### "Day of Family, Love and Loyalty" in Yekaterinburg, Russia









On 1 July the holiday "Day of Family, Love and Loyalty" was held in Yekaterinburg. The first two steps of the Blessing were completed by 13 couples. A deputy of the Yekaterinburg Legislative Assembly and an assistant to the deputy of the State Duma, as well as the head of the Department of Social Policy of the Yekaterinburg Administration, offered congratulations to the couples.



#### Summer Programme in St. Petersburg and Kola Peninsula, Russia



Twenty young people (16-17 years), mostly Second Generation, participated in a 21-day programme in Northwest Russia from 5 to 25 July. There was one week of Divine Principle education in our St. Petersburg centre, followed by one week of fundraising, and finishing with an ecological service project on the Kola Peninsula north of the Arctic Circle in Russian Lapland.

#### **YSP Forum in Lapland Region, Northwest Russia**



Student representatives from Moscow State University, Moscow University of International Relations, and Moscow Higher School of Economics travelled to the Kola Peninsula, north of the Arctic Circle, to take part in a forum organised by YSP Russia titled "Lapland – the Point of Growth." The forum, which was held from 22-31 July, began with a Peace Designer programme, followed by an ecological service project and presentations from NGO leaders. These students from the elite institutes of higher learning were chosen based on personal interviews.

### **Three-Month Leadership Training Programme in Russia**



Five young members, both First and Second Generation, started a threemonth leadership training course with one month of fundraising on Sakhalin Island off the Pacific coast of Russia. In the second month of training they will travel to Lake Baikal in Siberia for an ecological service project. Their training will conclude in September with one month of witnessing in Moscow.

Nine of the 11 workshop participants had started the training programme before the pandemic, and the two others are elder Second Generation who just graduated from school.



#### **Ukraine YSP Meeting**





From 17 to 19 July, YSP organized a meeting in Kyiv for 14 youth leaders who have different responsibilities in witnessing, taking care of public youth activities and programs for elder Second Generation. They analysed youth activities for the first half of the year, reported about each direction and defined a plan for the second half of the year. The three-day meeting also included an outdoor programme.

### **Special Outing in Belarus**



In Belarus, children from 7 to 12 years went on a two-day hiking trip with their fathers. It was very enjoyable for the fathers and children to spend time together while enjoying the beauty of nature. The 23 participants were not only hiking, camping and enjoying outdoor cooking, but also cleaning the areas in which they were walking. The children also offered special prayers for True Mother and for their own mothers.

#### Seven-Day Divine Principle Workshop in Romania



From 17 to 23 July, a seven-day Divine Principle workshop was held in Moeciu de Sus in Romania's Transylvania region. This was the first workshop programme since the COVID pandemic began, and three new guests graduated.
