A Report from Pastor Matthew

Hi everyone.

I have my fingers crossed that from 19th July many of the Covid-related restrictions will be lifted, allowing us to begin resume in-person meetings. After consultation with the Bromley Committee, a decision was made not to return to Livingstone House and instead begin to look for a new venue in which we can organise our worship services and other activities. The priority will be to find a place we can rent temporarily, but the long-term plan is to make a proposal for purchasing our own new property. Members of the committee are scouting for suitable locations, but if you have any suggestions – for rent or for sale – please let me know!

It was relevant that the focus of the latest Pastors Association meeting was finances: Stories from Spain, Ireland and the USA indicated that it is very possible, with good stewardship, for a community to build up assets that can be used for public purposes. We are blessed in the UK to have a high degree of financial security, so I believe we will have a lot of support in acquiring a new property.

The Worship Training Programme concluded at the beginning of last month. 5 members of the Bromley community registered to participate – with over 160 other individuals registering from across the EUME region – so I hope to invite those who participated to get more involved in our worship services. Work still needs to be done, however, on the set of guidelines that needs to be edited.

I spent some time last month planning the current sermon series on the FFWPU UK Strategy. The last sermon of the series will probably be delivered this month. In the area of teaching and preaching, I was also privileged to teach a couple of the recent Sunday School lessons. Irina does a great job coordinating the Children's Ministry, but new volunteers are always welcome: Please let Irina know if you would like to support the Children's Ministry.

My circumstances restricted the amount of time I had available to meet people in person last month, and I had to rearrange a few of my planned appointments due to unexpected events, but I managed to talk with a number of members on the phone. The last month has also been tense for the Krams family, with Andis waiting for an urgent heart transplant. Thankfully, a suitable heart arrived in good condition earlier this week, allowing the transplant operation to go ahead. Andis is not out of the woods yet and the next few days will be especially important for his recovery, but he is in a stable condition. Please keep Andis in your prayers, along with his wife Elvira and their three young children.

I hope that you have some holiday plans for July and August, but do not miss out on the Annual Gathering Festival on 28th August – book your family's spot here. Please also take advantage of the summer camps and workshops available for our younger members.

- o TCD True Children's Day

• Subsequent transfers of donations to European HQ or International HQ will be made by UK HQ after consultation with the National Director

2. CheonBo Related Donations

· All CheonBo related donations should be made by members directly to UK HQ

• From time-to-time members may receive or become aware of memos from the European Office and/or the International Headquarters offering the opportunity to make Cheonbo donations directly. Even so, the preferred process is always through the UK HQ

• CheonBo related donations can be for Ancestor Liberation, Ancestor Blessing, Collateral Liberation, Hyo Jeong Offering Papers, Home Town Mission, Home Town Victors, and Great Works

• However, if members make a CheonBo related donation to their local community, the local community needs to transfer the donation to UK HQ with a payment reference [Community Abbreviation]-[CB]-[Initial and Family Name] as soon as possible

· Gift Aid on CheonBo related donations cannot be reclaimed by the local community


