DONE 020 Update Development of New Environments

Dear brothers and sisters,

We are happy to announce that there are some more places available for DONE 020 and it is still possible to apply. We have now finalized most of the programme details and dates and want to share the key information in this letter. DONE 020 first module

This year's programme will take place from 7th November until either 13th or 20th December 2020. It will be 36-43 days long (the end date will be confirmed during the programme).

The participation fee is 1400 EUR.

DONE 020 will include 3 educational periods, a service project (4-5 days) and either active fundraising training (6-7 days) or a mountain trip (4-5 days).

DONE 020 will take place mainly in the seminar house in Dunajská Lužná, near Bratislava, Slovakia. The service project, mountain trip and fundraising training will take place in different locations. If traveling abroad is possible and safe, it is likely that we will go to Austria, Italy or Germany.

Application

As a part of the application form, we ask all applicants to send their CV, a motivation letter explaining why you want to apply to DONE (approx. 222 words) and a self-reflection letter sharing your personal strengths and weaknesses.

We are constantly monitoring the situation of travel restrictions and safety regulations related to COVID-19. We will send further details personally, after the application.
