade Communications and Reports

Create a USA CIG Missionary Team

- 2014: Korea, Japan and America tasked to do it
- 2015: First Japanese Team finishes 1 year
- 2015: USA First CIG Team
 - ▣ 12 to 21 participants [1-2 per region]
 - ▣ 21- 40 Day period, witnessing and service
 - ▣ Consider leadership by GPA Staff, others
 - ▣ Possible Locations: Puerto Rico; Jamaica
- 2015/2016 USA Second CIG Team

Longer Term Strategic Efforts

- Empower Members as Tribal Messiahs
- Strengthen and train pastors
- Improve the Church Management system (including redistricting)
- Improve the church financial foundation
- Address Media and PR issues quickly and directly

Empower Members

- Empower Members as Tribal Messiahs
 - 25% by June; 40% by end of year
 - Develop the International TM model and standards
 - Well understand benchmark projects

 - CIG IW system

- Strengthening pastors;
 - ▣ Ongoing UTS and other Education for all pastors
 - ▣ Create pastor mentoring teams
