We were especially blessed to have Reony and Adalia Tonneyck present the topic "Marriage Bed" and lead the gender breakout sessions that followed. This topic addressed many questions and concerns about married sexual life. They also gave great insight into the trust that can develop between two people and how the of power of God's love enters through married life.



Reony also shared several websites that proved helpful to him during the first years of his marriage and up to now. They have been blessed for 11 years.



Emmanuel and Risa Ossok offered a testimony about adjusting to married life. This beautiful couple from Cameroon and Japan made us laugh as they took us through the adventures of learning about each other's culture and led us to think deeply about why we are making the choice to get blessed.
