Gordon has a long experience with the analysis of major political systems. He is the author of many articles and books, including *Life, Liberty, and the Pursuit of Happiness*, Version 4.0 (2009), and *Integral Society: Social Institutions and Individual Sovereignty* (Paragon House, 2023). Since 1999, he has been a board member of the Minnesota Legislative Evaluation Assembly, serving as President from 2007-2011.
