With wire cutters, we cut and positioned wire cages around the trees to prevent animals such as rabbits from harming the newly planted trees. Zip ties were used to keep the cages together. Finally, our volunteers took time to put in emitters for the drip irrigation system.



Overall, it was a hands-on experience that provided our volunteers learning opportunities about the native plants in the area, as well as about general landscaping and gardening. It was great being able to contribute to Wetlands Park, and we hope to come back and see how the area transforms over time!
