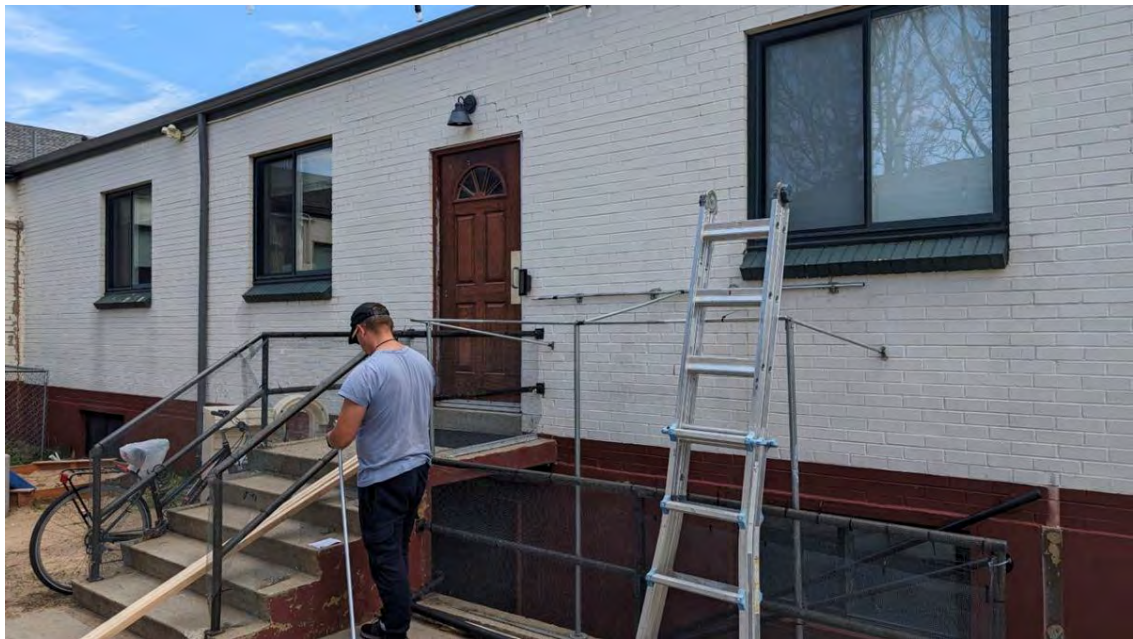


On Saturday, we had our pledge service and offering table for these Holy Days. Despite the rain and snow, we had a good attendance. Pastor Adonia gave a great

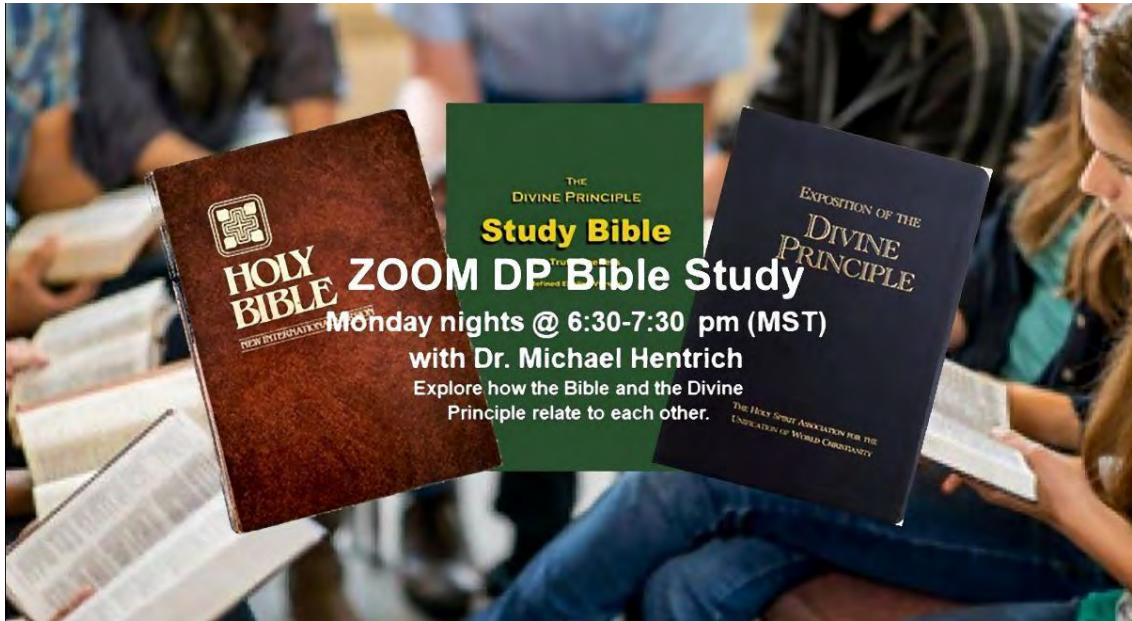
