

Launching YSP in local communities with YSP Peace Designer Seminars

Youth and Students for Peace (YSP) is an international youth organization launched recently by True Mother to advance world peace through empowering young leaders with a heart of service. YSP was inaugurated in North America earlier in February 2018, and we are currently planning to launch YSP in local Family Federation communities by providing YSP Peace Designer seminars.

The YSP Peace Designer Seminar is a 1-day seminar that gives young leaders an opportunity to design their own peace projects to address a challenge in their local or global community. It includes an intro to YSP, a Peace Perspective educational session and the Peace Project design process. Through this seminar, participants will identify causes they care about, learn how to develop your own peace project to address community issues, find ways to help support the UN Sustainable Development Goals, and become a part of an international network of young peacemakers.

In December there will be 2 locations in the US and 1 location in Canada hosting the YSP Peace Designer Seminar.
