Registration is now open for the latest *Peace Starts With Me Rally* to be held in New York on December 28th, right after Christmas. Up to 30,000 pastors, ministers, imams and religious leaders will join this inspiring gathering led by our True Mother, supported by the world-famous Christian leader Bishop Noel Jones – who already hosted a PSWM event in Los Angeles earlier this year.

Here in Europe, we are asking you to use our own [online registration form](#) rather than the US registration site. This will allow you to record your travel details and for us to help coordinate group accommodations in New York.

The Rally will take place at the **Prudential Center in Newark, New Jersey, from 2pm to 5pm on Saturday, December 28th**. For those who can make it a day early, there will be a seminar and briefing the day before, Friday December 27th, held at the New Yorker Hotel next to world famous Madison Square Garden. On the night of the 27th there will also be an invitation-only Welcome Banquet that True Mother is expected to attend.

Who should come: All religious leaders are welcome. As you can see from the website, the focus will be on a non-denominational, inclusive, music and spirit-filled worship service. Members of the Family Federation are also welcome to attend as long as they are accompanying one or more religious leaders.

When to come: You should aim to arrive no later than the evening of December 27th and leave no earlier than the morning of December 29th. Come a day earlier to join the interfaith seminar and have a chance to get tickets to the invitational banquet.

Costs

Meals and Accommodations: Hotel accommodations and meals in New York and/or New Jersey will be provided for a total of three consecutive nights (choose either the 26, 27, 28 or the 27, 28, 29 December)

and it should be possible to purchase additional nights should you wish to extend your stay.

Airfare Support Grant: All participants are expected to share the cost of their air travel to New York City. FFWPU Europe and Middle East HQ is pleased to announce that a partial airfare support is available on request up to a maximum of 50% of the ticket cost. Ground transportation to and from the airport remains a personal responsibility.
