Franklin took care of the Seonghwa ceremonies liaising with and supporting the bereaved families. Françoise concluded with a vote of thanks to Keiko de Giles for her tremendous investment in building up the Holy Oak Memorial Woodland. She then warmly welcomed Kumiko Large as the new warden for the site.

Franklin spoke and emphasised the importance of honouring our ascended members and including them in our daily lives. He reminded our members about getting a headstone for their loved ones.

At the closing of the service roses were given to everyone and a photo was taken of the group. Members went around the various wonjeon laying flowers, praying, and reminiscing about each of the ascended members. The afternoon concluded with a potluck lunch. We enjoyed each other's company and spent time catching up with each other.
