

Michael Balcomb and Matthew Huish January 24, 2020



The Council of Communities met in High Leigh Conference Centre, Hoddesdon, from January 17th to 19th for a weekend that showed the winds of change that have begun to blow through our movement for this long-awaited year of 2020. We began with welcoming our EUME regional chair couple, whose position in the UK national leadership was about to be ratified; a 2nd "UK Providence Meeting" was organised to occupy a central position in the middle of the weekend; and we finished with a wide range of "homework" tasks in preparation for a year promising huge new hopes and expectations.

On the Friday evening, in front of a panel combining members of both the National Council and the Council of Communities, a new arrangement was agreed on for our EUME regional chair couple, Dr Michael and Fumiko Balcomb, to assume, in addition, the role as UK National Leader couple. In this arrangement, they have committed to spend at least half of their time for the UK, while Matthew and Natasha Huish step into a role of deputy leadership in a full-time capacity. This is recognised as an unusual arrangement but one which we agreed will undoubtedly be of great benefit to our mission in the UK (for a full description of these roles for 2020, see the <u>attached file</u>). Mike is keen to submit himself to a review in front of the Board of Trustees within a year, while Matthew's position will be reviewed by Mike himself, with a reflection on the details, including financial arrangements, to be brought to the next CoC. All-in-all, the discussions that led to these arrangements were frank and personal, giving answers to many concerns, and inspiring confidence in the new leadership team and hope for many good results in the years ahead. Detailed minutes will be published soon and sent to all CoC representatives.

After the uplifting worship, testimonies and keynote talk by Mike Balcomb in the UK Providence meeting, the CoC got down to discussions on Saturday afternoon, reflecting on the opportunities and challenges facing each community and the initiating plans and ideas for moving towards the aspirational goals set up for the year.

We concluded with business matters, such as how to keep the National Prayer points upto-date and relevant; how the new FFWPU website is developing and the possibilities of a new media production (reports from Josh McGuigan); congratulations and thanks to Robert and Oksana Torok for their 3-year dedication to Scotland as pastor couple; comments on the National Council report; a communities financial management proposal; and plans for the next meetings of the CoC.



However, we left with a feeling that it will be anything but "business as usual".

RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE UK NATIONAL DIRECTOR AND DEPUTY NATIONAL DIRECTOR 2020

Joint Responsibilities

- 1. Work with all teams to prepare for welcoming True Mother to the 2020 UK Summit & Blessing
- 2. Plan and implement the National SMM100 / TP60 Exhibition
- 3. Working with the PR and webteam to upgrade our internet and social media presence
- 4. Conduct Regular National Zoom Calls for pastors, and for members
- 5. Conduct the Monthly Providence Meeting
- 6. Conduct the Quarterly National Sunday Service
- 7. Restarting the process of witnessing, evangelism, workshops, and the membership track

Specific Tasks: Michael Balcomb

Pastoral Care

- 1. Care of the Ministers / Pastors Association (formerly, the Council of Communities)
- 2. Quickly appoint pastors in communities that lack them (even on a temporary basis)
- 3. Plan and organize the first Boot Camp and other education for pastors
- 4. Visitation of different communities

Organizational Leadership

Take the lead in dealing with organizational, financial and property matters, at least in the short term. This includes spending a minimum of one day a week (usually Tuesdays) working in Lancaster Gate.

- 1. Working with the PIC Committee to develop best proposals for the major properties and bringing those proposals to the Board of Trustees and True Mother. Making temporary upgrades as needed to facilities ahead of long-term decisions. Possible hire of CFO/COO
- 2. Working with the Treasurer and the Director of Finance to provide transparent, timely and accurate reports. May involve changing our accounting company if they are not working well.
- 3. Improving tithing and community giving to create a culture of giving
- 4. Seeking a "development officer" to increase the potentials of charitable giving
- 5. Providing education to the Board of Trustees to better fulfill their function
- 6. Refresh make-up and role of the National Council to make it a more effective management team.

Specific Tasks: Matthew Huish

Pastoral Care

- 1. Matthew and Natasha appointed as Bromley (SouthEast London) pastors for a 1 year period.
- 2. Coordinate the National Cheonbo Events
- 3. Plan and organize the Annual Gathering

Organizational Leadership

- 1. Working 2-3 days a week out of Lancaster Gate, lead and guide the HJHQ team (general affairs, PR, etc) through weekly meetings and daily interactions. Create a calendar of annual events.
- 2. Primary focus on education, including working with various teams to oversee
 - a. Divine Principle workshops (start with a consistent 2 day workshop each month)
 - b. HARP, CARP and youth programs (including summer and winter workshops)
 - c. UPF, WFWP WCLC UK Retreats (Organized by these ministries, but coordinated and synergized)
 - d. Gatekeeping other proposed educational programs such as High Noon, Project Phoenix
- 3. Developing online education, especially as a follow up for HTM couples who have been blessed.

CheonBo Schedule for 2020

> By 31st January 2020: Creating the CheonBo Evaluation Committees

> 6th – 7th February 2020: Special invitation to the events for the HTM Victors who have completed the vertical and horizontal blessing of 430, and HTM Proclaimers.

> February 2020: First round of registration will begin through registering on the CheonBo Registration Evaluation website (details about the website to be announced at a later date).

1) First stage of evaluation: National committee reviews evaluation

2) Second stage of evaluation: Regional committee reviews evaluation

3) Third stage of evaluation: International HQ committee reviews evaluation

> April 2020: Announcement of CheonBo couples (from the first round of registration) who passed evaluation and can be inducted into the CheonBo Won and receive the CheonBo Holy Robes. > After April 2020: Begin website registration for the 'Proclaimers' to go through evaluation.

> August 2020: Second announcement of the CheonBo Couples who passed the evaluation and can be inducted into the CheonBo Won and receive the CheonBo Holy Robes.

> 9th September 2020: Anniversary Celebration for True Father's Holy Ascension and CheonBo Registration Ceremony

Providential Background

> Commemoration of True Parents' Centenary and 60th Holy Wedding Anniversary

> Accomplishment of True Mother's Vision 2020 goal and dedication of this victory to Heavenly Parent and True Father

> Victory for the firm establishment of Cheon II Guk through the seven-year course since True Mother proclaimed Cheon II Guk Foundation Day in 2013

> All blessed couples should complete their Heavenly Tribal Messiah mission and become registered as Cheonbo couples in the era of the firm establishment of Cheon II Guk

> Cheonbo candidate couples will be cleansed of all sins as they prepare to become registered as Cheonbos. Other couples will also be able to make their determination to become Cheonbo couples, as well as carry out the necessary preparations

Meaning of the Special Grace

> The special grace bequeathed by the True Parents of Heaven, Earth and Humankind cleanses Cheon II Guk citizens from any violation of heavenly laws they have consciously or unconsciously committed in front of Heavenly Parent related to matters of ethics, faith and the heart, such as a negligent life of faith, drinking, smoking, apostasy, heresy, problems related to lineage, infringements of the heart, etc.

> True Parents' special grace does not absolve from indemnities stemming from violating a nation's positive laws or from harm or hurt caused to others. Such indemnities must be set and fulfilled by each person.

Standard for Receiving the Special Grace

> This Special Grace is given through participating in the Cheonbo Holy Wine Ceremony on 6th February and through True Parents' Blessing Prayer at the Blessing Ceremony on 7th February.

> Those who have been involved in lineage problems (unprincipled sexual behavior) but wish to receive the Blessing this time in February must consult with the pastor of their church and confess through writing and submitting the "Statement of Resolve to Start Anew in the Era of the Firm Establishment of Cheon II Guk" (see link above). Then, after participating in the Holy Wine Ceremony on 6th February and receiving True Parents' Blessing Prayer on 7th February, their Blessing will be recognised and established.

> For 1st generation or 2nd generation members who married outside the church, to be restored as blessed families, they must first fulfill all requirements for this year's special grace, and report having done so to their National HQ Blessed Family Department.

Conditions of Devotion to Be Offered Prior to Participating in the Cheonbo Holy Wine Ceremony

> Registration and participation in the 4-day Cheon II Guk Hyojeong Festival:

5th February – Hyojeong Festival Opening Ceremony (Grand Hall, Cheonbo Training Center)

6th February - True Parents' Centenary & the 7th Anniversary

of Foundation Day (Cheongshim Peace World Center) and Cheonbo Holy Wine Ceremony (Grand Hall, Cheonbo Training Center)

7th February – True Parents' 60th Holy Wedding Ceremony & Hyojeong Cosmic Blessing Ceremony (Cheongshim Peace World Center)

8th February – Victory Celebration (Cheongshim Peace World Center)

> Prayer of Resolution through Pilgrimage to Holy Grounds:

Tree of Love: Resolution to love God, love humanity and love one's nation by practising True Love

Tree of Heart: Resolution to attend Heavenly Parent and True Parents with a filial heart (hyojeong)

Tree of All Things: Resolution to become a true person who can take dominion over all things

Tree of Loyalty: Resolution to have unchanging loyalty towards Heaven

Tree of Blessing: Resolution to become Cheonbo couples by completing the Blessing of 430 couples horizontally, and the Blessing of 430 generations vertically

JeongShim Won Prayer Hall: 120 bows

> Repent for past mistakes and offer the 'Statement of Resolve to Start Anew in the Era of the Firm Establishment of Cheon II Guk' in the JeongShim Won prayer hall

> Donation: All families must donate an amount based on the number 13 in the JeongShim Won prayer hall
