The "Building Our Blessing" series is aimed at all matched couples and young couples blessed in 2020 and 2021.

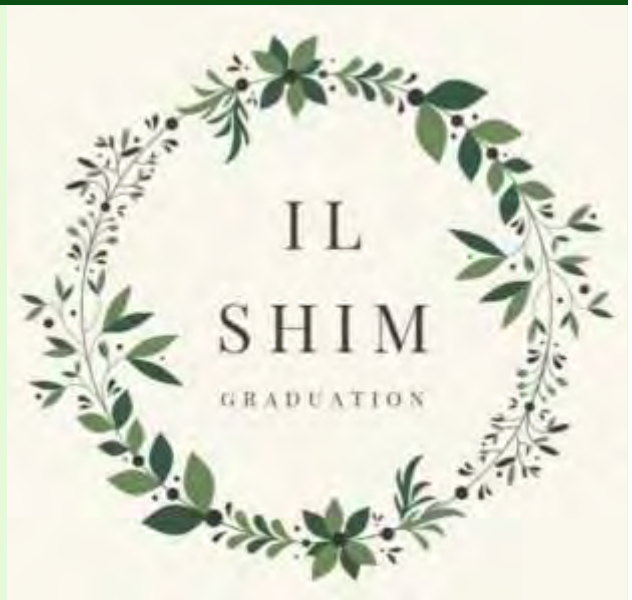

An Interfaith Prayer Gathering for Ukraine in Watford - Françoise Murphy

The Watford Elected Mayor had specially requested for the vigil to be held at the Watford Peace Garden in Cassiobury Park. Watford Interfaith Association had just one week to organise the event.

People stood together in the Peace Garden on a cold rainy afternoon listening to the various prayers and talks. We were all united in heart in our hope for a prompt, peaceful resolution to the conflict in Ukraine and an end to the suffering of so many innocent people.
