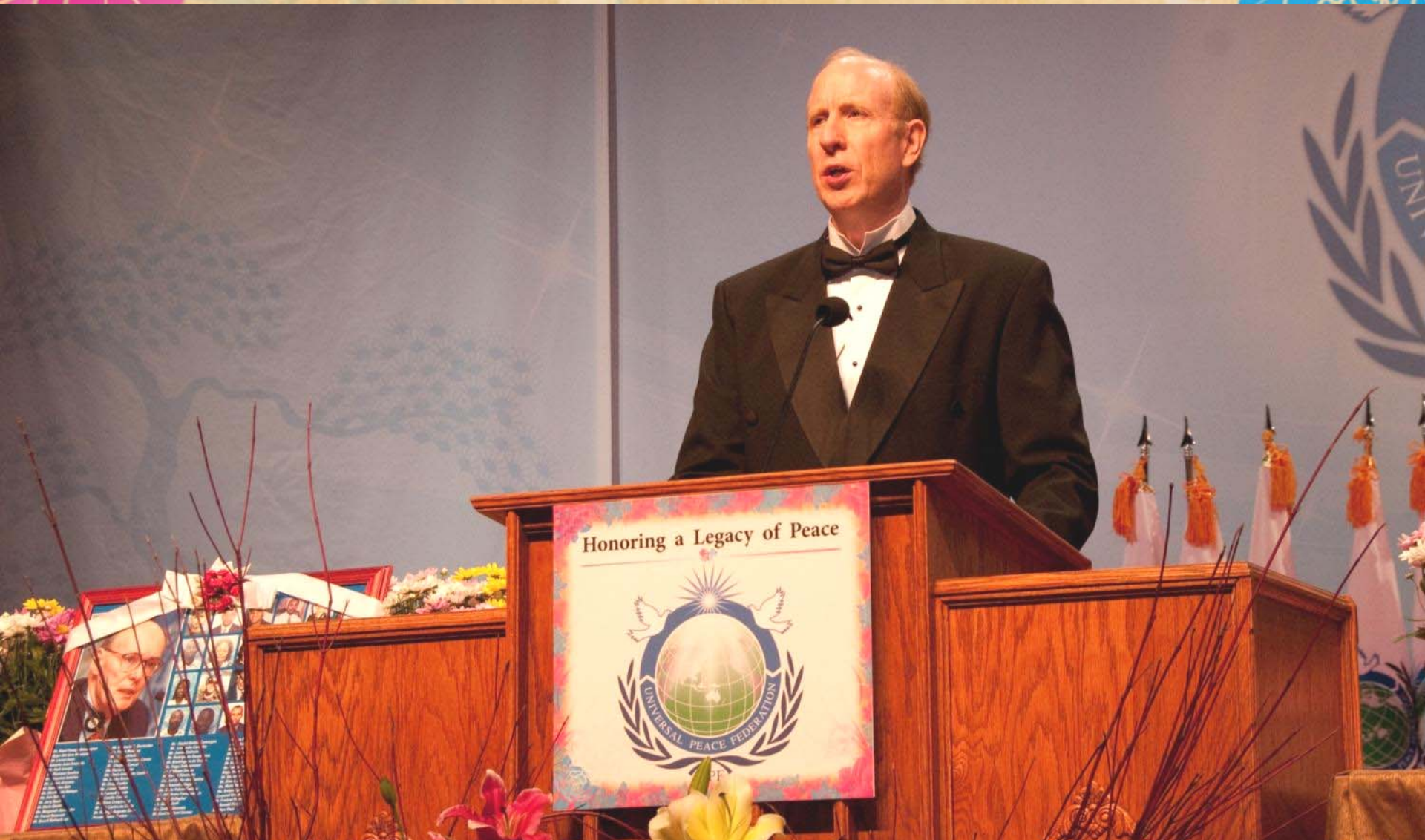

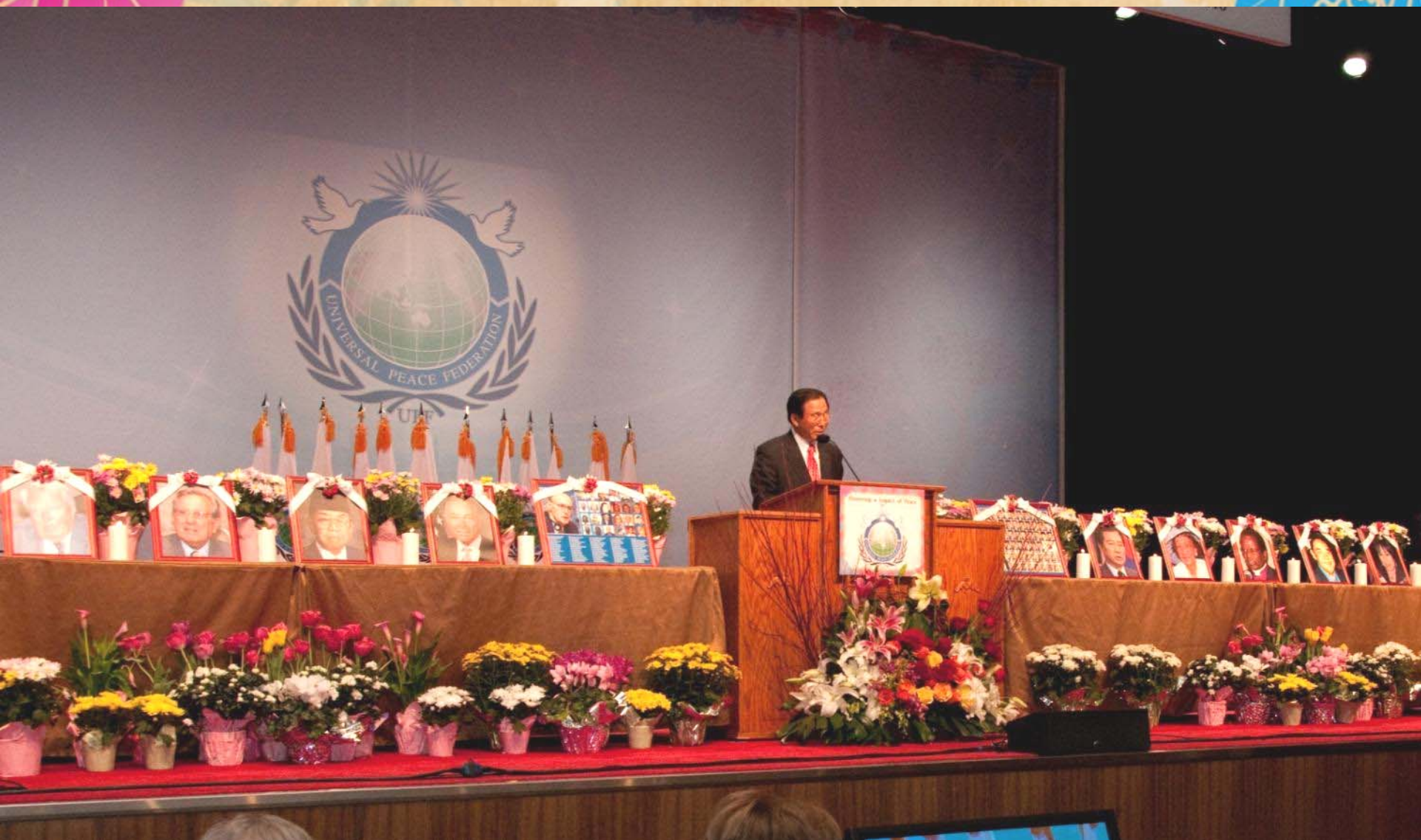

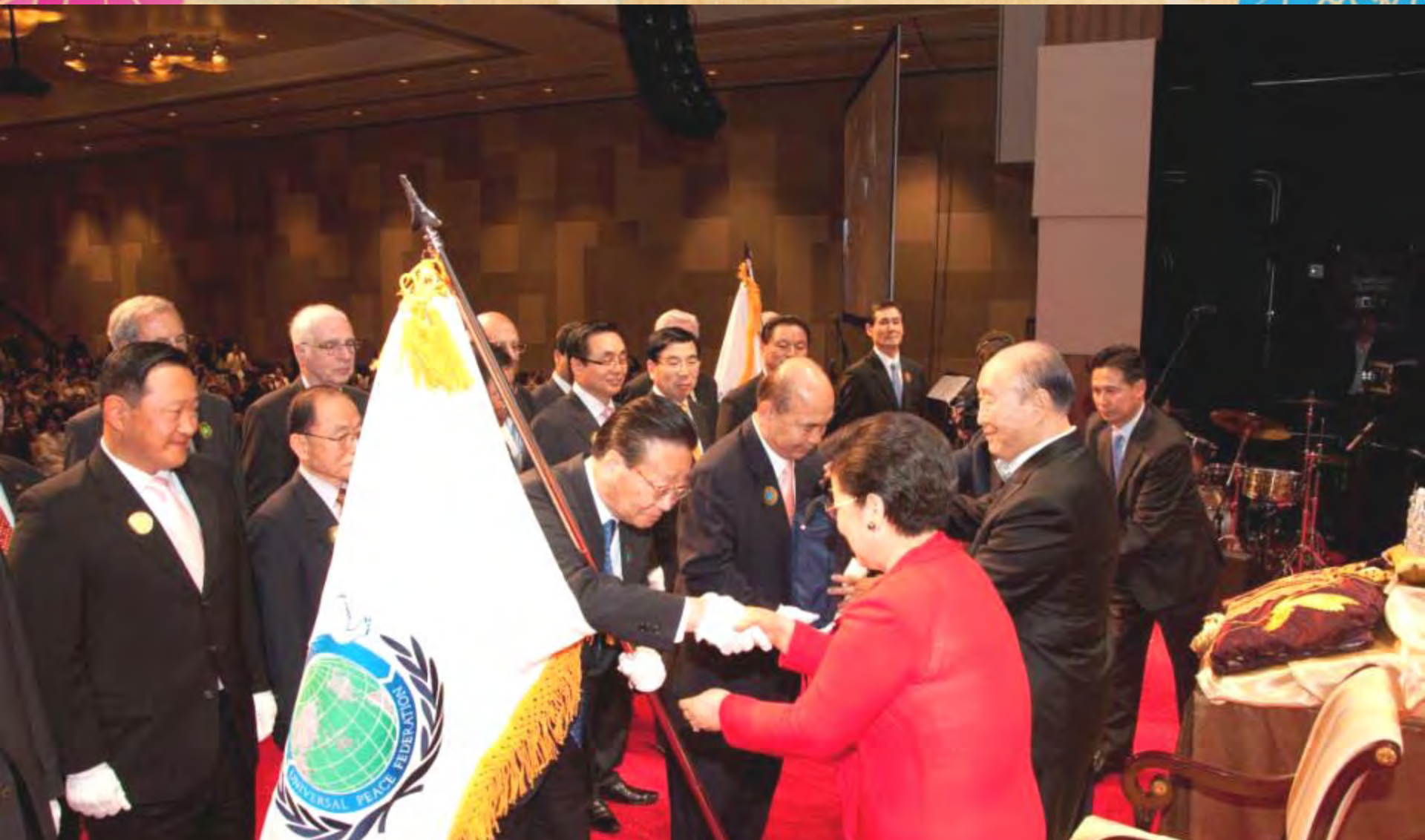
He spoke about the importance of interfaith and intercultural marriage as an instrument of peace, and the need for UN renewal and reform.
