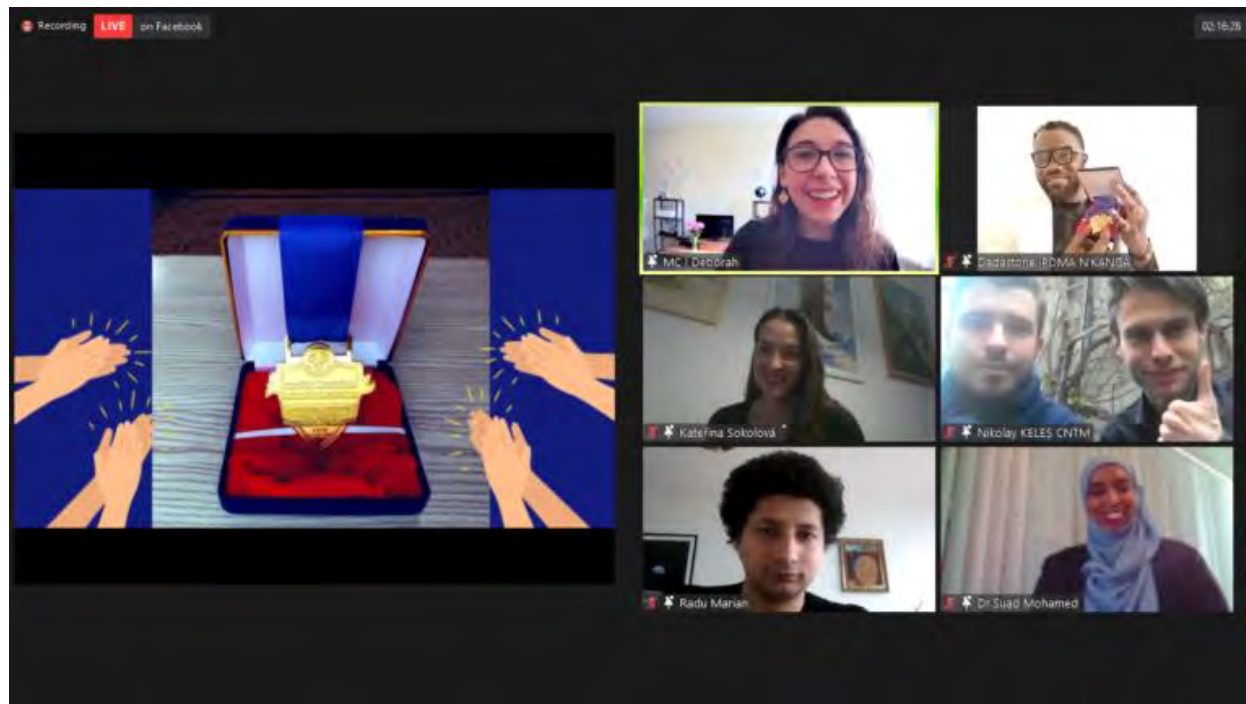


YSP Europe and Middle East: Annual Youth Heroes' Award ceremony

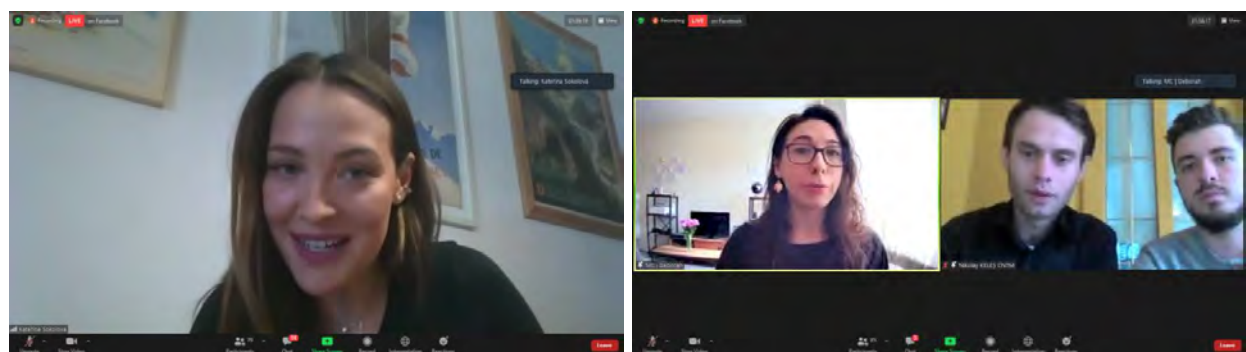
April 3, 2021
