
FFWPU UK: Bookshop Reopens At Lancaster Gate




Over the past year, Ala has been working with an artist to design books and workbooks for children to teach them our values and pass on our teachings. The first book of the series, The Story of Hyojeong: Let's Be Filial Children To Make Our Parents Happy, has now been released and is available for purchase. This is the first book of a set of three. It was inspired by the memoirs of Rev Sun Myung Moon and Dr Hak Ja Han Moon, who from their early childhood strived to become the most filial and loving son and daughter of God, our Heavenly Parent. It explores a meaningful Korean tradition of hyo, or filial piety, a virtue of beautiful love, care and deep heart of parent and child. This charming book is based on a story of two siblings from an interracial family who read True Parents' words with their parents and discuss its meaning in a simple, child-friendly language.
