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EUME Youth Department: Development Coordinator

The Development Coordinator supports the development of youth and young leaders across Europe and the Middle East. Working closely with the Youth Department Director, the Coordinator cultivates a thriving network of young leaders by strengthening relationships, encouraging collaboration, and building a culture of leadership ownership. The goal of the role is to nurture connection, spiritual growth, and leadership development among young people already connected to the Unificationist movement, and to connect, develop, and support youth leaders across EUME.

The role supports young people in progressing along the Youth Department “Youth Track”:
Visitor → Member → **Volunteer** → **Team Leader** → **Mentor** → **EUME Leader**.

Youth Department Vision and Mission

- **Vision Statement:** A loving, united Pure Water generation centered on Heavenly Parent and True Parents—embodying our faith, strengthening family-centered communities, and cultivating a culture of peace across Europe and the Middle East.
- **Mission Statement:** To care for and empower the youth of Europe and the Middle East as owners of faith, family, and environment, by providing spiritual guidance, leadership development, and a supportive community of peers.

Areas of Focus

Core Responsibilities

- **Youth Leader Network:** Facilitate communication, connection, and collaboration between youth leaders and activities across EUME. Organize regular leadership networking meetings, retreats, and forums.
- **Youth Leader Support:** Identify challenges faced by youth leaders and coordinate support where needed. Listen to and support the needs of local communities, maintaining regular communication and feedback with Regional youth representatives and Regional Vice Presidents.
- **Best Practices & Resources:** Promote the sharing of best practices, resources, and successful initiatives among EUME youth leaders.
- **Leadership Development:** Develop new programs and initiatives that engage youth in leadership training, and – together with the Youth Department Director – create a pipeline of youth leadership training opportunities. Support regional leadership development projects and youth-led initiatives.

- **Member Networking:** Expand member networking opportunities, including through Foundations, EMPOWER, CARP/HARP workshops, and the Pure Water Assembly.
- **Youth Representation:** Assist the Youth Department Director in strengthening youth representation and participation within the wider movement.

Qualifications and Experience

- **Mission Alignment:** A personal commitment to the teachings of True Parents and a heart for the “Pure Water” generation vision. Ability to embody the values of FFWPU in working with young people.
- **Relevant Experience:** Experience in youth ministry, youth leadership, mentoring, or event organization (volunteer or professional). Experience within EUME youth activities, workshops, or leadership programs is an asset.
- **Relational Skills:** Strong communication and relationship-building skills, with the ability to work sensitively across different cultures, languages, and national contexts within EUME.
- **Self-Management:** Self-motivated and reliable, able to work independently in a remote, flexible-hours arrangement and to coordinate with a distributed team.
- **Travel:** Willingness to travel within the Continent for workshops, gatherings, and major programs as needed.

This is an emerging-leader-friendly position: applicants at the beginning of their leadership journey are warmly encouraged to apply.

Practical Details

- **Organization:** Family Federation for World Peace and Unification (FFWPU) Europe and Middle East (EUME)
- **Position Type:** Flexible hours – applicants can indicate on the job application how many hours per week they are able to offer.
- **Location:** Remote (must be based within the EUME Continent)
- **Compensation:** €12,000-24,000 annually (depending on location and hours/week; plus covered official travel and expenses)
- **Length of Term:** 3 years
- **Reporting To:** EUME Youth Department Director

EUME Youth Department: Engagement Coordinator

The Engagement Coordinator helps young people find – or rediscover – their place in the EUME community. Working closely with the Youth Department Director, the Coordinator creates accessible experiences that reconnect distanced youth, welcome new participants, and build relationships across the wider community and affiliate network. The role engages, expands, and connects new visitors and distanced Blessed Children, supporting them in taking their first steps along the Youth Department “Youth Track”: **Visitor** → **Member** → Volunteer → Team Leader → Mentor → EUME Leader.

Youth Department Vision and Mission

- **Vision Statement:** A loving, united Pure Water generation centered on Heavenly Parent and True Parents—embodying our faith, strengthening family-centered communities, and cultivating a culture of peace across Europe and the Middle East.

- **Re-engagement:** Identify and engage youth who are disconnected or less involved in community life, creating welcoming pathways back into the community.
- **Affiliate Relations:** Build and maintain relationships with affiliate organizations and partner initiatives, and collaborate on youth-focused programs – including YSP, Peace Cup, High Noon, UFG, and others.
- **International Collaboration:** Develop opportunities for international friendship, exchange, and collaboration across the Continent.
- **Outreach & Witnessing:** Support outreach and witnessing initiatives through events and partnerships, encouraging relationship-building, community awareness, and positive representation of the movement.

- **Public Image:** Work together with the FFWPU Communications and Media Manager to create and sustain a positive public image of EUME youth.
- **Participation & Engagement:** Assist in developing new opportunities for youth participation and engagement throughout EUME.
